#### ABSTRACT

This catalog lists periodicals available in special media to blind and physically handicapped persons throughout the United States. Part 1 lists and describes all magazines produced by the National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped (NLS) of the Library of Congress for its free reading program. These magazines are available at no charge through cooperating libraries to persons who are unable to read or handle conventional print materials because of visual or physical impairment. Part 2 lists and describes magazines that are not part of the NLS reading program but are offered free or by paid subscription by their producers or other sources. The magazines are produced on disc, cassette, or computer diskette or in braille, large type, or Moon type. Indexes by title, subject, and medium are provided as access points to the listings. (JDD)

# Introduction

Magazines in Special Media is a descriptive listing of periodicals available in special media to blind and physically handicapped persons throughout the country.

Part 1 of Magazines in Special Media lists all magazines produced by the National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped (NLS), Library of Congress, for its free reading program. Magazines listed in Part 1 are available at no charge through cooperating libraries to persons who are unable to read or handle conventional print materials because of visual or physical impairment. Eligible persons must be residents of the United States or American citizens living abroad.

To order any of these magazines, fill out the order form that appears at the end of the catalog and send it to your cooperating library. If you do not know the address of your cooperating library contact your local public library for this information. Your personal subscription will be entered and new issues mailed directly to you from the producer. Allow three months between the time of your request and receipt of the first issue of magazines you order. You need not return the magazine issues to your cooperating library with the exception of two magazines noted in Part 1 as "on loan from cooperating libraries." These magazines must be returned to your cooperating library for loan to other readers.

Part 2 lists magazines that are not part of the NLS reading program and cannot be requested from cooperating libraries. The information about these magazines was provided by their producers. Some of these magazines are offered free, others

by paid subscription. In all cases, the source for ordering is indicated and full addresses are given in the appendix to Part 2. The sources given should be contacted directly for the latest subscription information because availability and prices tend to change frequently.

In both Part 1 and Part 2, magazines are arranged alphabetically by title. Some magazines are listed in both Part 1 and Part 2. In such cases, a cross reference is made from one part of the catalog to the other. Media included are braille, cassette, computer diskette, disc, large type, and Moon type. Most braille magazines are grade 2 and most discs play at 8 rpm. Cassettes play at 15/16 or 1-7/8 ips.

Magazines can be located in the catalog by using the title index, the subject index, or any of the indexes arranged by medium. Each index indicates the page or pages on which a full description of a magazine can be found. Boldface numbers in the indexes indicate the magazine is available through cooperating libraries.

Braille Book Review and Talking Book Topics frequently announce new magazines in special media and changes in any of the magazines listed in this catalog.

New issues will be mailed directly to you from the producer, and you need not return them to your cooperating library except the following titles: Choice Magazine Listening and Dialogue. These two magazines are noted as "on loan from cooperating libraries" and must be returned for loan to other readers.
