ABSTRACT

This status report presents progress data concerning the Graduate Fellowship Program that was initiated in Washington State in 1987. The Washington State legislature enacted the Graduate Fellowship Trust Fund Program to strengthen partnerships between citizens and public four-year institutions. It does this by providing a matching grant program to assist institutions in creating endowments for funding fellowships for distinguished students. No appropriation was made till 1990. In the 1989-91 biennium, the legislature provided \$1.5 million to fund 60 fellowships: 36 at the University of Washington; 18 at Washington State University; 2 at Central Washington University; 1 at Eastern Washington University; 1 at The Evergreen State College; and 2 at Western Washington University. Specific grants are listed for each institution. (GLR)



OVERVIEW

Since its inception in 1987, the Graduate Fellowship Program has resulted in the establishment of 60 fellowships at the four-year institutions. At this point the institutions have provided private matching for all state funds that have been made available, and have proposed matching for an additional 63 fellowships.

1987-89 Biennium

In 1987 the Legislature enacted the Graduate Fellowship Trust Fund Program to strengthen partnerships between citizens and public four-year institutions by providing a matching grant program to assist institutions in creating endowments for funding fellowships for distinguished graduate students. Provisions as stated in RCW 28B.10.880 through 887 established the program but no appropriation to the trust fund was made until 1990.

1989-91 Biennium

In 1990 the Legislature provided \$1,500,000 to fund 60 fellowships (\$25,000 each). Allocation of the 60 awards among the institutions was established in the appropriations act as follows:
