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ABSTRACT

Fulfilling its legislative mandate, the Alaska State Department of Education prepares annual profiles on state school districts. The summary of data in this publication represents only a portion of information gathered about Alaska public schools, but it does provide information on school operations, facilities, programs, students, and personnel. The profile format for the state total summary and each of the 54 districts is a two-page display of data grouped into six headings: (1) background; (2) operating revenues and expenditures; (3) funding community summary; (4) student characteristics; (5) staff ratios and statistics; and (6) staff and student demographics. In addition, student characteristics, staff ratios and statistics, and staff and student demographics are provided for two state-operated schools. Data were submitted to the Department of Education in reports from school districts or were taken from reports published by state and federal agencies. A glossary of terms is included, as is a directory of school districts. (SLD)

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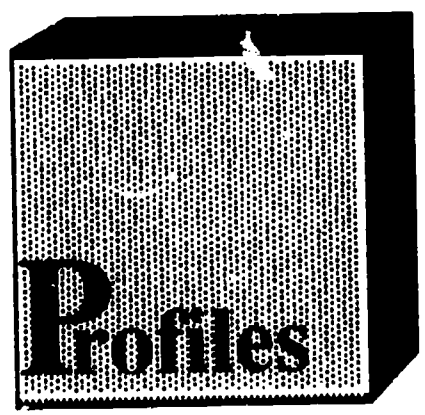

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Introduction

This is the second annual publication of **Profiles of Alaska's Public School Districts**. The Alaska Legislature in its Fiscal Year 89 authorization, directed the State Department of Education to prepare annual profiles on each school district. In its directive the Legislature wrote:

It is the intent of the Legislature that the Department of Education will implement a data management system including but not limited to profiles of school districts which include data on school operations, facilities, programs, students and personnel.

In compliance, the Department produces this publication on an annual basis. This information is intended to add to the statewide knowledge base and understanding of education in Alaska.

The summary of data in this publication represents only a small portion of the statistics contained in the Department's computerized data management system. The District Profile Data Base is a compendium of information gathered from numerous sources. For example, the financial data is gathered from the audited financial reports submitted by school districts in November following each school year. The staff and student data is gathered from enrollment and staff reports submitted by each school district annually, in compliance with state and federal requirements. Other background data, such as employment statistics and population, are gathered from official state and federal government sources.

Several changes have been made to this year's publication. These changes include:

1. The size of the publication has been reduced to a more manageable size. In doing so, the Alaska maps showing the location of each district was eliminated, but overall, the final product should be more convenient to use.
2. A new data field has been added on the first page of each report in the background section. It is entitled Median Family Income and is shown just below Population. Refer to the Glossary of Terms in the back of this publication for a definition and the source of this information.
3. The Aleutians East Borough School District began operations in June 1989 and is, therefore, included in this year's report. The district is composed of the former Sand Point School District and King Cove School District. Akutan School, Cold Bay School, False Pass School, and Nelson Lagoon School, formerly in the Aleutian Region School District, are also part of the new district. Nikolski School and Atka School remain in the Aleutian Region School District.
4. Centralized Correspondence School (CCS) and Mt. Edgecumbe High School have been included in this year's publication. Although not school districts, there has been enough interest in having student and staff information published for these State operated schools that they have been included. Specifically, of the two-page format used in the Profiles, only the second page providing Student Characteristics, Staff Ratios and Statistics, and Staff and Student Demographics is relevant to these schools and therefore published.
5. Lake and Peninsula Borough was incorporated as a borough on April 24, 1989. This changed its governance status from an REAA to a Borough.

Content

The profile format for the fifty-four districts and the State Total summary is a two page display of data grouped into six subject headings. A one-page display for Mt. Edgecumbe High School and Centralized Correspondence School uses three of the six subject headings. The subject headings used are as follows:

- Background
- Operating Revenues and Expenditures
- Funding Community Summary
- Student Characteristics
- Staff Ratios and Statistics
- Staff and Student Demographics

Below is a sample of the format used to report each district's profile. On succeeding pages sections of the profile are enlarged and annotated to help the reader understand them.

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Background

The background area at the top of the first page provides background on each of the school districts. Some items, such as square miles, originate with state sources while others, such as population, originate with the federal Bureau of the Census.

In those instances where data, such as unemployment statistics, per capita income, median family income and adults with a high school diploma were not available at the district level, the policy is to use percentages and averages from the region of the state in which the school district is located.

- A. Square miles reported at the district level include a significant amount of tidelands and submerged lands seaward to three nautical miles and therefore exceed the total square miles of land reported at the state level.
- B. Population counts for the districts do not add to the state total because there is no school district for the community of Hyder. Students in Hyder attend school in British Columbia.

Operating Revenues and Expenditures

Centrally displayed on the first page of each district's profile is the 1989-90 audited financial data. On the Alaska State Total page, you will find the summary totals for the fifty-four school districts.

- C. The figures displayed are 1989-90 audited Operating Revenues and Operating Expenditures only. These data depict the financial characteristics of each district's general operations and show the costs to operate schools in the district. Audited data are available six months after the close of each school year.
- D. The totals do not include federal supplemental grant funds or restricted use funds such as the Migrant Program, Chapter I, or Handicapped Program funds, because these funds are supplemental to a district's normal operations and are restricted in their use.
- E. Those districts reporting revenue fund "transfers" have had those sums included in the "Other (State)" revenue category.
- F. City and borough district "Tuition" totals are included as "Other (State)" revenue.
- G. The "\$ per ADM" column represents Average Daily Membership in grades K-12 only. Districts that included expenditures for pre-elementary or other students outside these grades are not being given credit in the ADM for the numbers of those students. Therefore, expenditures per student in those districts are slightly inflated.

A detailed description of each of the Revenue and Expenditure categories can be found in the glossary following the profile series beginning on page 123.

The State of Alaska Uniform Chart of Accounts currently provides school districts great latitude in optional function and object code presentations. Totals reported in audits, therefore, do not necessarily represent costs of similar activities in every case, as many users of the data would desire. The department is considering proposed revisions to the chart of account definitions and structure that would provide summary data that meets the needs of state and federal users for specific and comparable data.

Funding Community Summary

Funding Community information displayed at the bottom of the first page provides data on grade levels, facility counts and enrollments. Funding Communities are financial reporting agencies set up under the Alaska Administrative Code as part of the Public School Foundation Program.

In this section of the report, district operated correspondence study programs are listed as separate Funding Communities, so that their enrollments could be shown accurately. However, according to state law, district correspondence programs are assigned to the funding community with the highest Average Daily Membership. Accordingly, the total count of funding communities appearing in the "Background" section does not include the correspondence programs.

- H. The Average Daily Membership full-time equivalent number may differ from the total enrollment listed in the previous Funding Community Summary section. Average Daily Membership (ADM) is based on an average of counts taken each day over a prescribed twenty-day period while enrollment is a single day count.
- I. The item "Special Needs" is a total of those students reported by the districts in three classifications: "Resources," "Self Contained," or "Intensive."
- J. Poverty level data are not universally available for all districts. Most poverty data are obtained from the number of students who qualified for the Federal Government's free and reduced lunch program. When a District did not participate, a poverty estimate was obtained, if available, from the Department of Education Chapter I records.
- K. Vocational Education is offered only in grades nine through twelve and, consequently, is shown as a percentage of the enrollment for those four grades only.

Staff Ratio and Statistics

Centrally displayed on the second page are ratios and statistics relating to the district and school staff.

L. Staff totals are displayed as Full-Time Equivalents (FTE). Often a staff member will work part time in some positions, which results in some FTE numbers appearing as fractions, even in such areas as sex and ethnicity.

M. The definition of "full time" may vary from district to district, particularly for Instructional Aides. For example, some districts define a work day as a five-and-one-half-hour day while others define a work day as an eight-hour day.

Beginning on page 123 is a glossary of terms listed in alphabetical order. The reader is encouraged to refer to this glossary for additional explanation of data elements included in these profiles.

Methodology

All data gathered for this publication were either submitted to the Department of Education in official reports from the school districts, or in the case of background information, taken from reports published by official state and federal sources. Therefore, this data base is a compendium of data originally gathered elsewhere and brought together for this display.

Columns containing percentages have been computed from the figures provided to the Department by the school districts, but may not total 100% due to rounding. Percentages for numbers less than .1% have been rounded to .1% unless insignificant.

Not every district participates in every program displayed here. Therefore, some districts have areas of blank data fields, which indicates either the district does not participate in the program or did not report the particular data.

Glossary of Terms

Administrative Expenditures

Expenses that pertain to the activities of both school and district administration. At the school level, it includes the activities performed by the principal, assistant principal and other assistants in general supervision of administrative operations of the school. At the district level, it includes administration of the schools and the school system, as well as activities relating to school board matters.

All Teachers

This term refers to a summary of those certified teachers including visiting teachers, in remedial or consulting roles to meet special student needs in classrooms, and in a teaching capacity as a head teacher. Information reported is on a full-time equivalent basis.

Area Cost Differential

A multiplier factor as shown in AS 14.17.051 to adjust a school district's instructional units for cost differentials between school districts. Factors vary between 1.0 and 1.46, depending usually on remoteness of the district.

Attendance Centers

A school, operated by a district, serving one or more grade levels of students or special education, vocational education, or bilingual/bicultural students as defined by 4 AAC 09.105 for foundation funding purposes.

Average Daily Membership

The average of the number of students enrolled over a twenty-day period on a full-time equivalent basis, as specified by AS 14.17.160. It is reported to the department in the district's initial Foundation Report by the end of the second week following the fourth Friday in October and updated at mid-year if the numbers of students increase dramatically.

Bilingual/Bicultural Students

Students who are determined by a district to be bilingual as defined by 4 AAC 34.050.

Building Administrators

Principals and assistant principals are in this category along with head teachers that spend some portion of their time on administrative duties.

Central Office Staff

District personnel that provide administrative services for the school district. Examples of central office staff are superintendents, assistant superintendents, directors, managers, and administrative assistants. Contact the Office of Data Management for a complete listing by job code.

Chapter 1 Students

Students whose educational attainment is below the level appropriate for children of their age as defined by 34 CFR Part 75.

Classroom Teacher

A regular, certified classroom instructor under contract to a state recognized school district to provide formal instruction within a specified time period.

Election District

The State of Alaska is divided into fourteen Senate election districts and twenty-seven House election districts creating seats for twenty state Senators and forty state Representatives.

Enrollment

For reporting purposes, enrollment is the number of students on a full-time equivalent basis that are listed on the membership role in a school for instruction. October 1 is the designated Fall count date.

Foundation Revenues

Revenues accruing to the school district from the state and based on a formula that guarantees each district \$60,000 per instructional unit, taking into consideration revenue from federal sources and local contributions.

Full-Time Equivalent (students)

The number of classes in which a student is receiving instruction divided by the number of class periods in a day. This measurement is expressed as a decimal fraction to the nearest tenth.

Full-Time Equivalent (teachers)

That portion of the total teaching assignment for an individual teacher allocated to a particular subject matter. It is derived by dividing the amount of employed time normally required of a staff member to perform a less than full-time assignment divided by the amount of time normally required in performing a corresponding full-time assignment. For example, if a teacher is employed full time, the FTE is 1.0. If a teacher is employed half time, the FTE is .5. This measure of time is expressed as a decimal fraction to the nearest tenth.

Funding Communities

Each school district is divided into funding communities by attendance centers, a financial reporting entity as defined in 4 AAC 09.005 that gives consideration to centralization and to grade levels involved. In this report, district operated correspondence study programs are listed as separate funding communities although according to state law they are assigned to the funding community with the highest Average Daily Membership. The total count of funding communities appearing in the " Background " section does not include the correspondence programs.

Gifted/Talented Students

Students identified as exceptional as defined in AS 14.30.350.(a), determined eligible under 4 AAC 52.130, and warranting special advanced instruction as required in 4 ACC 52.140, and reported for Foundation funding.

Governance

System of government at the local level as provided for in the Alaska Constitution. Currently, there are three unified home rule governments, eleven organized boroughs, one hundred forty-nine incorporated communities, one community organized under federal law, and twenty-one Regional Education Attendance Areas. School districts have been established in each of the municipalities, boroughs, REAA's and nineteen of the incorporated communities.

High School Graduates

Students receiving a high school diploma or a certificate of completion during the school year.

Instructional Aides

Staff members assigned to assist a teacher in activities requiring minor decisions regarding students and in such activities as monitoring, conducting rote exercises, operating equipment and recordkeeping.

Instructional Expenditures

Instructional Expenditures include those operating expenses for: Regular Instruction, Vocational Education, Correspondence Study, Special Education, Gifted and Talented Education, and Bilingual-Bicultural Education. As compiled from annual audits, this category excludes categorical grant funds restricted in use.

Instructional Units

Basic unit of measure upon which the state School Foundation Program funding is based and calculated from student Average Daily Membership identified for grade levels K through 12, with additional weighting for vocational, special education, gifted/talented, and bilingual programs and adjusted by the area cost differential, according to AS 14.17.041-47.

Local Sources Revenue

Revenue collected by cities and boroughs and appropriated to the school board for school purposes and revenue produced within the school system for school purposes. The city and borough school districts are, under state law, required to contribute the lesser amount of: (1) the equivalent of funds generated by a four mill tax levy based on the full and true value of the taxable real and personal property in the school district; or (2) 35 percent of a school district's basic need for the preceding school year.

Median Family Income

Income by family derived from the 1980 Census and updated on an annual basis with Bureau of the Census income data and Department of Commerce employment and earnings data. Family is defined as 2 or more persons related by blood or marriage. Median income is the amount that divides the distribution of families into two equal groups, one having incomes above the median and the other having incomes below the median.

Migrant Education Students

Students who within the last six years have moved across school district boundaries because their parents are involved in seasonal or temporary employment in fishing, logging or agriculture activities as defined in 34 CFR Part 201.

Operation and Maintenance

Expenses of plant facilities, which includes such items as utilities, janitorial services, painting, and repairs.

Other Expenditures

Expenses relating to Community Services, Tuition, Fund Transfers and Pupil Activities.

Other (Federal) Revenue

Federal revenue other than PL 874 revenue such as indirect cost revenue for administration of grants.

Other (State) Revenue

State revenues that cannot be classified in the nine other state revenue categories as described in the Uniform Chart of Accounts and include such items as legislative grants.

Per Capita Income

The total personal income of an area divided by the area's resident population (every man, woman and child). This information is published on an annual basis by the federal Bureau of Economic Analysis, an agency of the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Percent of ADM

Percentage derived by dividing student counts for each category of program service by the Average Daily Membership on a full-time equivalent basis.

Percent of Adults with High School Diploma

Percent of persons 25 and over completing four years high school or more from the 1980 Census.

PL-874 Revenue

Federal funds (Federal Law PL-874, Impact Aid to Education) provided to school districts for children of parents living and/or working on federal property as an "in lieu of local tax" revenue, including land conveyed to Native Corporations under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. Under Federal law the State may deduct a portion of these revenues from the State's aid to school districts as long as the State insures equality in funding to all students across the State.

Population

Aggregate counts of individuals generated annually by the Alaska Department of Labor based upon the 1980 Census and modified by such sources as school enrollments, Internal Revenue Service, Vital Statistics, and Permanent Fund data.

Poverty Level Students

Students who participated in the federal free and reduced lunch program, as reported to the State Department of Education in November. As not all districts choose to participate in the program, a poverty estimate obtained from Department of Education Chapter I records was used for non-participants, and in some cases supplemented by best estimates supplied by the district.

Pupil Staff Ratio

Ratio computed by dividing the student Average Daily Membership by the number of full-time equivalent staff positions in each category.

Pupil Support Expenditures

Expenses incurred in pupil support activities such as school office, health, library, student activities, and usually not related to direct instruction.

Regional Corporations

Twelve Regional Corporations were created in 1971 by the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act to accept payment from the Federal Government in exchange for all aboriginal titles and claims of title in Alaska. These corporations were based on twelve geographic regions that approximated the areas covered by the operations of existing Native associations. A thirteenth region and Regional Corporation was also established for Natives who were non-residents of Alaska.

Specialists

Individuals in non-teaching and non-administrative job code positions. They are individuals who perform services of a specialized nature. Examples of this category would be audiologists, physical or occupational therapists, psychologists, nurses, counselors, and librarians. Contact the Office of Data Management for a complete listing by job code.

Special Needs Students

Students who are identified in need of special education assistance as defined in 4 AAC 52.130 and grouped in three Special Education categories: Resources, Self-Contained, and Intensive. For each district these are the numbers reported for Foundation funding.

Square Miles

The area in square miles for each school district provided by the Department of Community & Regional Affairs. Some districts have included in their totals tidelands and submerged lands seaward to three nautical miles. In certain districts, the perimeter boundary extends even beyond the three mile limit.

Staff Average Years Experience

Years experience, by job category, for teachers, administrators and specialists as reported by each district.

Staff Demographics

Staff data on sex and ethnicity reported on a full-time equivalent basis.

Student Demographics

Student ethnicity extracted from the annual Student Ethnicity and Enrollment Report prepared by individual districts.

Unemployment Rate

Monthly estimates published by the Alaska Department of Labor by Census Area. School Districts are assigned the same figures for the applicable census area.

Vocational Education Students

Students in a non-degree secondary school training program that prepares them for entry level employment or advancement in an occupation requiring less than a baccalaureate degree as defined by 4 AAC 51.190.

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
