ABSTRACT

The September 30, 1990 enrollments are reported for educational programs administered by three agencies of the Delaware State Government: the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS); Department of Corrections (DDC); and Department of Services for Children, Youth, and Their Families (DSCYF). Data concerning 474 students in this report complement the annual data on school enrollment collected and reported by the Department of Public Instruction and all these reports together give a complete view of enrollment in educational programs operating in the state. Table 1 provides the cross-tabulation of students enrolled in educational programs by age and instruction. Data are provided for: 245 students aged less than 4 years up to 20 years in 3 DHSS facilities; 14 students aged less than 4 years up to 20 years in 4 DOC facilities; and 215 students aged less than 4 years up to 20 years in 9 DSCYF facilities. Table 2 is a cross-tabulation by race/ethnic category (American Indian, Black, Asian, Hispanic, and White) and institution. (SLD)

PREFACE

This report outlines the September 30, 1990 enrollments in educational programs administered by the Department of Health and Social Services, Department of Correction and Department of Services for Children, Youth and Their Families. Annual data on enrollment in the public and nonpublic schools for the State are collected and reported separately by the Department of Public Instruction. These enrollment reports, along with this report, constitute a complete set of enrollment data for education programs operating in the State.

The data gathered for this report were tabulated and are presented in two tables. Table 1 provides the cross tabulation of students enrolled in educational programs by age and institution. Table 2 provides a cross tabulation by race/ethnic category and institution.

NOTE: The number of students noted in parentheses (843) are over age of 20; therefore, are not included in the totals.
