ABSTRACT

Sixteen tables and four graphs present data concerning enrollment trends since 1960 in non-public schools in Delaware as of September 1990. Figures are included for schools with religious affiliations and for independent private schools. The total non-public school enrollment in Delaware in September 1990 was 22,353. Eighty-eight percent of these students were residents of Delaware; this total represents a 1.5% increase over the September 1989 total. Statewide, the 1990 resident student non-public enrollment was 16.5% of the combined public and resident non-public school enrollment in the state. Since September 1989, nine new non-public schools opened in Delaware, two Catholic schools were combined into one school, and two non-public schools closed. The largest enrollment figures were for diocesan Catholic schools. Three appendices provide additional tables of data concerning non-public school openings/closings for 1989-90, non-public schools by district for 1990-91, and a directory of non-public schools in Delaware for 1990-91. - Delaware's total nonpublic school enrollment in September 1990 was 22,353. Of these 88 percent (19,736 students) were Delaware residents, twelve percent (2,617 students) were from out of state.
 - Delaware's total nonpublic school enrollment has increased 1.5 percent (337 students) over the September 1989 total, compared to a 2 percent increase from 1988 to 1989.
 - This is the second consecutive year since 1982 that Delaware's total nonpublic enrollments have increased. Total Catholic school enrollments increased 1.2 percent. Enrollments in other religiously affiliated schools increased 0.4 percent, while independent school enrollment rose 4.1 percent.
 - Nonpublic enrollments of Delaware *residents* increased 1.1 percent (219 students) over the September 1989 total. The increase from 1988 to 1989 was 1.9 percent.
 - *Resident* nonpublic school enrollments in New Castle County rose 1.1 percent (188 students). Those in Kent County remained stable. Sussex County *resident* nonpublic enrollments increased 5% (33 students).
 - Statewide, the 1990 *resident* nonpublic enrollments were 16.5 percent of the combined public and resident nonpublic enrollments, a slight decrease from 1989's 16.6 percent.
 - Nine new nonpublic schools with a total enrollment of 35 opened in Delaware since September 1989. Two Private Catholic schools combined into one reporting unit while two nonpublic schools closed. Five nonpublic schools, while operating, are serving only prekindergarten pupils this year.
- *Change in the number of public schools resulted from closing Claymont High School (Brandywine School District), opening Elbert Palmer Elementary School (Christina School District), and reorganization in the Cape Henlopen School District.

**NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS IN DELAWARE
1990-1991**

INTRODUCTION. The Research and Evaluation Division of the Delaware Department of Public Instruction annually collects, analyzes, and reports selected data pertaining to pupils enrolled in kindergarten through grade twelve in nonpublic schools in the state. Enrollment data are collected each fall. Although each annual report provides some trend information, more extensive longitudinal data are to be provided every fifth year beginning in 1986. Readers should be aware that tables in this report include out of state pupils attending Delaware nonpublic schools except in those tables specifying *Delaware Residents Only* in the table heading.

PURPOSE. Pupil enrollment and attendance information for nonpublic schools is required to be reported by Section 2704, Title 14, *Delaware Code*. Because of increased needs for detailed enrollment data, the collection and analysis procedures were modified extensively in 1975 to accommodate demands.

PROCEDURES. Basic procedures employed in the collection and analysis of nonpublic data are as follows:

Data Collection. Nonpublic schools are required to provide name, sex, race, grade, district of residence, and type of transportation assistance requested for all students enrolled in grades K-12. Miles from school and home addresses are required only for those students requesting transportation assistance. Schools are also required to provide summary counts of school staff. Enrollment data are key entered, one record per pupil, and machine processed.

Reporting. Computer-generated reports relating to enrollments are prepared for each nonpublic school and at the state level. These documents provide bivariate cross-tabulations for various pairs of variables. The format of school reports is identical to those prepared at the state level.

Nonpublic schools, for reporting purposes, are organized into four categories: (1) Diocesan Catholic, (2) Private Catholic, (3) Other Religious Affiliation, and (4) Independent (those schools with no religious affiliation).

FINDINGS. In 1990, Delaware's total nonpublic school enrollment increased 1.5 percent over last year's count. This increase reflects a 1.6 percent enrollment increase in Diocesan Catholic schools, a 0.4 percent increase in schools of other religious affiliations, and a 4.1 percent increase in Independent school population. Private Catholic schools experienced a small enrollment decrease (-0.4 percent). This is the second consecutive year since 1982 that the total nonpublic enrollment has increased. Delaware's nonpublic schools currently enroll 18.3 percent of the combined public and total nonpublic enrollments. This ratio has remained fairly constant over the last five years.

Delaware's *resident* nonpublic enrollment rose to 19,736 in 1990, an increase of 1.1 percent (219 students) since last year. New Castle County's *resident* nonpublic enrollment increased 1.1 percent (188 students), while the combined increase for Kent and Sussex Counties was 1.4 percent (31 students). Statewide, the 1990 *resident* nonpublic enrollments were 16.5 percent of the combined public and *resident* nonpublic enrollments, a slight decrease from 1989's 16.6 percent. In New Castle County the 1990 *resident* nonpublic enrollments remained at 22.9 percent of the combined public and *resident* nonpublic enrollments. In Kent County *resident* nonpublic enrollments dropped from 6.6 to 6.3 percent; those in Sussex County decreased from 3.8 to 3.6 percent.

Nonpublic Schools by Type, 1974-1990



Public and Nonpublic Schools, 1960-1990



Delaware Residents Only



September, 1990


