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#### ABSTRACT

This publication offers 17 tables of data on higher education admissions and enrollment in New York State for Fall 1991. The degree-credit and noncredit enrollment information is in the first 15 tables. Tables 1-3 present general trends and summaries of degree-credit enrollment. The next four tables provide summaries of first-time degree-credit enrollment, degree-credit by institutional classification, noncredit enrollment by institutional classification, and enrollment data by institution, respectively. Additional tables cover undergraduate information including: undergraduate enrollment, organized occupational enrollment by subject area, upper division enrollment by subject area, and unclassified enrollment. Tables also present first-professional degree enrollment information by subject area and unclassified. Tables presenting data on graduate enrollment are organized for: (1) masters degree programs by subject area, (2) doctoral degree programs by subject area, (3) unclassified enrollment, and (4) graduate certificate programs. The section on admission trends identifies trends by institutional sector and presents data on admissions status and applications received and accepted, and full-time students enrolled, by institutional classification. #### **DEFINITIONS**

DEGREE-CREDIT ENROLLMENT: Students in a program or taking courses which are creditable toward a diploma; certificate; or associate, bachelor's, master's, doctoral or first-professional degree.

#### **UNDERGRADUATE:**

<u>LOWER DIVISION</u> - Includes freshmen and sophomores in bachelor's degree programs, students in associate degree programs, and students in terminal occupational programs of one, two or three years that result in a certificate or diploma.

<u>UPPER DIVISION</u> - Includes students who have completed the sophomore year and typically are enrolled in a four- or five-year bachelor's degree program.

<u>UNCLASSIFIED</u> - Not candidates for a degree or other formal award, although taking degree-credit courses designated by the institution as undergraduate level. Includes students in undergraduate certificate or diploma programs of less than one academic year.

ORGANIZED OCCUPATIONAL ENROLLMENT - Students in a program specifically associated with the development of skills required for occupations at the technical or semiprofessional level.

FIRST-TIME STUDENTS - Entering freshmen or unclassified undergraduate students who have not previously attended any degree-granting college. These are students who began their first academic year in a degree-granting institution after July 30, 1991 and are currently enrolled at the undergraduate level, either in a program or as an unclassified student. In addition to the traditional first-time student, this category includes students entering with advanced standing achieved through examination, completion of courses in nondegree-granting nursing schools, or college courses taken by high school students who were not formally enrolled in a college program. These advanced standing students are included, even if their credits allowed them to enter as sophomores or juniors.

#### FIRST-PROFESSIONAL:

FIRST-PROFESSIONAL DEGREE PROGRAM STUDENTS - Students enrolled in a professional school or program which requires at least two academic years of college work for entrance and a total of at least six years for a degree. This category includes students taking courses in the following first-professional degree programs: Dentistry (D.D.S. or D.M.D. degree), Medicine (M.D. degree), Optometry (O.D. degree), Osteopathic Medicine (D.O. degree), Pharmacy (D.Phar. degree), Podiatry (Pod.D., D.P.) or Podiatric Medicine (D.P.M.) [include Chiropody], Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M. degree), Chiropractic (D.C. or D.C.M. degree), Law (LL.B. or J.D. degree) and Theological Professions (B.D. or M.Div.).

<u>UNCLASSIFIED</u> - Students who are not candidates for a first-professional degree, but are taking degree-credit courses, designated by the institution as first-professional level.



#### DEFINITIONS

(Concluded)

#### **GRADUATE:**

MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE ENROLLMENT - Students who hold a bachelor's or first-professional degree or equivalent, and are in a program for a master's or doctoral degree.

<u>GRADUATE CERTIFICATE ENROLLMENT</u> - Students enrolled in graduate level curricula which lead to a certificate, such as a Certificate of Advanced Studies (CAS), School Administrator and Supervisor, School Counselor and Library and Information Studies.

<u>UNCLASSIFIED</u> - Students who are not candidates for a graduate degree or certificate but are taking degree-credit courses designated by the institution as graduate level.

FULL-TIME: Those students whose academic load-coursework or other required activity is at least 75 percent of the normal full-time load. For students on a semester calendar system, undergraduate students must carry at least 12 credit hours to be considered full-time, while graduate students must carry at least 9 credit hours. Graduate students enrolled in the City University of New York must carry at least 12 credit hours to be considered full-time.

PART-TIME: Those students whose academic load-coursework or other required activity is less than 75 percent of the normal full-time load.

NONCREDIT ENROLLMENT: Students taking courses which are not creditable toward a degree, diploma or certificate.




