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ABSTRACT

This publication is comprised entirely of statistical reports that summarize graduation-rate data collected from National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division 1 member institutions. The reports reflect the graduation rates of: (1) students and student-athletes entering college in the 1985-86 academic year, and (2) the average graduation rates of the freshman classes entering college in 1983, 1984, and 1985. Rates are based on individuals graduating (or not graduating) within six years of their initial collegiate enrollment. The reports have been divided into categories that group similar public and private member institutions, reflect differences in institutional sizes and missions, and place institutions with similar philosophies together. Ten tables provide the following information about graduation rates and enrollment for 298 Division 1 institutions: comparisons between students and student-athletes; information on gender and racial groups; an overall look at the different sports categories; organization of institutions by NCAA Division 1 subdivisions (based on existing football programs); and detailed data for both large and small public and private schools. 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INTRODUCTION

The following reports are summaries of the data collected from Division I member institutions and contained in the graduation-rates disclosure form. These tables have been created to provide meaningful summaries of the graduation-rates and enrollment data that Division I institutions have provided to the NCAA. The information contained provides comparisons between students and student-athletes, and gender and racial groups. It also provides an overall look at the different sports categories included in the reports.

These reports have been divided into 10 categories that are groups of similar institutions. The categories are based on NCAA subdivision, size of institution and whether the institution is public or private. The categories are meant to reflect differences in institutional sizes and missions, and to place institutions with similar philosophies together.

The data included in these tables are sums of all data collected from institutions in a given category. In all cases, the columns labeled "N" in the following tables relate the total number of students within a reporting cell that were included in the group of institutions in question (e.g., in Division I there were 1,989 white football players who entered school in 1985-86). The test scores and core grade-point averages that are provided in the admissions-data section are averages for the category.

The first table in the series presents data for the 298 Division I institutions that returned the graduation-rates disclosure form. The numbers in this table reflect the data about every institution that was included in the study.

The next three tables divide the institutions by NCAA Division I subdivisions, based upon the football programs that exist at these institutions. There are 107 Division I-A members, 88 Division I-AA respondents and 103 Division I-AAA members included. If I-AAA institutions submitted football program data, these data are included in that institution's report; the aggregate report omits these data since these institutions do not compete in football at the Division I level.

The next three reports detail the data for the public schools that are members of Division I. The first of these reports contains data for all public institutions in the division. The next two reports divide the public institutions into two categories: large and small. These categories were created by looking at 1991-92 enrollment for all 198 public institutions, and placing the half with the higher enrollments in the large category, and the half with the smaller enrollments in the small category. The dividing point for public institutions was a reported enrollment of 10,378.

The final three tables provide similar data for all private schools within Division I. Again, the first table presents data for the entire group ($n=100$) of private institutions. The final two charts divide the private institutions into large and small groups using the same methodology as was used for the public institutions. The dividing point for private institutions was an enrollment of 3,524 individuals.

It is hoped that these data will provide useful information about the graduation rates and enrollment at NCAA Division I institutions. It is also hoped that institutions will be able to use this information to compare themselves with other similar institutions.

DESCRIPTION OF DATA

This information and the following graduation-rates reports have been prepared by the NCAA, based on data provided by member institutions, in compliance with NCAA Bylaw 30.1 and the Federal Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act. Each NCAA Division I member institution is required to distribute its individual report to prospective student-athletes and others, as specified in Bylaw 13.3.1.2.

Each individual report provides information about two groups of students at the institution identified at the top of the form: (1) all undergraduate students who were enrolled in a full-time program of studies for a degree, and (2) student-athletes who either received athletics aid from the institution upon initial enrollment, or were offered aid but could not qualify for it because of the NCAA's initial-eligibility legislation. [Note: Athletics aid is a grant, scholarship, tuition waiver or other assistance from a college or university that is awarded on the basis of a student's athletics ability.]

Each individual report gives graduation information about students and student-athletes entering in 1983, those entering in 1984, and those entering in 1985. These are the three most recent graduating classes for which the required six years of information is available. Each report provides information about student-athletes who received athletics aid in one or more of eight sports categories: football, men's basketball, baseball, men's track and field/cross country, men's other sports and mixed sports, women's basketball, women's track and field/cross country, and women's other sports. For each of those sports categories, each report includes information in six self-reported racial or ethnic groups: American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian or Pacific Islander, Black, Hispanic, White, and Other (not included in one of the other five groups or not available) and the total (all six groups combined).

A graduation rate (percent) is based on a comparison of the number (N) of students who entered a college or university and the number of those who graduated within six years. For example, if 100 students entered, and 60 graduated within six years, the graduation rate is 60 percent. It is important to note that graduation rates are affected by a number of factors: some students may work part-time and need more than six years to graduate; some may leave school for a year or two to work or travel; some may transfer to another college or university; or some may be dismissed for academic deficiencies.

Three measures of graduation rates are presented in each report: (1) freshman-cohort rate, (2) refined rate, and (3) exhausted-eligibility rate. The freshman-cohort rate indicates the percentage of freshmen who entered during a given academic year and graduated within six years. The refined rate adjusts the freshman-cohort rate by including transfer student-athletes who entered, and by excluding student-athletes who did not graduate within six years but were either in good academic standing (as defined in Part 4 of each report) when they left the institution, or were still in school at the beginning of the seventh year. The exhausted-eligibility rate indicates the percentage of student-athletes who used all of their athletics eligibility at the institution and who had graduated by August 1991.

1. Graduation-Rates Data.

The box at the top of each graduation-rates report provides freshman-cohort graduation rates for all students and for student-athletes who received athletics aid at the college or university.

1-a. All Students. Provides the freshman-cohort graduation rates for all full-time degree-seeking students by race or ethnic group. It shows the rate for men who entered as freshmen in 1985-86, and the three-year average, which includes those who entered as freshmen in 1983-84 and 1984-85. The same rates are provided for women. The total for 1985-86 is the rate for men and women combined, and the three-year average is for all students who entered in 1983-84, 1984-85 and 1985-86.

1-b. Student-Athletes. Provides the freshman-cohort graduation rates and also the refined graduation rates for student-athletes in each race and ethnic group who received athletics aid. Information is provided for men and women separately and for all student-athletes.

1-c. Student-Athletes by Sports Categories. Provides the identified graduation rates as in 1-b for each of the eight sports categories. (The small letters indicate the value of N.)

1-d. Graduation Rates of Those Exhausting Eligibility. Provides the graduation rates of student-athletes who entered during the 1983-84, 1984-85 and 1985-86 academic years and exhausted their eligibility at the institution. The rate indicates the percentage who had graduated by August 1991.

1-e. Average Time Required for Graduation. Indicates the average number of years it took all students and student-athletes to graduate. The calculation is based on those freshmen who entered during the 1983-84, 1984-85 and 1985-86 academic years and graduated by August 1991.

1-f. Five Most Common Degree Programs at Graduation. Identifies the five most common programs (majors) of student-athletes who entered in 1983-84, 1984-85 and 1985-86 and graduated within six years.

2. Student-Athlete Admissions Data. (Entering Freshmen 1991-92)

2-a. High-School Preparation Data. Provides core grade-point averages and test scores for student-athletes.

Average high-school CGPA (core grade-point average) shows the GPAs these freshmen earned in a core curriculum of 11 academic courses. The core curriculum includes a minimum of three years of English, two years of mathematics, two years of social science, and two years of natural or physical science, with at least one lab course, if the high school offers one.

Average SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) and average ACT (American College Testing program) scores indicate the average test scores for student-athletes within each sport group. On the SAT, the highest possible composite score (combination of math and

verbal scores) is 1600. On the ACT, the highest possible score is 36.

2-b. Enrollment Date. Indicates the five most common degree programs chosen by student-athletes when they entered this college or university as freshmen during the 1991-92 academic year. At some institutions, students do not select a major program until the beginning of their second or third year and, in that case, the entry in 2-b of the form is "undeclared major." At colleges and universities that do not allow freshmen to declare a major, the entry in 2-b of the form is "major not allowed."

3. Undergraduate Enrollment Data. (All students enrolled fall 1991-92)

3-a. All Students. Indicates the number of full-time undergraduate students enrolled for the 1991 fall term and the number of men and women in each racial or ethnic group.

3-b. Student-Athletes. Identifies how many student-athletes were enrolled for the 1991 fall term and the number of men and women in each racial or ethnic group.

3-c. Student-Athletes by Sports Categories. Provides the enrollment data as identified in 3-b for each of the eight sports categories.

4. Definition of Good Academic Standing.

Good academic standing is the standard that students must meet for grades and credits toward graduation and/or to compete in intercollegiate athletics. Each college or university sets its own standard, which is described in this section of each report.

5. Definition of Satisfactory Progress.

The NCAA has a minimum standard for satisfactory progress toward a degree, which student-athletes must achieve to remain eligible to compete. If the institution requires more stringent rules for satisfactory progress than the NCAA minimum standard, the additional requirements are stated in this section.

GRADUATION RATES OF STUDENT-ATHLETES WHO ENTERED COLLEGE IN 1985: NOTES AND COMPARISONS WITH FRESHMEN WHO ENTERED IN 1984

This report reflects the graduation rates of: (1) students and student-athletes entering college in the 1985-86 academic year, and (2) the average graduation rates of the freshman classes entering college in 1983, 1984 and 1985. This is before the NCAA's athletics eligibility requirements (the so-called Proposition 48—NCAA Bylaw 14.3) went into effect (August 1986). The rates are based on individuals graduating (or not graduating) within six years of their initial collegiate enrollment.

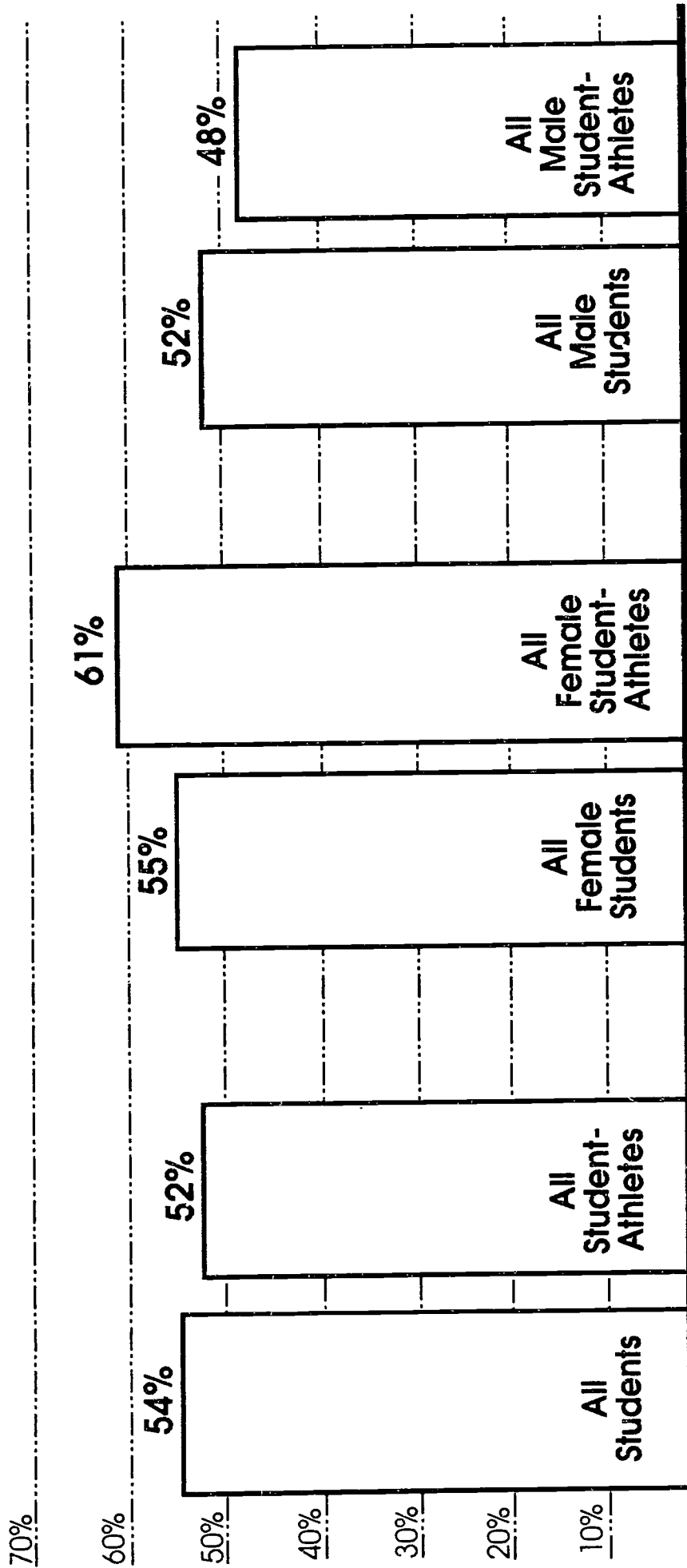
NOTES

1. The graduation rate of student-athletes entering NCAA Division I institutions in 1985 remained at 52 percent, the same rate as that of student-athletes who entered in 1984. That rate is within two percentage points of the graduation rate of all students in Division I institutions (54 percent).
2. The graduation rate of male student-athletes entering Division I institutions in 1985 rose slightly, from 47 percent to 48 percent, over the rate of male student-athletes who entered in 1984. That rate is within four percentage points of the graduation rate of all male students in Division I institutions (52 percent).
3. Female student-athletes entering Division I institutions in 1985 graduated at a rate of 61 percent, one percentage point lower than the rate of female student-athletes who entered in 1984. That rate is six percentage points higher than the graduation rate of all female students in Division I institutions (55 percent).
4. The graduation rate of Division I black male basketball players entering in 1985 rose four percentage points, from 29 percent to 33 percent, over the rate of those entering in 1984. That is three percentage points higher than the graduation rate of Division I black male students entering in 1985 (30 percent).
5. The graduation rate of black football players in Division I-A rose two percentage points, from 33 percent to 35 percent, over the rate of those entering in 1984. That percentage is two percentage points higher than the graduation rate of Division I-A black male students entering in 1985 (33 percent).
6. The graduation rate of black male basketball players in Division I-A rose two percentage points, from 23 percent to 25 percent, over the rate of those entering in 1984. That, however, is eight percentage points lower than the graduation rate of Division I-A black male students entering in 1985 (33 percent).
7. The graduation rate of black student-athletes in Division I-AAA rose two percentage points, from 35 percent to 37 percent, over the rate of those entering in 1984. That is 10 percentage points higher than the graduation rate for black students in Division I-AAA (27 percent).
8. The graduation rate of Division I male basketball players rose five percentage points, from 38 percent to 43 percent, over the rate of those entering in 1984. That figure is nine points below the graduation rate of Division I male students (52 percent).
9. The graduation rate of white male basketball players in Division I rose nine percentage points, from 53 percent to 62 percent, over the rate of those entering in 1984. That is also seven percentage points higher than the graduation rate of white male students entering in 1985 (55 percent).
10. The graduation rate of white male football players in Division I rose two percentage points, from 56 percent to 58 percent, over the rate of those entering in 1984. That is three percentage points higher than the graduation rate of white male students entering in 1985 (55 percent).

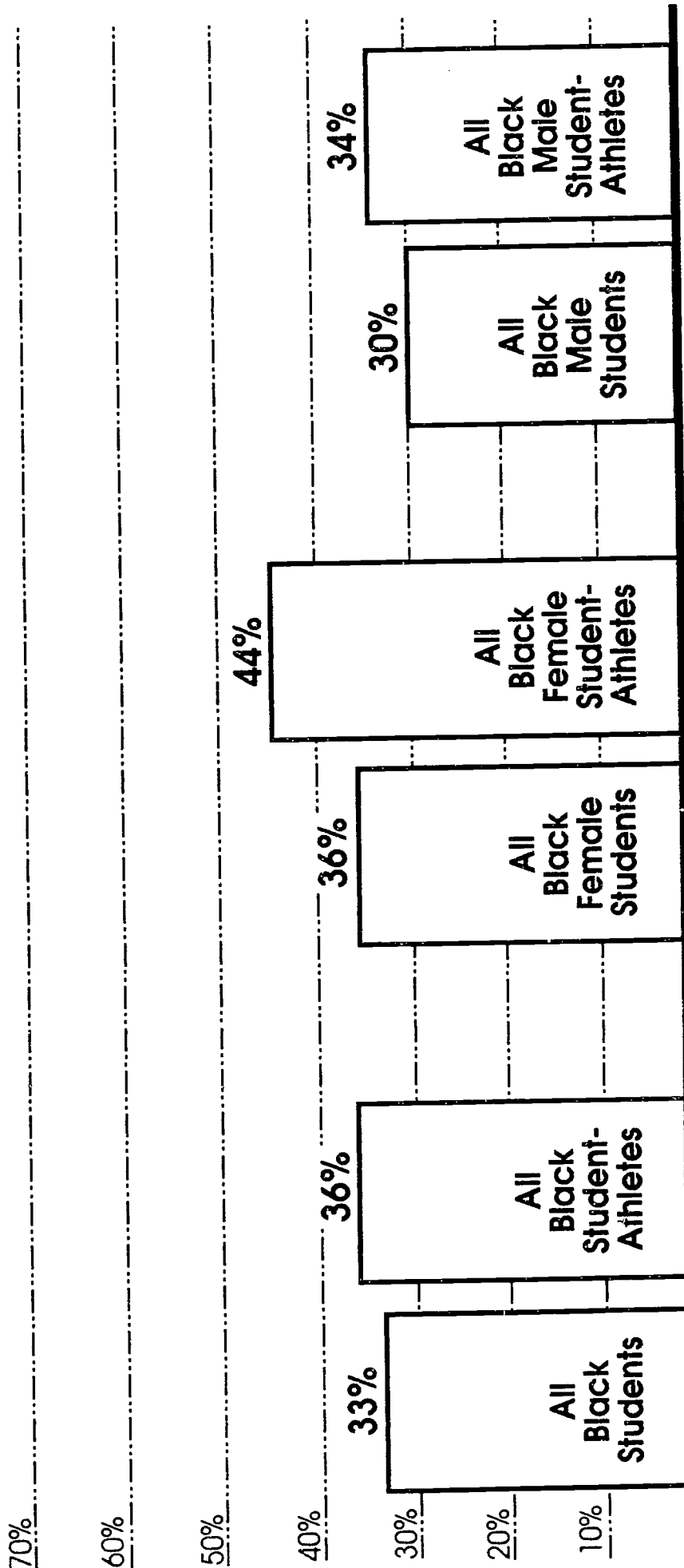

figure 1 – Students and Student-Athletes



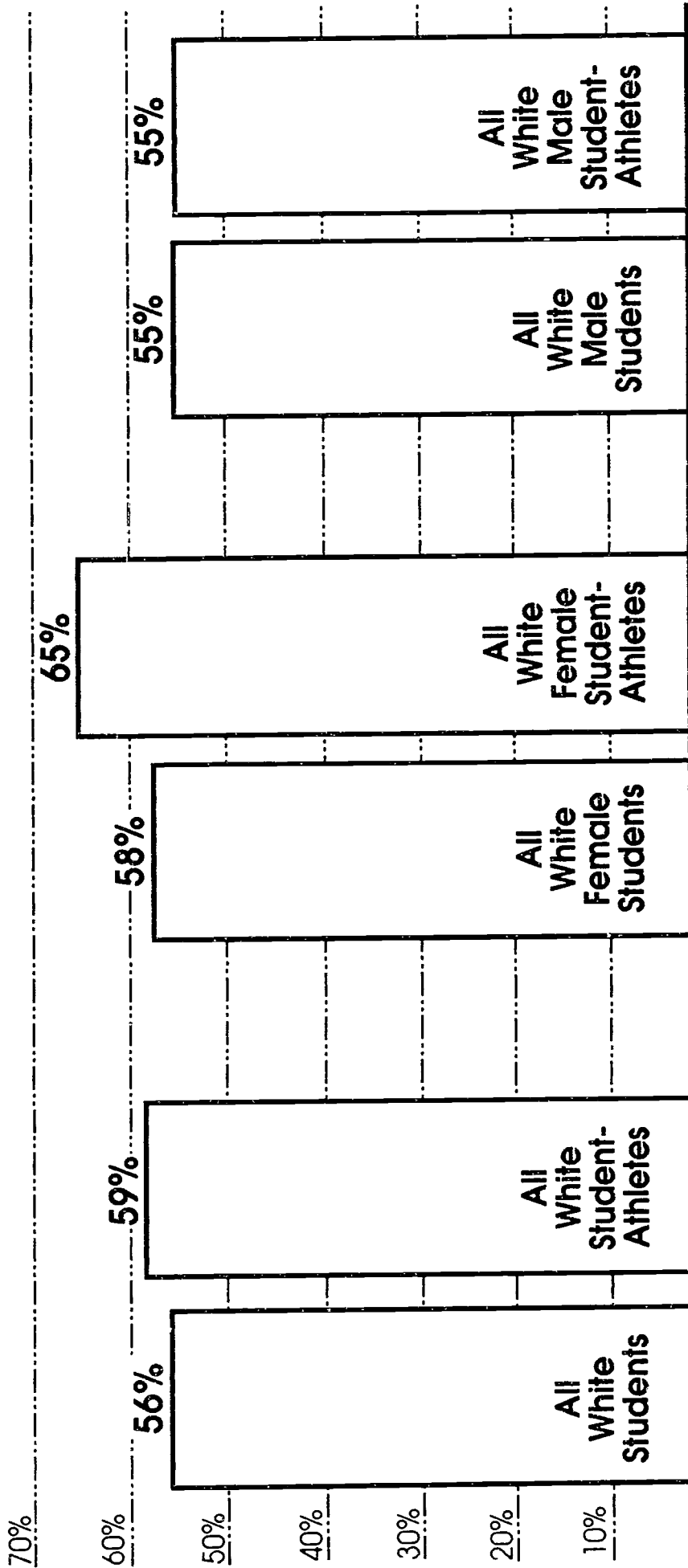
- Student-athletes graduate at a slightly lower rate than the general student body.

figure 3 – White Students and White Student-Athletes

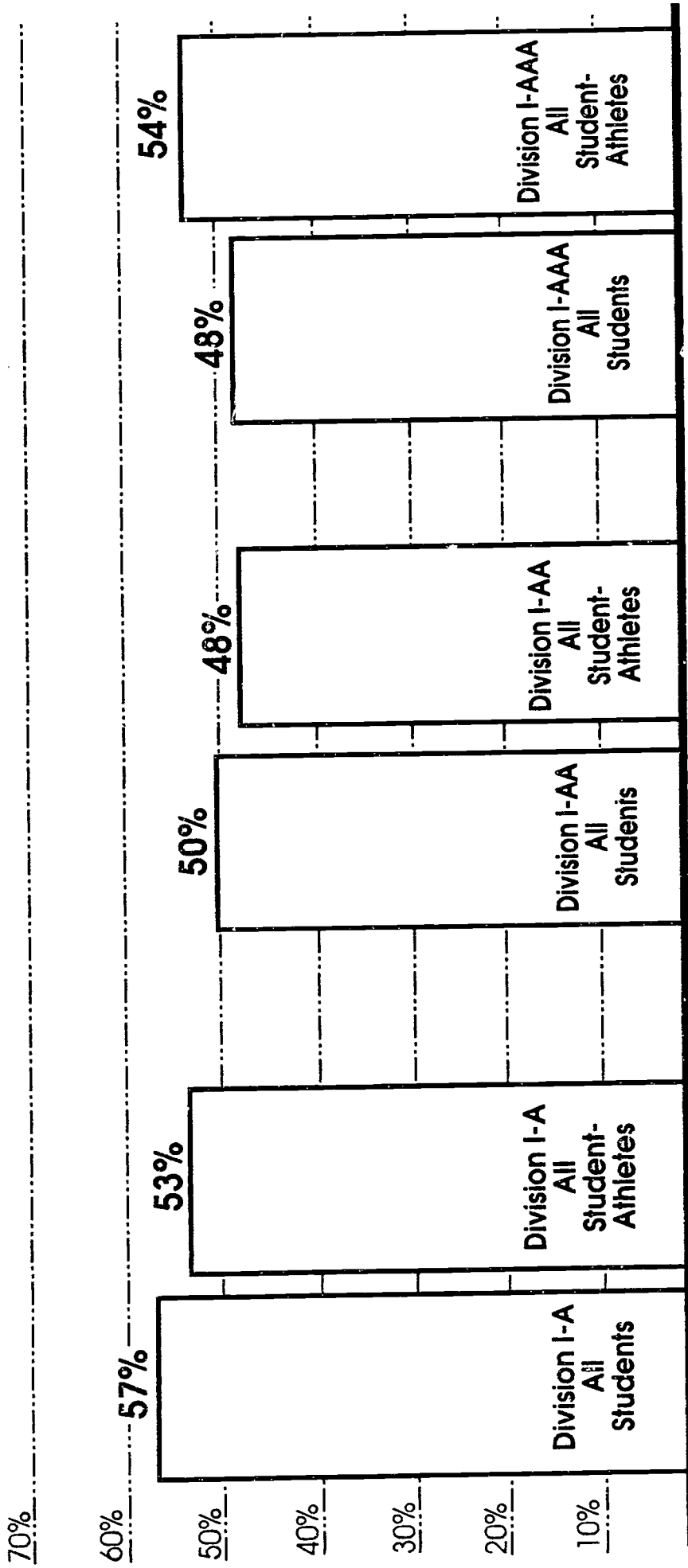

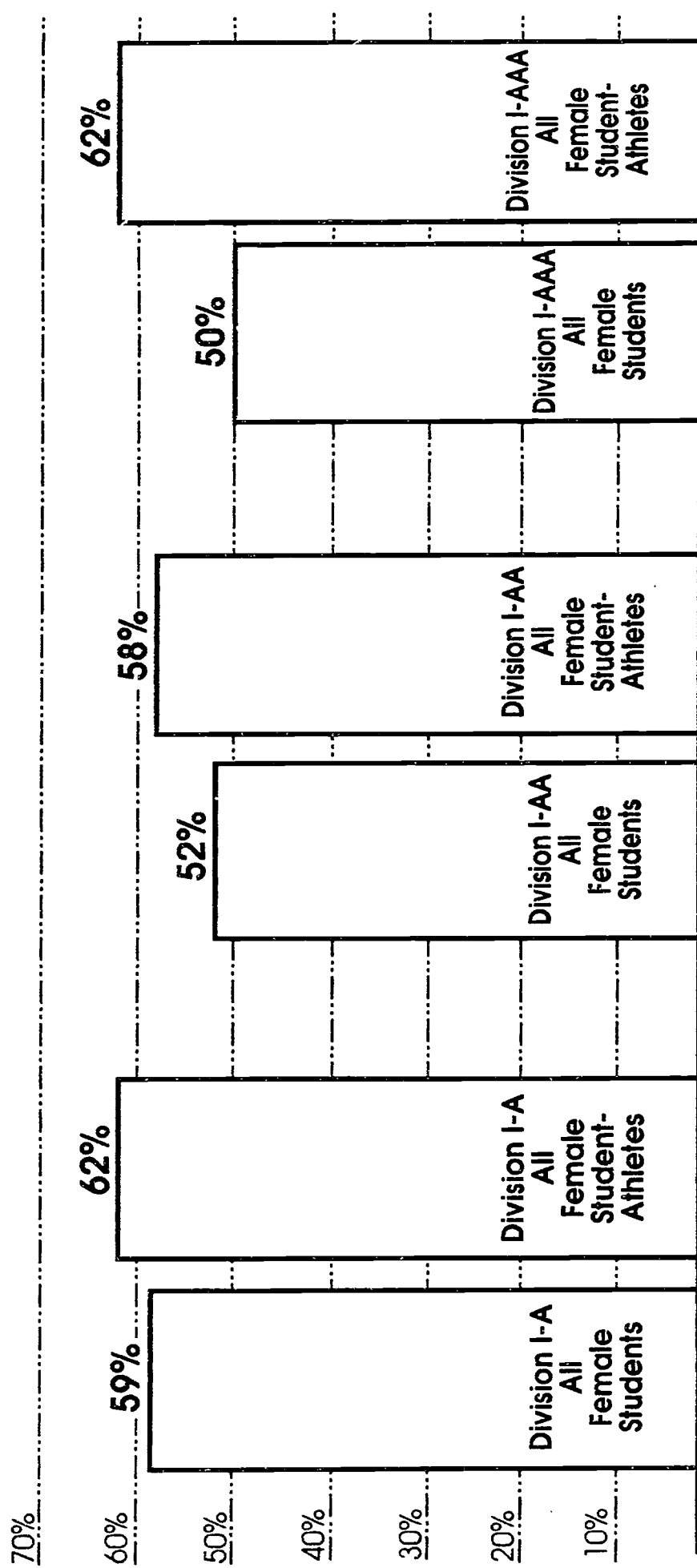

figure 4 – Students and Student-Athletes by Subdivision



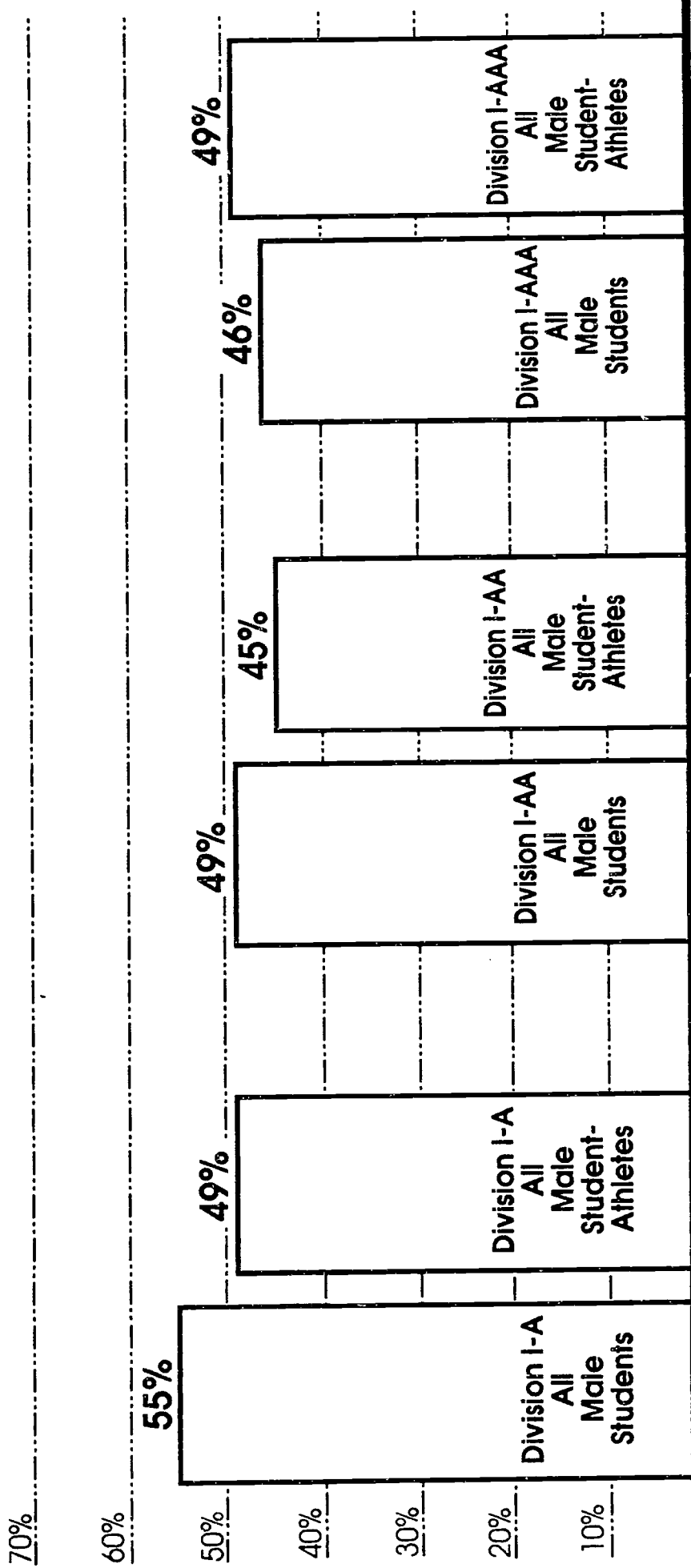

● In all Division I subdivisions, female student-athletes graduate at a higher rate than female students in general.

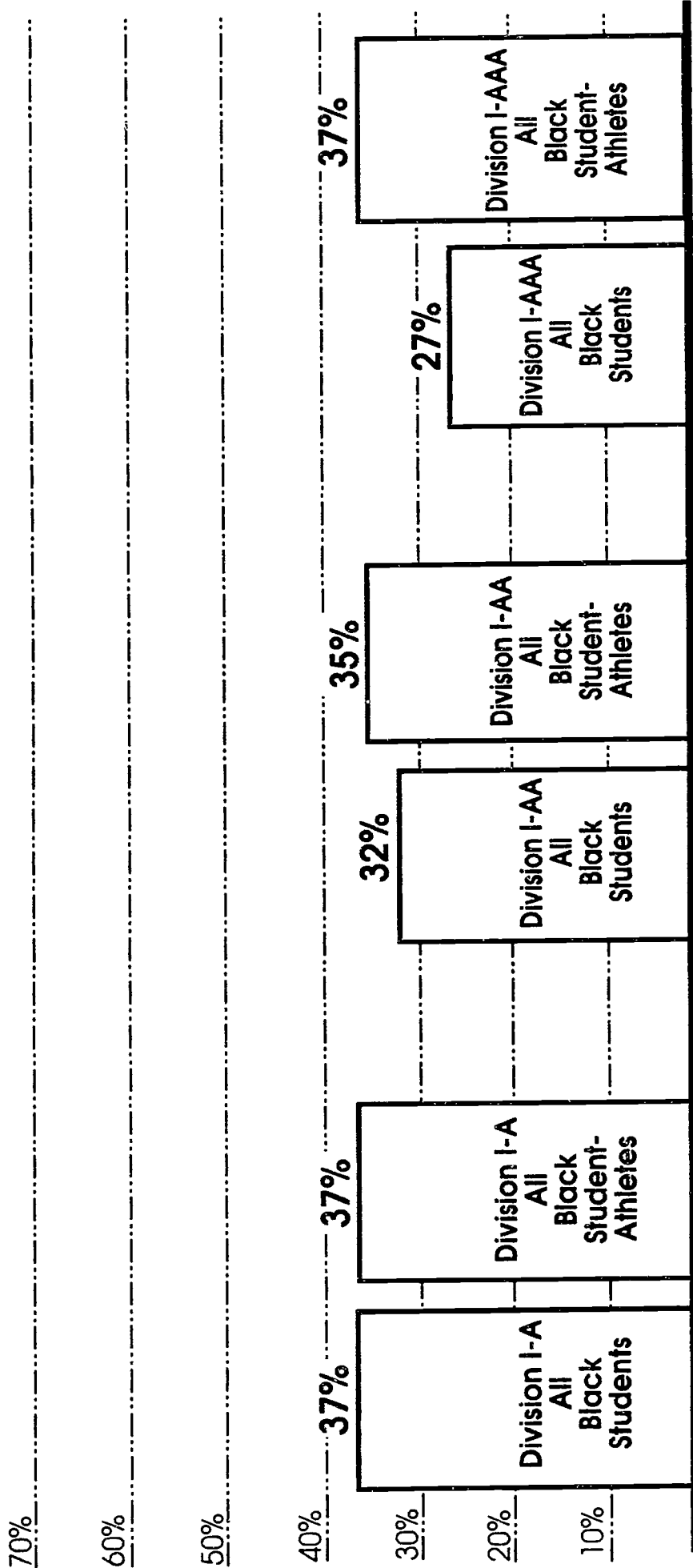
Figure 6 – Male Students and Male Student-Athletes by Subdivision



● In Divisions I-A and I-AA, male student-athletes graduate at lower rates than male students in general in their respective subdivisions.

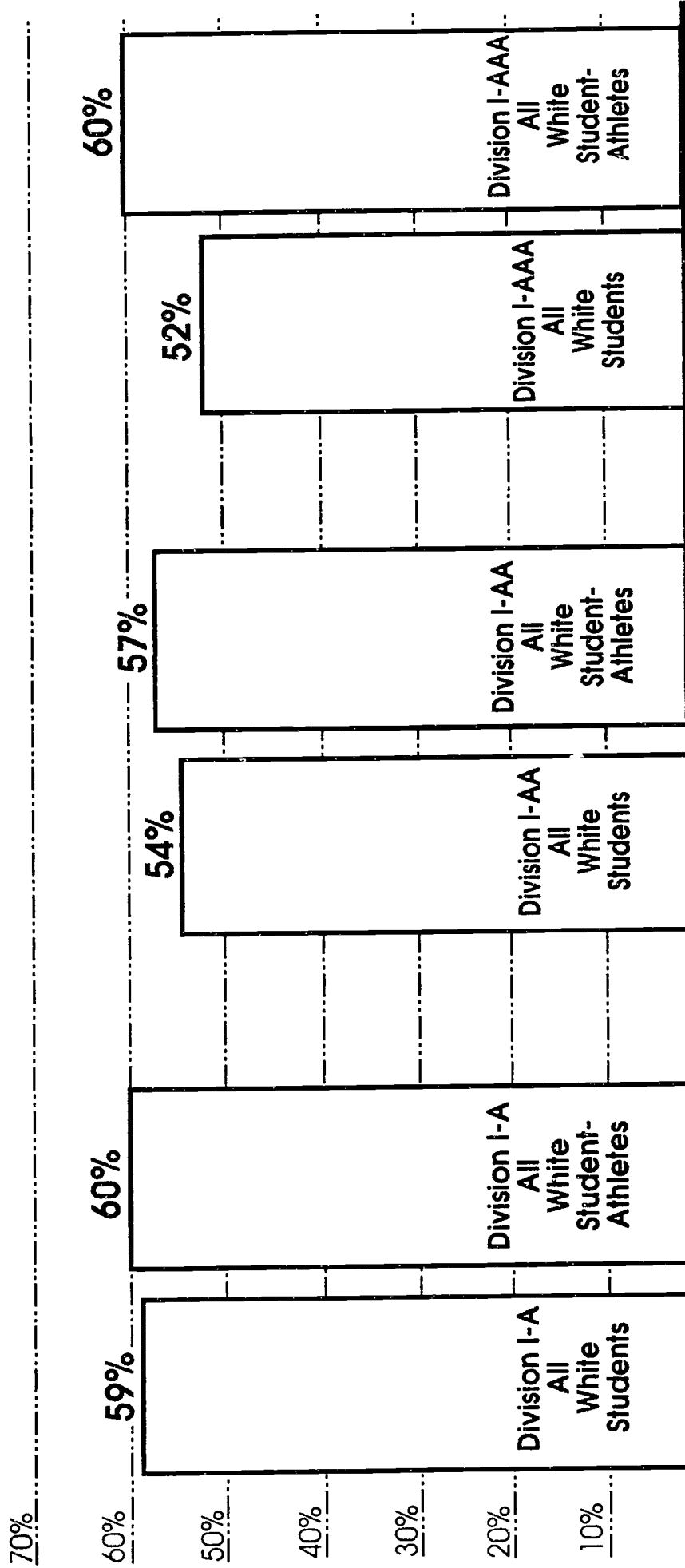
● In Division I-AAA, male student-athletes graduate at a higher rate than I-AAA male students in general.

figure 7 – Black Students and Black Student-Athletes by Subdivision



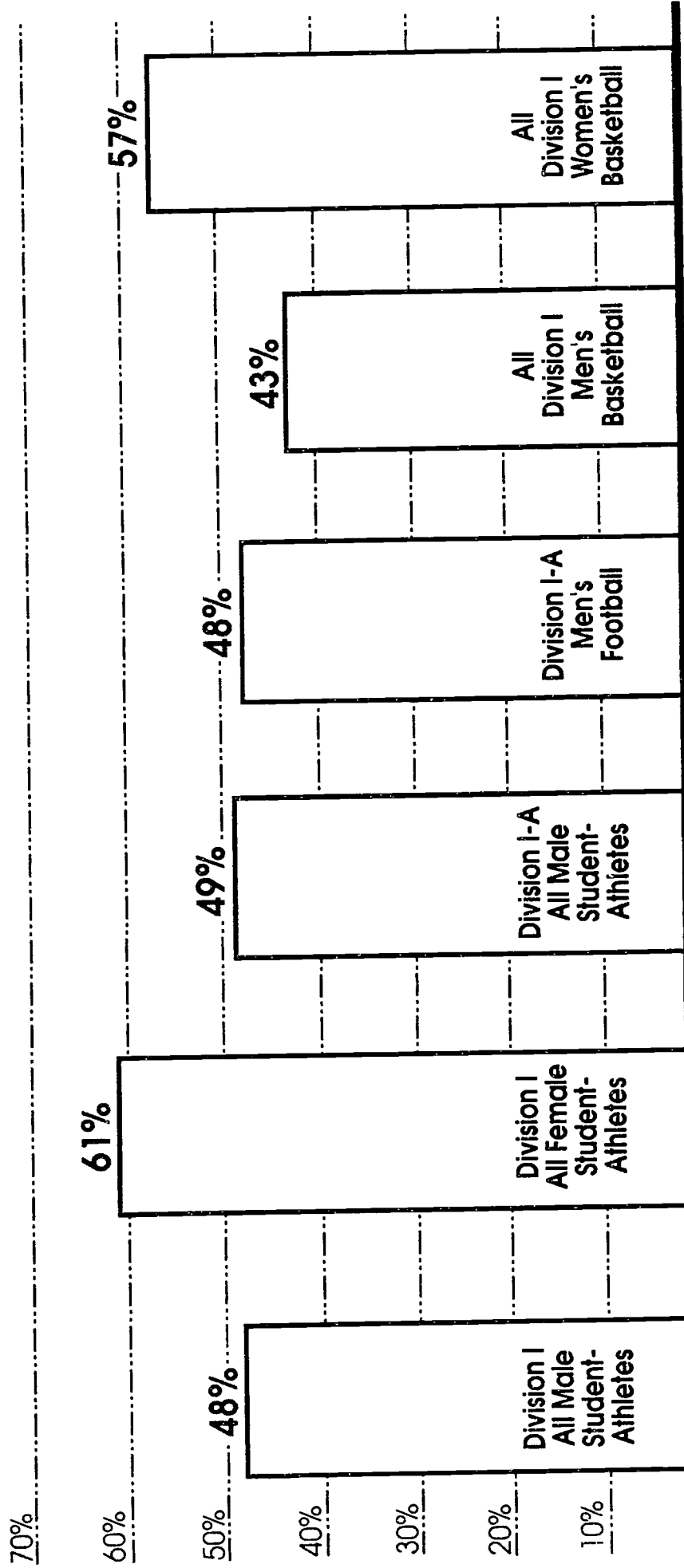
● In all Division I subdivisions, black student-athletes graduate at the same or higher rates than black students in general.

figure 8 – White Students and White Student-Athletes by Subdivision



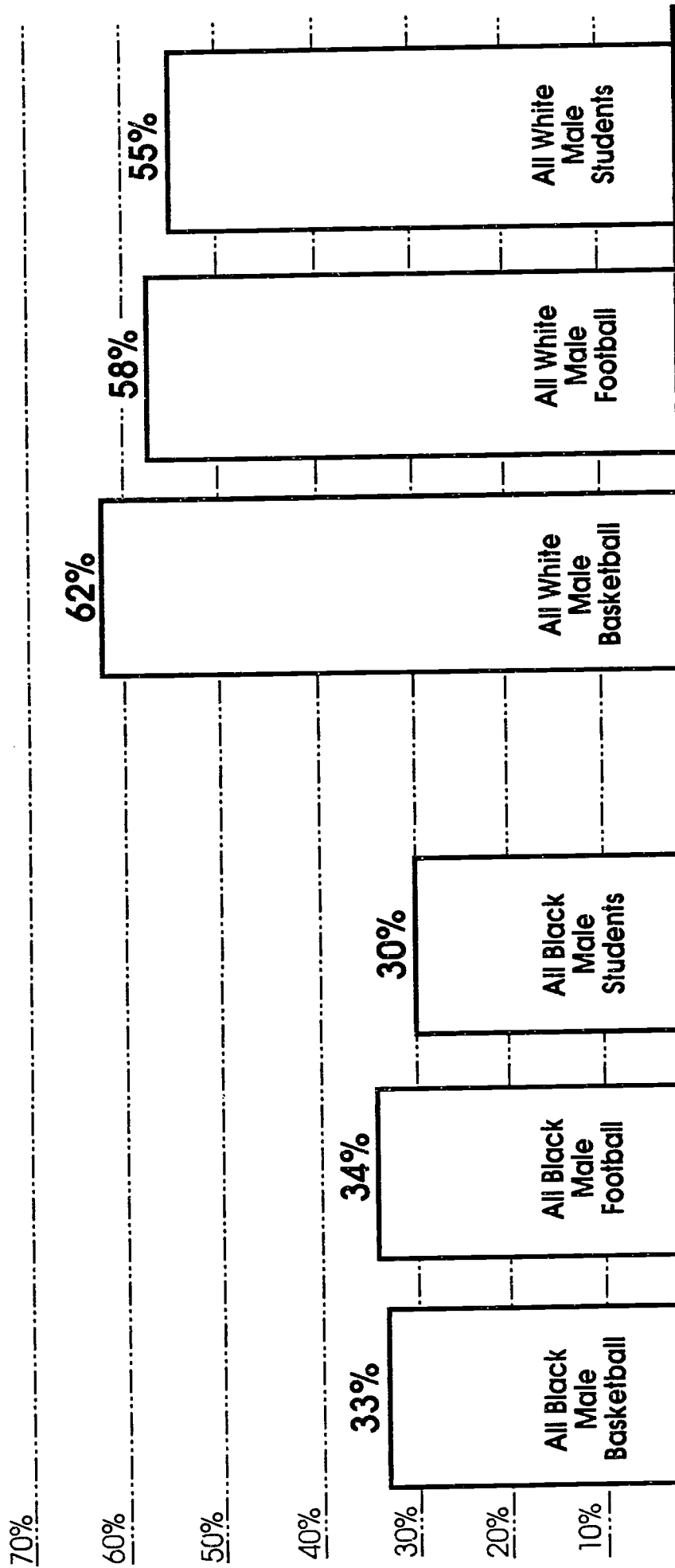
● In all Division I subdivisions, white student-athletes graduate at higher rates than white students in general.

figure 9 – Graduation Rates of Selected Sports



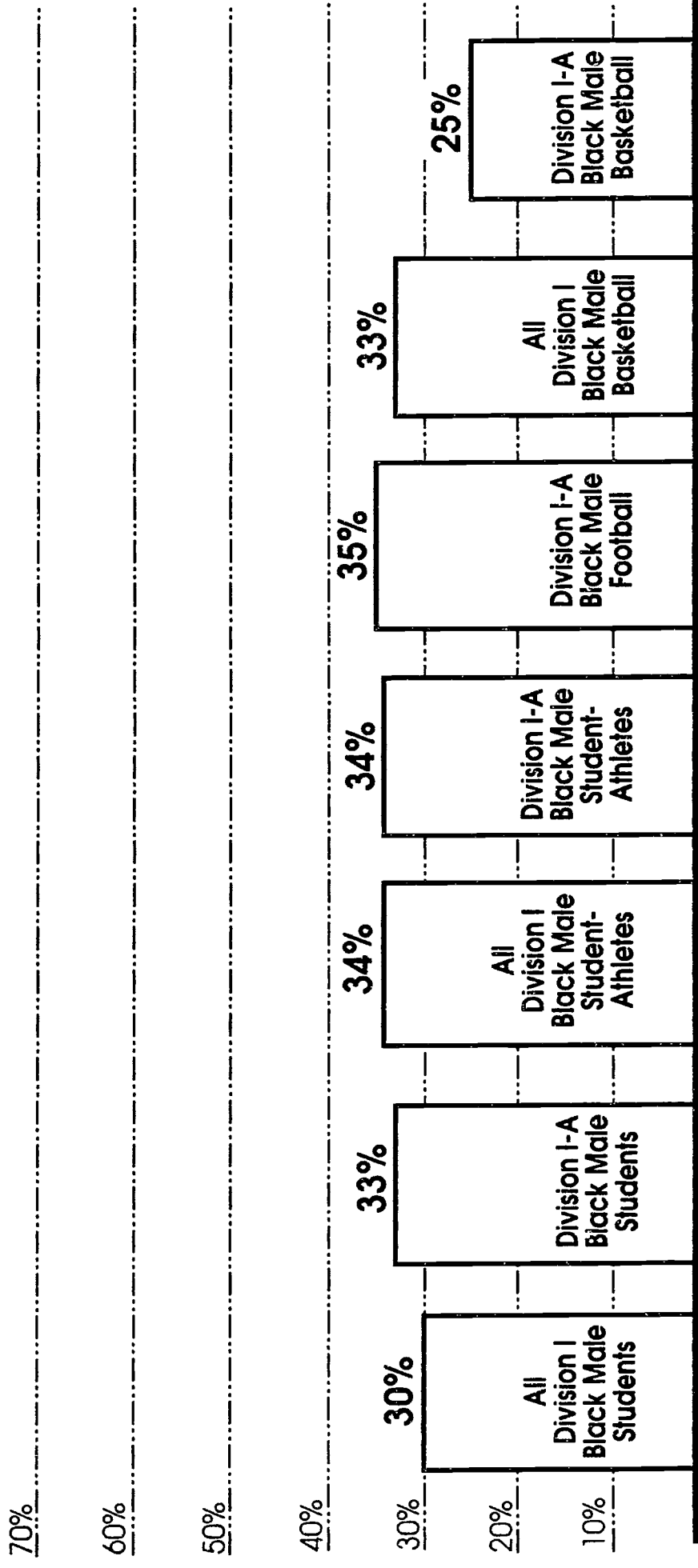

figure 10 – Selected Sports: Comparison by Race



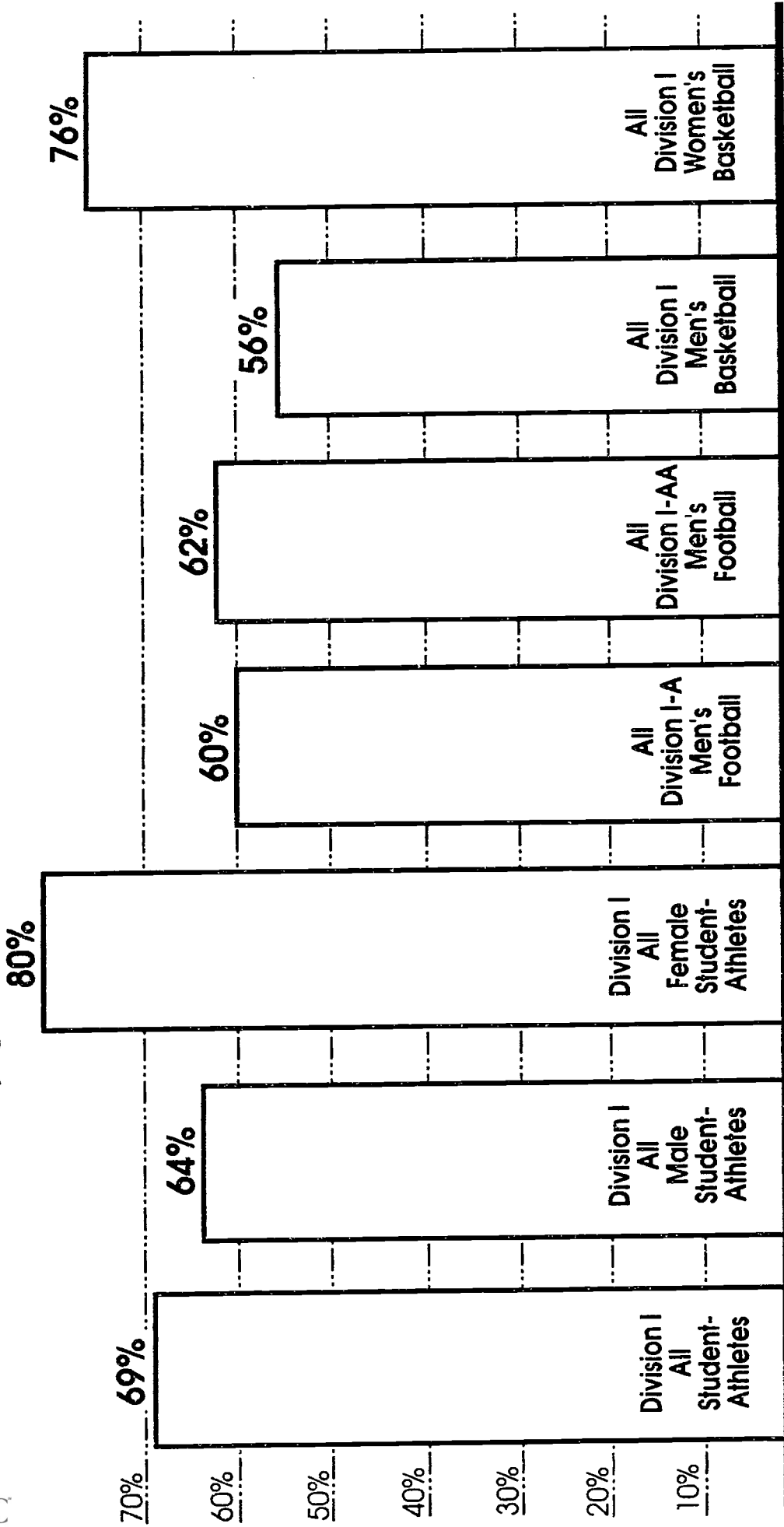
