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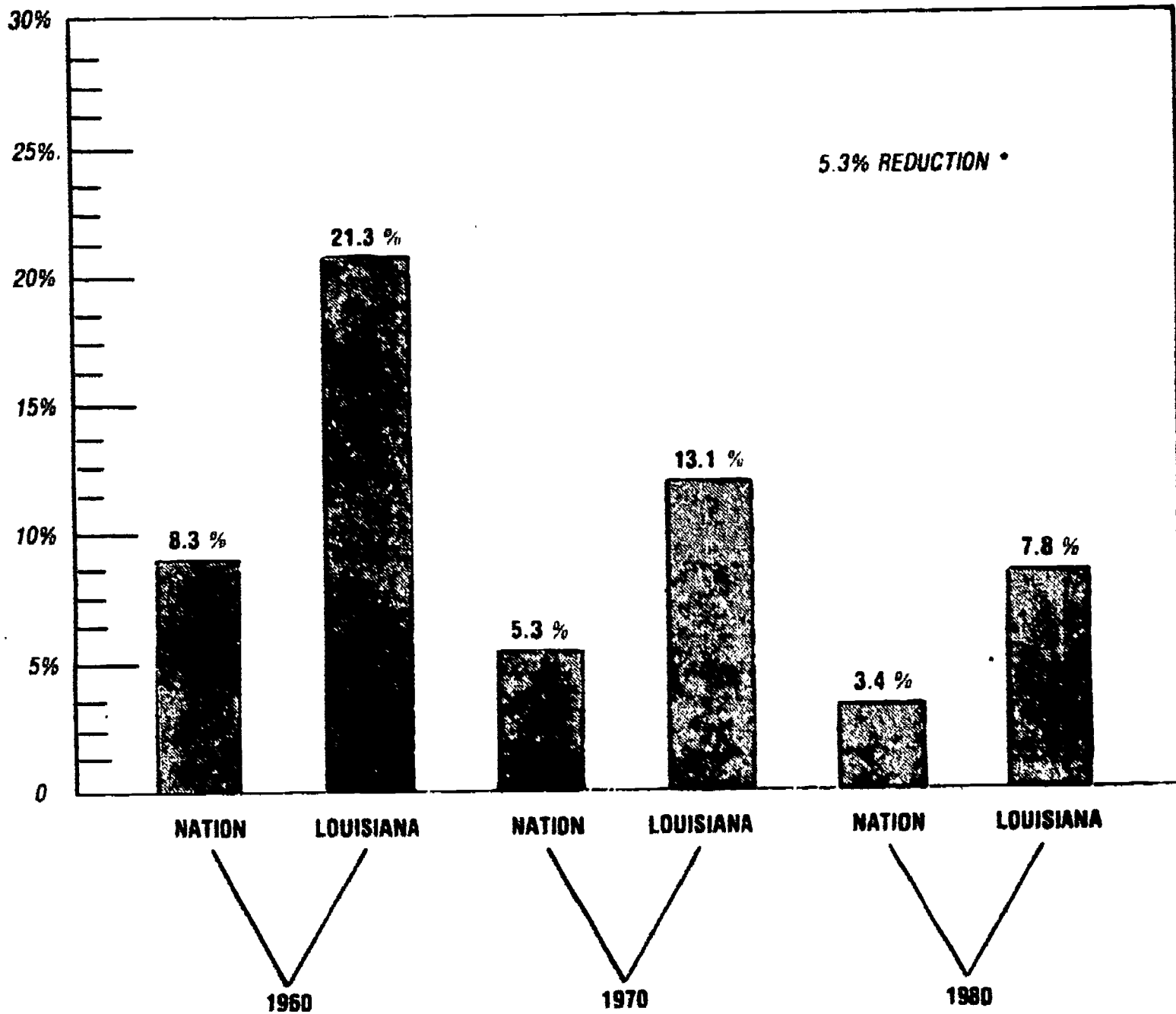
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ILLITERACY DEFINED

Functional illiteracy denotes one who has completed less than five years of school and lacks the ability or skills necessary to function competently in today's society.

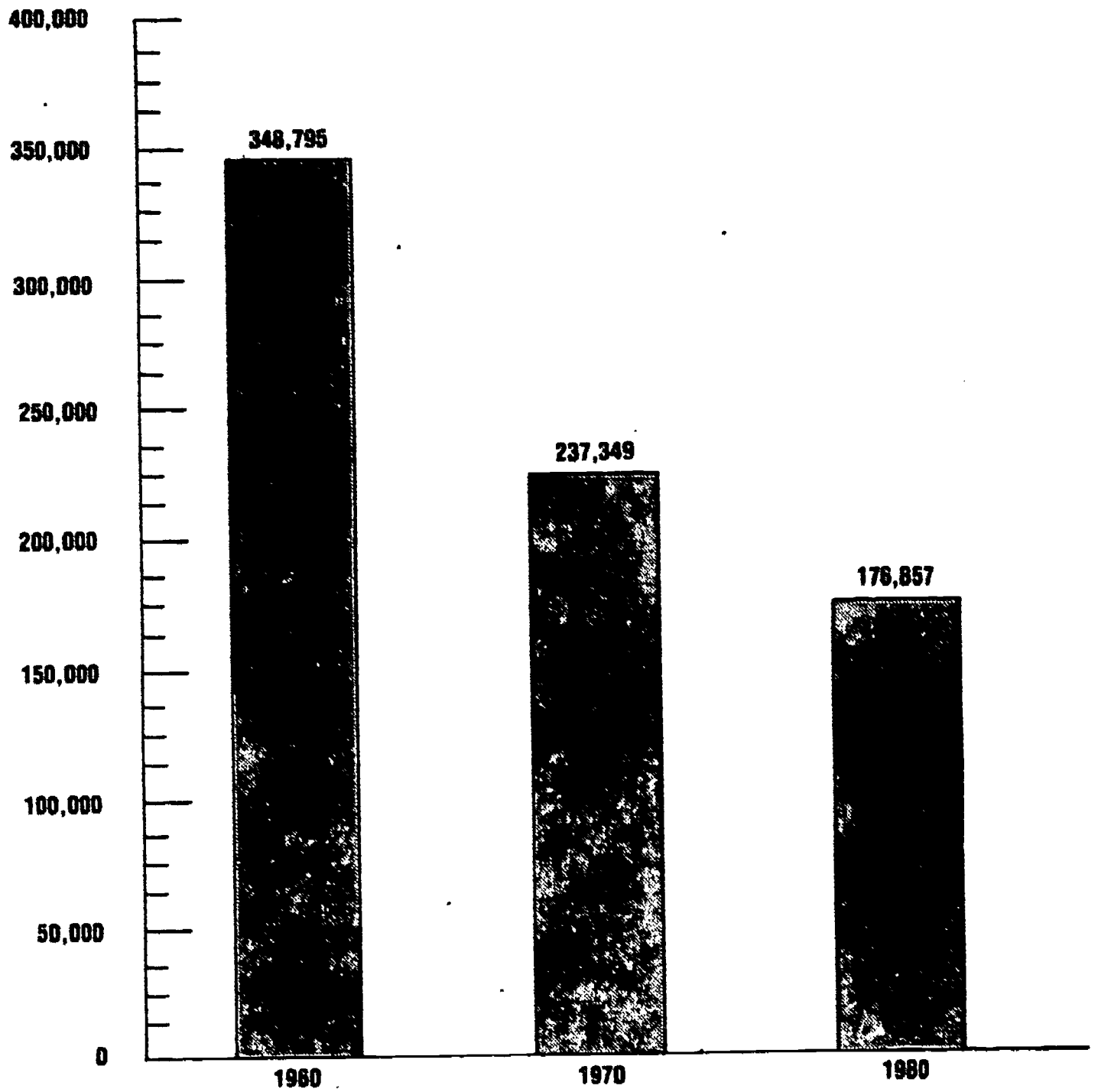
DECREASING ILLITERACY IN LOUISIANA



*5.3% REDUCTION IN PERCENTAGE OF ILLITERATES AND FUNCTIONAL ILLITERATES - 0-4 GRADE

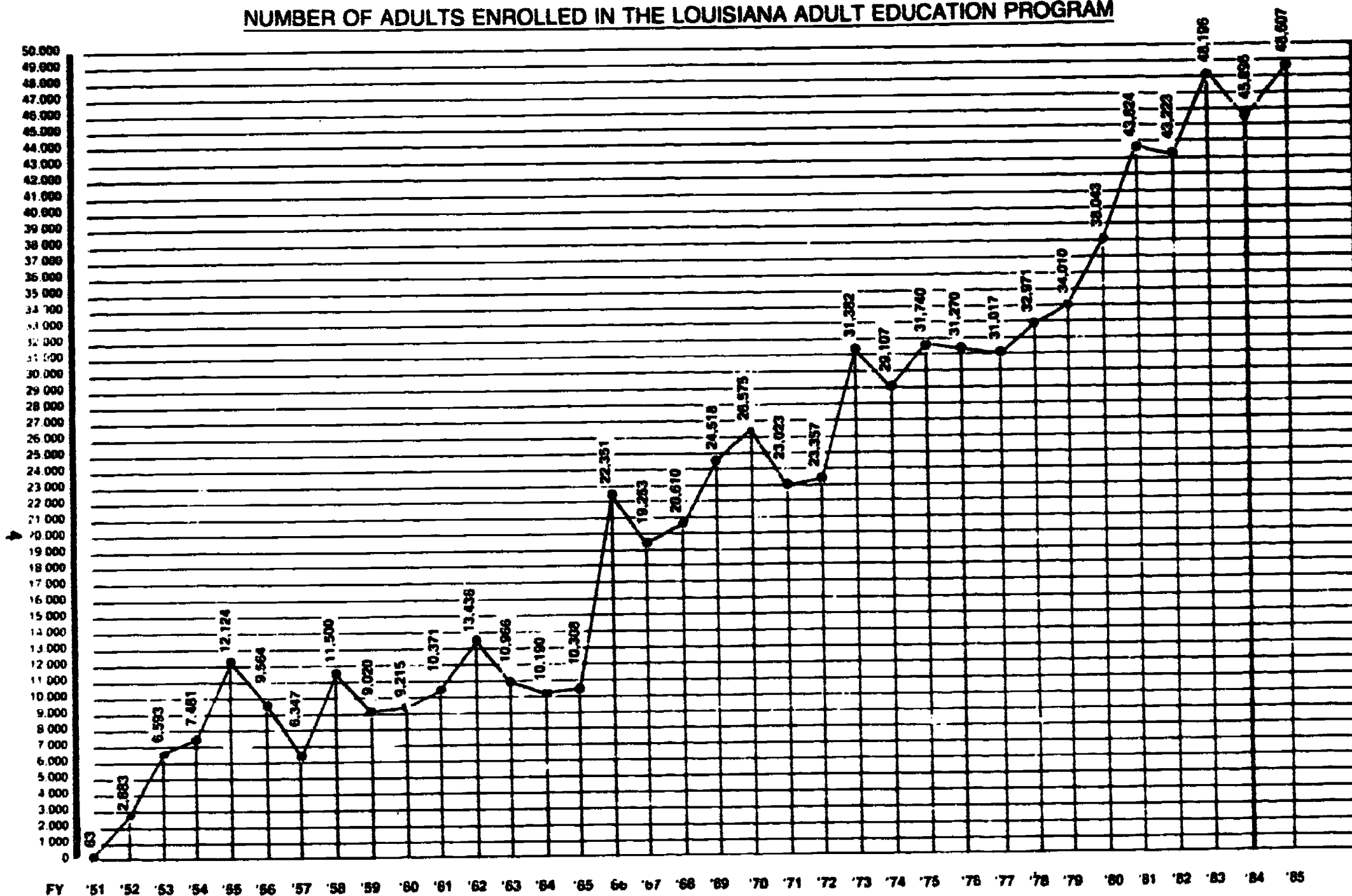

DECREASE IN THE NUMBER OF ILLITERATES AND FUNCTIONAL ILLITERATES



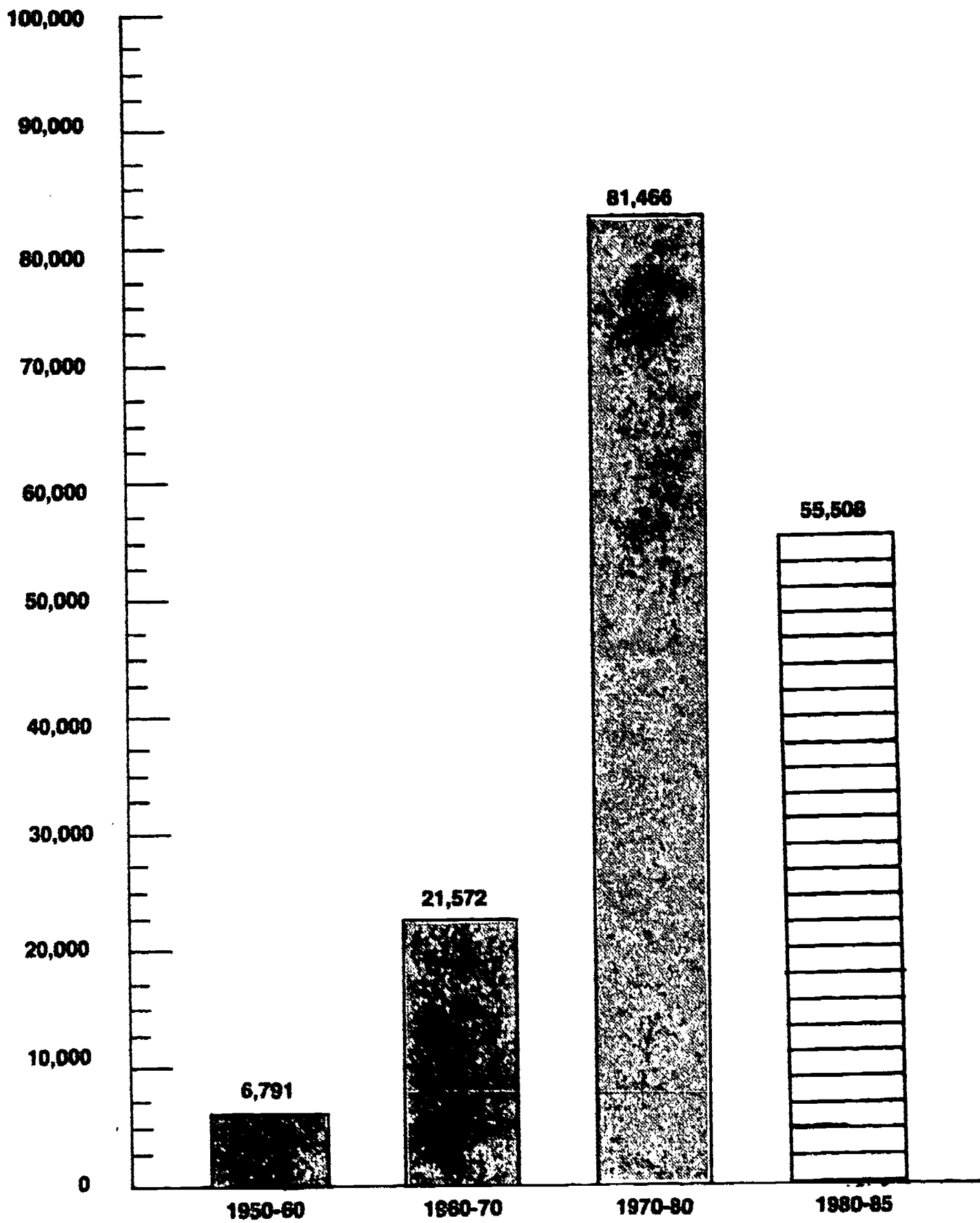

This graph indicates the number of adults enrolled in Adult Basic Education and Act 252 of 1950 Programs as amended.

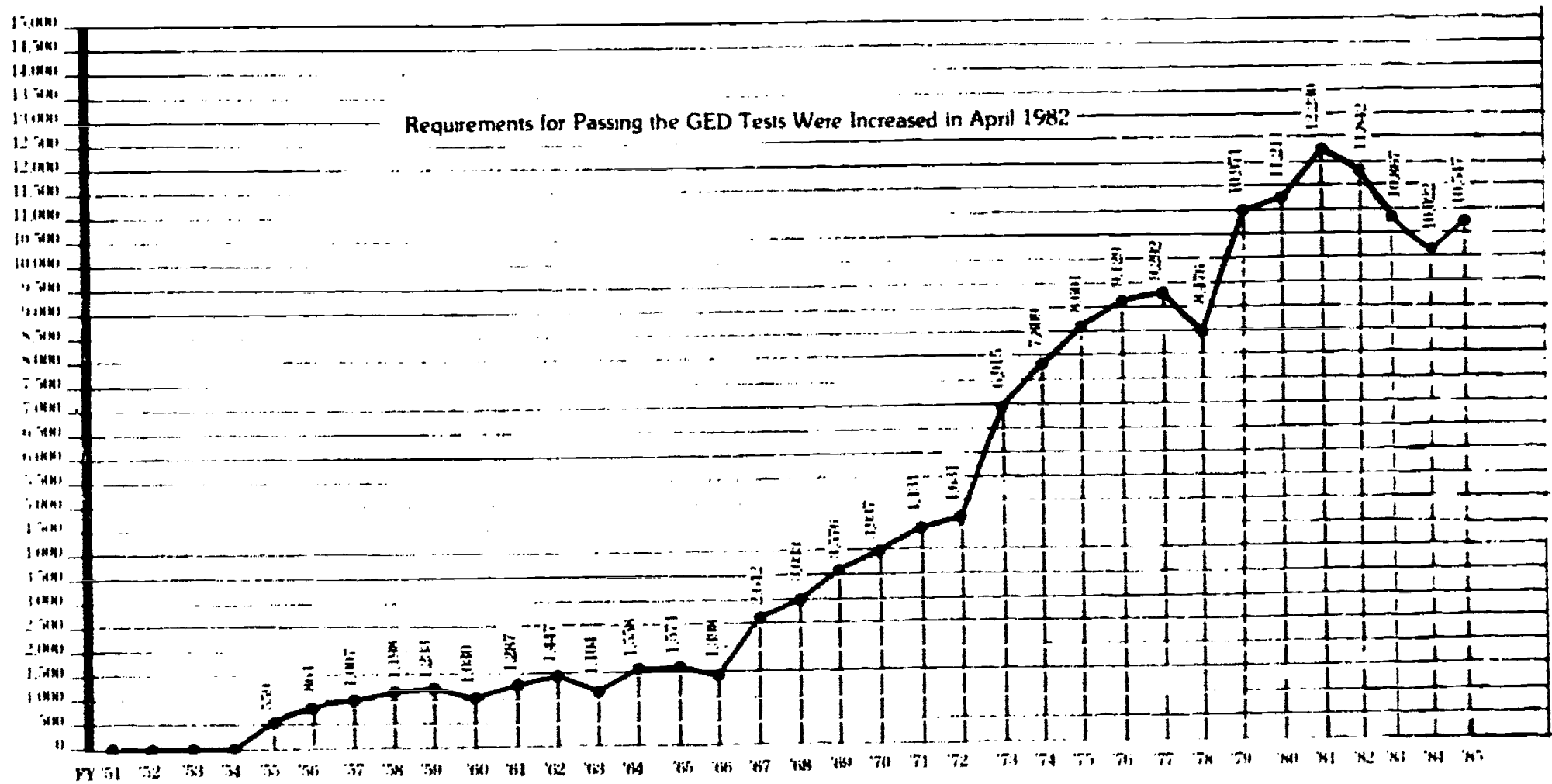
PERSONS COMPLETING HIGH SCHOOL THROUGH THE
ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM



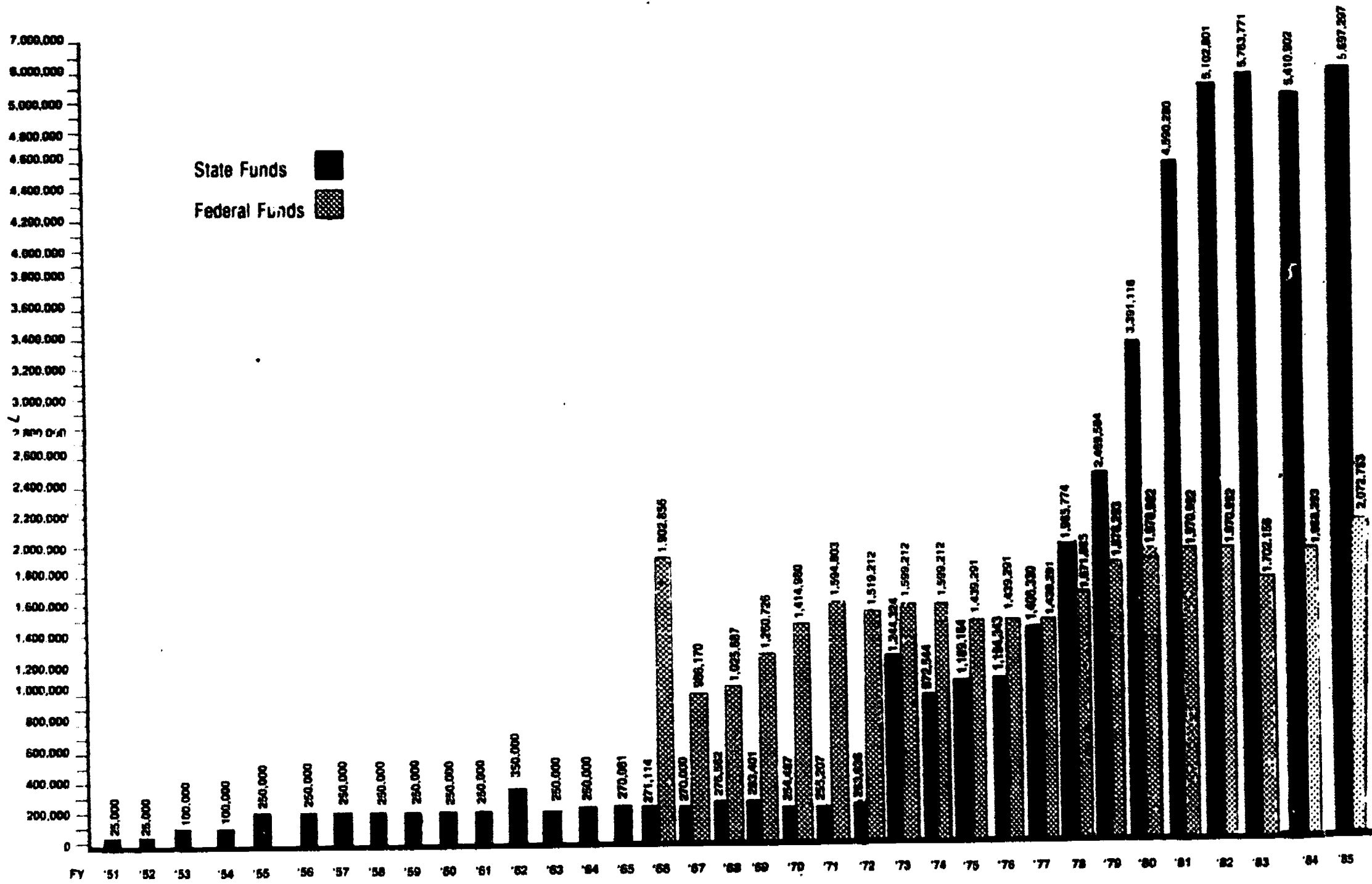
NUMBER OF ADULT GRADUATES FROM THE LOUISIANA ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM

LOUISIANA ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM STATISTICS

1984-85

- In 1984-85, the Adult Education program served 48,607 undereducated adults.
- The Adult Education program produced 10,547 graduates in 1984-85.
- Adult Education classes are offered in 29 vocational-technical schools located in 28 parishes.
- Adult Education is cost-effective. In 1984-85, the cost per student hour of instruction was \$1.89.
- The average cost per enrollee was \$145.81.
- Students were upgraded an average of 1.6 grade levels per 77.0 hours of instruction.
- Adult Education is the only alternative method of earning a high school diploma in Louisiana once the individual leaves the K-12 system.
- Certification of all full-time Adult Education teachers has been required since September 1, 1982.
