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ABSTRACT

Compiled to assist Pennsylvania community colleges in analyzing their financial performance in relation to their peers, this report contains financial and historical data for the 14 colleges in the state for fiscal year (FY) 1992-93 and projections for FY 1993-94 and 1994-95. Section I examines reimbursement requests for 1992-93 in terms of enrollments, operating reimbursements for operating and stipend expenses, and capital reimbursements for capital, rentals, and debt service. Section II provides 1993-94 rebudget request data for such items as enrollments, operating net reimbursable costs, state reimbursements, and capital deferred and non-deferred items, while section III presents 1994-95 budget requests for these same categories. Section IV presents historical systemwide data for FY 1984-85 to 1994-95, including full-time equivalent enrollments, state reimbursement of operating and capital costs, comparisons of net and gross costs, and capital reimbursement requested versus capital reimbursed. Section V provides similar data by individual college and also includes stipend enrollments by category for FY 1984-85 to 1994-95 and state reimbursement for operating with stipend reimbursement as a percentage of the total for FY 1984-85 to 1994-95. Section VI presents data on operating expenditures by source and by category, book value and replacement values by college, fund balances, scholarship expenditures and interest for FY 1992-93. The final section presents data on community college capital projects financed through state public school building authority or local authority or bank. (KP)

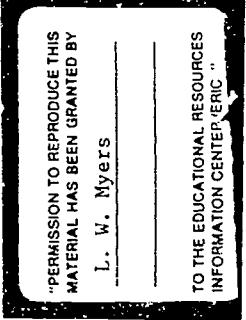

PREFACE

This report has been designed to assist individual community colleges in comparing their financial performance to that of their peer institutions in Pennsylvania. Comparisons against other institutions and in historical perspective can provide a starting point for identifying strengths and weaknesses and thus can help in the process of institutional renewal.

Although this report has the same limitations as previous editions, we have begun an effort to clarify and better identify the sources of data and to more clearly indicate in the table headings whether data are estimated or actual. We have also clarified some column headings within tables, in order to provide more accurate information.

All financial data for fiscal year 1992-93 have been taken either from IPEDS reports submitted to the U. S. Department of Education in October 1993, or from reimbursement claim forms submitted by the colleges to the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) in February 1994, seven months after the end of the fiscal year. For fiscal year 1993-94, data are from estimates submitted by the colleges to PDE in their "Rebudget Requests" in August 1993. For 1994-95, estimates shown are from budget requests for 1994-95, submitted by the colleges in September 1993.

We also must caution the reader that all data for 1993-94 and 1994-95 are estimates, and that the unusual circumstance of a sudden slowing of overall enrollment growth will undoubtedly produce significant differences between estimates and actual performance for those years.

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DEFINITIONS

OPERATING COST TUITION COMPLIANCE

Gross Operating Costs minus the following: compensatory fees, miscellaneous income offsetting expenditures, full cost recovery programs, federal programs, state programs, auxiliary enterprise expense, community service expense, inter-collegiate athletic expense, student activity expense (non-educational), non-inventory capital purchases, and capital portion of rental expenditures.

Student tuition is limited to one-third of operating costs.

NET REIMBURSABLE OPERATING COST BASE

Operating costs minus bad debt expense, unused vacation expense, out of state tuition, tuition remission, Federal funds, and full costs recovery programs.

OPERATING COST

Reimbursement is one third (1/3) of net operating costs base. Dollar limitations are the lesser 1/3 of net operating or (EFTS divided by 2 times state maximum).

EFTS = EQUATED FULL TIME STUDENTS

Equated full time enrollment = number of full time students plus total of part time student credit hours divided by 12.

Full time student	-	12 semester credit hours or more
Part time student	-	less than 12 credit semester hours
Non credit courses	-	15 hours of classroom study is equated to one semester credit hour - for courses requiring laboratory study, each 30 hours of laboratory study is one semester hour credit.

Fiscal year begins July 1 and ends June 30th the following year.
(Fiscal Year 1994 begins July 1, 1994, etc.)
