ABSTRACT

Data are provided on the degrees conferred by the University and Community College System of Nevada (UCCSN) in 1991-92 and the characteristics of their recipients. The UCCSN's four two-year campuses and two four-year campuses awarded over 4,700 degrees and certificates in 1991-92. Of these, 55% were bachelor's degrees, 23% were associate degrees, and 15% were master's degrees. Business and management was the subject area in which most degrees (24%) were awarded, followed by social and behavioral sciences (17%), humanities (16%), education (14%), and health professions (12%). The majority of certificates were awarded in the areas of health professions and business, and the majority of associate degrees were awarded in liberal/general studies. The number of liberal meral studies associate degrees increased sharply since 1980, wit similar trends in degrees awarded in computer and information sciences, engineering-related technologies, health professions, law and legal studies, protective services, and precision production trades. Among bachelor's degrees conferred, business and management was the most popular major, while the majority of graduate degrees awarded were in the field of education. The bulk of the report consists of charts and tables providing data on: degrees conferred, 1980-1992; degrees by discipline; degrees by gender; degrees by racial or ethnic group; number of degrees conferred by subject area; and percent of degrees conferred by campus by gender, racial or ethnic group, and subject area. INTRODUCTION

The six instructional campuses of the University and Community College System of Nevada (UCCSN) awarded more than 4,700 certificates and degrees during 1991-92¹. More than one-half of the degrees awarded were bachelor's degrees (55%), followed by associate (23%) and master's (15%) degrees. Certificates, first professional degrees², and doctorates comprised the remaining share of degrees awarded (Table 1).

Among all degrees and certificates conferred by UCCSN campuses, business and management was the subject area in which most degrees (24%) were awarded (Figure 1). An additional 17% were awarded in social and behavioral sciences, followed by 16% in the humanities, 14% in education, 12% in health professions, and 11% in science and technology.

More than one-half of all 1992 degrees conferred were awarded to females (59%), a 12% increase since 1980 (Table 2). The majority of certificates were earned by female students (75%), and more than one-half of associate, bachelor's, and master's degrees were also awarded to females. Approximately two-thirds of the doctorates and more than one-half of the first professional degrees were conferred to males, however. The proportion of females receiving degrees has increased in all degree types except certificates since 1980.

The racial/ethnic group receiving the greatest percentage of degrees conferred in the UCCSN in 1992 was Whites at 82.0%. Blacks, Asian or Pacific Islanders, and Hispanics each received 3.7% of the degrees awarded, followed by American Indians or Alaskan Natives at 0.9% (Table 3). Non-resident alien students were awarded 2.6% of all degrees conferred in 1992. The highest percentage of degrees awarded to minority students was at the associate (14.2%) and certificate (13.1%) levels.

During 1992, the majority of certificates were awarded in the areas of health professions and business. The diversity of subject areas in which certificates are awarded has increased among all community college campuses since 1980 (Table 4).

More than forty percent of the 1992 associate degrees were awarded in liberal/general studies. The number of associate degrees awarded in this discipline has increased rapidly

since 1980 (Table 5). Other subject areas in which the number of associate degrees awarded are rising include computer and information sciences, engineering-related technologies, health professions, law and legal studies, protective services, and precision production trades.

Among bachelor's degrees conferred, business and management was the subject of choice for the majority of the 1992 graduates. Education, health professions, and social sciences and history were also popular subject areas for students receiving bachelor's degrees during 1992 (Table 6).

The majority of graduate degrees were awarded in the field of education during 1992. Approximately one-third of master's and doctorate degrees were awarded in education (Table 7, 8). A large number of master's degrees were also conferred in the areas of business and management, engineering, and public administration. Among doctorate degrees, a significant share were awarded in the physical sciences and biological/life sciences as well.



Figure 1. UCCSN Degrees Conferred, by Discipline









Figure 2. UCCSN Certificates and Associate Degrees Conferred, by Discipline
1980









Figure 3. UCCSN Bachelor's Degrees Conferred, by Discipline







Figure 4. UCCSN Graduate Degrees Conferred, by Discipline




