ABSTRACT

The Virginia Council of Higher Education annually collects a variety of data on the activities of academic institutions in the state. This report presents data on the activities of Virginia's academic libraries during the 1990-91 academic year. Data are reported on collections, staff, expenditures, costs for monographs and periodicals, services and automation, and interlibrary loans. A short narrative summary precedes the data tables, and five sets of tables are included: a systemwide summary; separate sets for public four-year, public two-year, and independent institutions; and a ranking of all Virginia academic libraries according to 15 elements. Preface

The Council of Higher Education annually collects a variety of data on the activities of Virginia's academic institutions. This report presents data on the activities of Virginia's academic libraries during the 1990-1991 academic year. The data were derived primarily from the Council's survey, College and University Libraries, 1990-1991 and Fall 1991 (Form LB). Data on the educational and general expenditures (E&G) of the institutions were taken from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System survey, Finance, FY 1991 (IPEDS F1/F2).

Two independent institutions, Institute of Textile Technology and Virginia Seminary and College, did not respond to the Council's survey. Data for two other independent institutions, Notre Dame Apostolic Catechetical Institute and Presbyterian School of Christian Educaiton, are not included because those institutions provide library services through third-party agreements.

The responding institutions sometimes omitted specific data elements on their survey responses. These missing data are indicated by dashes [----] in the appropriate tables.

A short narrative summary precedes the data tables that show the academic libraries' activities during 1990-1991. Five sets of tables are included: a systemwide summary; separate sets for public four-year, public two-year, and independent institutions; and a ranking of all Virginia academic libraries according to fifteen data elements.

During the collection and compilation of the data contained herein, the Council staff received the full cooperation and assistance of the responding libraries. Every effort has been made to ensure that the data are as accurate and complete as possible.

## ACADEMIC LIBRARIES IN VIRGINIA, 1990-1991

During the 1990-1991 academic year, fiscal constraints restrained the growth of collections, forced staff positions to remain unfilled, and limited both expenditures and services of the academic libraries. Yet the libraries continued to respond to increased demands for information resources and services through increased reliance on electronic technology and shared resources. Compared to the previous year,

Virginia's academic library collections grew at a modest rate.

- Bookstock increased by 771,258 volumes (4.81 %)
- Periodical subscriptions decreased by 120 (-0.09 %)
- Microform pieces increased by 3,893,729 (18.63 %)

The libraries relied more heavily on part-time staff.

- Full-time staff positions decreased by 24 (-1.61 %)
- Part-time staff positions increased by 47.80 FTE (42.29%)
- 90.50 FTE staff positions remained vacant, an increase of 10.50 FTE (13.13 %)
- Student assistance decreased by 8.29 FTE (-1.80 %)

Library funding increased only slightly.

- Expenditures for materials increased by \$760,701 (2.65 %)
- Total expenditures increased by \$167,342 (0.20 %)
- Library percent of E&G expenditure remained steady at 3.48%

Increased expenditures for periodicals did not keep pace with inflation of periodical subscription prices.

- Periodical expenditures increased by \$1,291,666 (8.81 %)
- Average cost of subscriptions rose from \$115.69 to \$127.36, a one-year increase of \$10.09 %

Library service hours and circulations declined slightly.

- 5.27 million items circulated, decreasing by 14,354 items (-0.27 %)
- Average weekly service decreased from 80.9 to 80.0 hours

The libraries increasingly relied on electronic technologies.

- Membership in library networks increased by 7 libraries (13.46 %)
- Automated library catalogs now contain more than 90 percent of the libraries' book holdings
- Patron use of fee-based automated search services increased by 68,350 searches (49.33 %) while their cost decreased by \$216,704 (-28.87 %)

More library resources were shared within the Commonwealth.

- Total interlibrary loans increased by 28,139 transactions (9.24 %)
- Items lent to other Virginia libraries increased by 16,114 (22.83 %)
- Items borrowed from other Virginia libraries increased by 10,110 (24.22 %)
