#### **ABSTRACT**

This report provides basic descriptive information about the 100 largest school districts in the United States and its outlying areas. Almost one in four public school students in the country is served by one of these districts. Characteristics, which include average and median school size, pupil/teacher ratios, number of high school graduates, enrollment of special education students and minorities, and selected fiscal data, are presented in 10 basic tables. Preceding these are Tables A through C, which establish the context of education in these largest districts. Although these districts represent fewer than 1 percent of all school districts, they educate nearly 23 percent of students. Fifty of the 99 districts that report racial and ethnic information have more than 50 percent minority enrollment. These 100 largest districts employ nearly 23 percent of the nation's public school teachers and account for more than 19 percent of all public high school graduates. Appendix A lists the nation's 500 largest districts with some basic data, while Appendix B lists them alphabetically. Appendixes C and D are representations of the data collection instruments used in the Common Core of Data surveys on which this report is based. One map locates the 100 largest districts. (SLD)



### Highlights

Information collected by the National Center for Education Statistics for the Common Core of Data, relating to public schools and school districts in the United States and outlying areas, indicates that during the 1991-92 school year

- The 100 largest public school districts, representing fewer than 1 percent of all school districts in the nation, were responsible for the education of about 23 percent of all public school students;
- About one-third of these districts were located in three states;
- Of the 99 districts for which student racial-ethnic information was reported, 50 had over 50 percent minority enrollment. However, in 21 of the 99 districts no single racial-ethnic group comprised a majority of the student population;
- Schools in the 100 largest districts tended to be about 39 percent larger than the average American school and to have a slightly higher pupil/teacher ratio than those in other school districts;
- The 100 largest districts employed about 23 percent of the nation's public school teachers, and accounted for about 17 percent of all public schools and over 19 percent of public high school graduates;
- Among the 20 largest districts, 4 have increased in size by 25 percent or more since 1986: Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach Counties in Florida and Clark County in Nevada. Puerto Rico, Chicago, and Detroit have registered significant declines in membership; and
- Current expenditures per pupil in the 100 largest school districts range from a low of \$2,586 in Granite School District (Utah) to a high of \$8,389 in Newark, New Jersey Public Schools.

#### Introduction

This publication provides basic descriptive information about the 100 largest school districts in the United States and its outlying areas. Almost one in every four public school students in this nation is served by one of these largest districts, which are distinguished from smaller districts by differences in several other characteristics in addition to sheer size. The characteristics noted in this report include average and median school size, pupil/teacher ratios, number of high school graduates, number of pupils receiving special education services, minority enrollment as a proportion of total enrollment, and selected fiscal data. This information is found in the 10 basic tables. Preceding the basic tables are text tables for the purpose of establishing a meaningful context for the information on the 100 largest districts. Following the basic tables, appendix A lists the 500 largest school districts with some identifying information and basic statistical data. Appendix B is an alphabetical list of the 500 largest school districts, and appendices C and D are representations of the data collection instruments used in the Common Core of Data surveys. The information presented in the basic tables comes from the responses to these surveys.

In the 1991-92 school year there were 16,666 local education agencies in the United States and its outlying areas, 15,178 of which were categorized as "regular school districts." (The others were a variety of agencies providing specialized or cooperative educational services.) The 100 largest districts were chosen for attention in this report because they serve such a substantial percentage of our nation's school-age youth and because their size and other characteristics set them apart from the other 16,000 plus public school districts in the country.

The 100 largest school districts serve 9,823,729 students, or about 23 percent of the total public elementary and secondary school population of over 42 million students in the more than 16,000 local education agencies (LEAs) in the nation (see table A). The largest school district in the country is New York City Public Schools, with 962,269 students in 1,008 schools. The second largest is the Puerto Rico Department of Education, with 642,392 students in 1,590 schools. Los Angeles Unified School District, with 636,964 students in 635 schools, is third in size (see table 1). The 500 largest districts (about 3 percent of all school districts) serve 18,060,434 students, or about 42 percent of the total public elementary and secondary school student population in the United States (see table A).

For a more comprehensive picture of the distribution of school districts of all sizes nationally, and the number of students served, see table B or consult the related data sources listed at the end of the text. From table B, for example, one can learn that regular school districts having a membership of 7,500 or more are responsible for the education of over half (54.4 percent) of all public school students in the nation, although they comprise only 6.5 percent of all regular school districts.

This publication is the fourth in the current series of reports on the largest school districts in the nation. Previously published were Characteristics of the 25 Most Populous Cities' School Systems and the 25 Largest Public Elementary and Secondary School Districts: Fall 1986, released in September 1988; Characteristics of the 55 Largest Public Elementary and Secondary School Districts in the United States: 1987-88, published in May 1989; Characteristics of the 100 Largest Public School Districts in the United States: 1988-89, published in April 1991; and Characteristics of the 100 Largest Public School Districts in the United States: 1990-91, published in April 1993. ### Where Are the 109 Largest School Districts?

The District of Columbia, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico each have only one school district for the entire jurisdiction, and each is represented among the 100 largest districts. Alaska, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, New Jersey, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Oregon, Washington, and Wisconsin each have one district among the 100 largest. States with multiple districts among the 100 largest are Florida and Texas, with 13 each; California with 10; Georgia and Maryland with 5 each; Louisiana and Virginia with 4 each; Alabama, North Carolina, Ohio, Tennessee, and Utah with 3 each; and Arizona, Colorado, Nevada, New York, Pennsylvania, and South Carolina with 2 each (see figure 1).

As expected, these 100 school districts tend to be in cities and counties having large populations, with administrative offices typically in large central cities or populous "edge" cities. Many of the districts are in states where school districts are coterminous with counties. The district names indicate that 49 of them are identified with cities, 42 with counties or parishes, and 3 with state-level jurisdictions. Many of the districts are located in coastal states, and several are located in the large cities of the north central states.

## How Do These Districts Compare With the Average School District?

#### **General Characteristics**

According to information submitted to the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) by education officials in state education agencies, the average school district in America has about 5 schools. 138 teachers, and 2,568 students, with an average school size of about 496 students and a mean pupil/teacher ratio of about 18.6 to 1. Among the 100 largest districts, the means are 142 schools, 5,216 teachers, and 98,237 students, yielding an average school size of about 690, and a pupil/teacher ratio of 18.8 to 1. Nationally, the number of high school graduates per year as a percentage of total school membership is about 5.3 percent. For the 100 largest school districts the average is about 4.4 percent (see table A).

#### **Student Body Composition**

A substantial number of these districts have a disproportionately high percentage of racial-ethnic minorities in their pupil population, compared with a typical school district. Using school district data from the Office for Civil Rights, NCES estimates that the 100 largest districts, with about 23 percent of the nation's pupils, have slightly more than 40 percent of the 13.1 million minority students in the country.\*

Among the 99 districts for which student racial-ethnic data are reported, some 50 districts report 50 percent or more of their students as white, non-Hispanic. Of these 50 districts, 21 report minority representation of less than 25 percent of their student body, and 13 of them have less than 20 percent minority students.

In 22 districts, half or more of the membership is black, non-Hispanic; 6 districts report that the majority of their students are Hispanic; and in one district, most of the students are Asian/Pacific Islanders. In 21 districts, no single racial-ethnic group comprises more than 50 percent of the student population (see table 9).

#### Membership Trends

The largest school districts in the United States have for the most part remained relatively stable in size over the past 5 years, although there are some exceptions. When 1991-92 membership is compared with that of 1986-87 (see table C)

- The 20 largest districts, in both years, have accounted for approximately 12 percent of the students in the nation's public elementary and secondary schools. In the fall of 1986, these 20 districts enrolled 4,850,406 pupils out of a national total (including outlying areas) of 40,499,050. In 1991-92, the top 20 had 5,067,587 students out of 42,800,693.
- One district, Palm Beach County, Florida, has displaced Jefferson County (Louisville), Kentucky, from the list of the 20 largest districts by moving from its 1986-87 position as 25th in size to 18th in 1991-92. Some other large districts in Florida (Dade and Broward Counties) also have shown noteworthy increases, as has Clark County, Nevada.



<sup>\*</sup>The number of students in different racial-ethnic categories is reported on the school universe survey of the Common Core of Data (CCD), and these school-level numbers are then aggregated to the school district level. Although there were sufficient school-level data to calculate student racial-ethnic enrollment figures for 90 of the 100 largest school districts, reporting from schools in other districts was not complete enough to be able to calculate national distributions. National racial-ethnic data are, therefore, taken from the most currently available (fall, 1990) Office for Civil Rights (OCR) report, which provided racial-ethnic data for a total of 99 school districts. The OCR data show a national estimate of the total number of minority students in all the public school districts (13.1 million) and the number of minority students in each of the 100 largest districts. These figures were divided by national public school membership and total membership in the 100 largest districts to get a percentage of minority students in the nation's public schools.

• Many of the districts serving large cities have experienced some losses, with Detroit and Chicago registering the sharpest declines in proportion to their size. Puerto Rico, not a city district, shows a 5.5 percent loss over the 5-year period, as well.

### Methodology

The primary source of data for this report is the 1991-92 Common Core of Data (CCD). Information was reported to NCES by state education agencies in the spring of 1992. There are four CCD surveys collecting basic descriptive data on public education in the nation: nonfiscal data are gathered through the school ("Public School Universe" survey), local education agency ("Education Agency Universe" survey), and state forms ("State Nonfiscal Survey"); fiscal data are gathered at the state level by NCES and at the local level in the F-33 series of the Census of Local Governments by the Governments Division of the Bureau of the Census. All responses for the CCD surveys are provided by a CCD coordinator in each state education agency. Local level fiscal data are provided directly to the Census Bureau by state and local government officials. The information for the tables is taken from the "Public School Universe" and the "Education Agency Universe" collections. Since the information is supplied by state education agencies, any item of data missing for one school district is generally missing for other districts in the same state. For the calculation of national or subnational averages, data were obtained from the "State Nonfiscal Survey." Wherever this alternative source has been used, the information is footnoted or explained in the text.

#### **Response Rates**

Notwithstanding the item nonresponse situations cited below, most of these data represent school district-level figures from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and five outlying areas: American Samoa, Guam, Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.

### Item Nonresponse

The following nonresponse situations in the CCD school and agency universe surveys relate to information presented in this report: No teacher counts—Massachusetts and Michigan; no racial-ethnic counts—Georgia, Missouri, Virginia, and Puerto Rico; and no special education Individual Education Plan counts (or zero entered in every record)—Kansas, Kentucky, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Puerto Rico, Vermont, Virginia, and Washington.

### **Definitions**

Graduates—Students who completed the course of public elementary and secondary education offered by the school district and received a regular high school diploma as defined by state law or policy during the period September 1990 through August 1991.

Pupil/teacher ratio—The ratio of pupils to teachers in the school district, based on the total number of pupils and the total full-time-equivalent (FTE) number of teachers reported in the schools associated with the school district.



**Public school**—An institution which provides educational services and has the following characteristics:

- Has one or more grade groups (prekindergarten through grade 12) or is ungraded;
- Has one or more teachers to give instruction;
- Is located in one or more buildings or sites;
- Has an assigned administrator;
- · Receives public funds as primary support; and
- Is operated by an education agency.

Pupils in membership—Count of all students whose names have been entered on the roll during a given school year, minus those whose names have been withdrawn on or before the closest school day to October 1. Membership counts at the district level may include students for whom the district is providing educational services through some other agency or institution.

Schools having membership—Schools at which students are counted for administrative purposes; even though the students may attend one or more other schools for all or part of their school day.

Teachers—Sum of full-time-equivalent (FTE) count of teachers by school for all schools in a school district.

#### **Basic Tables**

Table 1 presents basic data—numbers of students, teachers, 1991 graduates, and schools—for each of the 100 largest districts. Also shown in table 1 is information to fully identify each school district, since the name of the district is not always sufficient for this purpose. On this and all the other tables, the districts are shown in order of size (pupils in membership as of October 1991). Since the districts are arrayed by number of pupils, it is easy to note the differences in the numbers of teachers, graduates, and schools as they relate to districts of similar size. For example, although the Cobb County School District has fewer students than Long Beach Unified, it has more teachers and graduates. Fairfax County Public Schools, though smaller in size than the Dallas Independent School District, has more graduates.

**Table 2** shows the number of schools in the 100 largest districts, by type of school. All but two of the districts have at least one specialized school devoted to special, vocational, or alternative education.

**Table 3** shows the numbers of students assigned to the schools that are in the categories specified in table 2. It should be noted that students attending a specialized school are often counted at their (regular) home school rather than at the specialized school they attend. It can be seen from these tables that districts vary widely in their use of specialized versus general schools in educating students with special needs. The number of students having Individual Education Plans (IEP) in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act-Part B is shown in the last column of table 3, for school districts in states reporting those figures to NCES.

Since pupil membership at the school level is necessary for determining school categories in tables 4 through 9, only schools having membership, or "regular" schools having membership, as specified in the table, are used in the data sets from which these tables are derived.

Table 4 provides information on school characteristics in the 100 districts by displaying an array showing school size (pupils in membership) at different percentile levels, as well as mean school size for each district (computed using regular schools having membership). According to this table, median school sizes range from a low of 310 pupils (St. Louis City) to a high of 1,153 (Santa Ana Unified) for these districts. The largest school in these districts is a 4,999 student school in the Dade County School District. Looking more closely at Dade County, the table shows that 25 percent of the schools have a pupil membership of 711 or fewer, and 25 percent have a membership of 1,230 or more. Dividing all the students in regular schools by the number of such schools yields a mean, or average, size of 1,110.6 students. If all the regular schools in Dade County were listed by size, the school at the mid-point on the list would have 928 pupils in membership. The median, therefore, is 928.

**Table 5** gives data on the number of students assigned to graded (three categories) and ungraded classes. In accounting for their students, 47 of the 100 largest districts assign all students to numbered grades and 53 use the "ungraded" status for students in some settings, such as special



education, vocational education, and other specialized and alternative programs. In this table, students assigned to all types of schools are counted in the grade for which they are reported.

Table 6 deals with questions people frequently have about the number of "elementary schools" and "high schools" in any selection of school districts. Since nearly every conceivable grade span is found among the nearly 14,000 schools in the 100 largest districts, the following four categories are used: primary (low grade of prekindergarten to 3; high grade up to 8), middle (low grade 4 to 7; high grade 4 to 9), high (low grade 7 to 12; high grade 12), and other (all other configurations). Although 90 of these school districts have some schools in the "other" category, only in the Puerto Rico school system is the *number* very high (229, or 14.5 percent). Several districts that have fewer pupils than Puerto Rico, however, have higher *percentages* of schools in this category. Districts in this group are Volusia County, Florida (19.1 percent), Lee County, Florida (17.5 percent), Escambia County, Florida (14.7 percent), and Jefferson County, Alabama (17.0 percent). The school counts in tables 6 through 10 include only schools having regularly assigned membership.

Table 7 shows median pupil/teacher ratios for the schools found in the categories established in table 6. Since teacher counts by school were not available for Detroit or Boston, no pupil/teacher ratio could be calculated for the schools in these districts. Among the 100 largest districts, the median pupil/teacher ratio for all schools in a district varied from 13.3 in St. Louis, Missouri, to 26.6 in Granite School District in Utah.

Table 8 gives the number of schools in each district in five percentage categories of minority concentration, as well as the overall minority student percentage for each district as a whole. In this report, minority is defined as all other than white non-Hispanic. In districts serving large central cities, it is not uncommon for two-thirds or more of the schools to have over 60 percent minority membership. Racial-ethnic data by school were not available for the school districts in Georgia, Virginia, or Puerto Rico.

Table 9 shows the percentage of students in the entire district by specific racial-ethnic category. As in table 8, racial-ethnic data from CCD surveys were not available for districts in some states. Table 9 also shows the number of students eligible for free lunch. Responses in this data category were available for only 78 districts in 41 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. Among these districts, the percentage of students eligible for free lunch under a federal program range from 1.2 (Orange County, Florida) to 94.9 percent (Puerto Rico).

Table 10 relates student data from the CCD surveys to fiscal data from the F-33 series of the Census of Local Governments done by the Governments Division of the Bureau of the Census. In this table, fiscal year 1991 revenue receipts and current expenditures are shown for each school district. Current expenditure per pupil is calculated using fall 1990 membership as reported to NCES for CCD. The per pupil expenditures shown in this table range from a low of \$2,586 in Granite School District (Utah) to a high of \$8,389 in the Newark, New Jersey Public Schools.


