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## ABSTRACT

This report provides a single-year rate and a 3-year average of the Oklahoma college-going rate. The average linear college-going rate for Oklahoma colleges in 1993-94 was 43.9 percent of the Oklahoma high school graduates from 1990-91, 1991-92, and 1992-93. Of 1992-93 high school graduates, 44.7 percent went directly to an Oklahoma college the following academic year. Combining those students who are attending directly out of high school with those students who have delayed entry for 1 year or more (the combined college-going rate) resulted in a rate of 70.1 percent of the high school graduates from 1990-91, 1991-92, and 1992-93. The aggregate data came from the Oklahoma State Department of Education and from the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Unitized Data System. Data are presented by county and by high school within each county. (JDD)

### **HIGH SCHOOL TO COLLEGE-GOING RATES: FOR OKLAHOMA HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES TO OKLAHOMA COLLEGES**

As part of the State Regents cooperative effort with the State Department of Education to provide measures or "indicators" of educational performance, the High School Indicators Project has produced the High School to College-Going Rates of Oklahoma High School Graduates Report.

The data used to construct this report comes from two sources, the Oklahoma State Department of Education and The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. Data derived from the State Department is aggregate data reported to the Department by individual high schools each year. The data is aggregate in that it is total numbers of graduates and does not contain information on individuals. The State Regents' data is created from the Unitized Data System (UDS). The UDS is a data collection system whereby institutions collect a number of distinct "units" of data for each individual student each and every semester. These units of data are then "aggregated" into numbers by computer programs designed to create the information reports needed from the larger database. The data sources, then, cannot be merged in a true sense. Therefore, in order to obtain the needed rates of college-going, like-type populations were created and compared because tracking "individuals" from high school into college was not possible.

This year the counts from the current annual report and counts from reports of the previous two years have been averaged to provide a three-year average Oklahoma college-going rate. This average provides an opportunity to consider a trend in addition to single year activity by high school site. The single year reports are also provided for each of the three years used to construct the average college-going rates: the college-going rate for 1990-91 high school graduates going to college in 1991-92, the college-going rate for 1991-92 high school graduates going to college in 1992-93, and college-going rate for the 1992-93 high school graduates going to an Oklahoma college in 1993-94.

There are two kinds of rates shown on these reports. The first rate is the "Linear College-Going Rate." This rate measures the movement of Oklahoma high school graduates who go directly to an Oklahoma college the following year. This is the way most people think of a "college-going rate," but in actuality it is seldom used because in most states the detailed information needed to ascertain such a rate is not available. The average Linear College-Going Rate for Oklahoma colleges in 1993-94 was 43.9 percent of the Oklahoma high school graduates from 1990-91, 1991-92, and 1992-93. The Linear College-Going Rate for Oklahoma colleges in 1993-94 was 44.7 percent of the high school graduates from 1992-93. The second is that of the "Combined College-Going Rate." This method of examining the flow of high school graduates into higher education combines those students who are attending directly out of high school with those students who have delayed entry for one year or more. The average Combined Rate for Oklahoma was 70.1 percent of the high school graduates from 1990-91, 1991-92, and 1992-93. The Combined Rate for Oklahoma was 70.2 percent of the high school graduates from 1992-93.

It should also be kept in mind that the data displayed in this report is not complete in several respects. One: there are several private high schools in Oklahoma not reported on the State Department of Education database. Two: there are several private colleges and universities which did not participate in State Regents' Unitized Data System. Three: the coding of first-time freshmen depends entirely on institutional input. If a higher education institution mis-codes an ACT high school code or improperly codes the student's level or status, data will be lost to the report.

The report, of course, does not track students out-of-state, nor does it take into account those students who received GEDs or dropped out of high school prior to graduation but went on to college as an adult or through admission to an "open-door" institution for which high school graduation is not required. It is extrapolated that were these instances added to the combined rate, the college-going rate would be in excess of 70 percent for any given graduating class.

For the present, this report is as complete as can be constructed. It should be kept in mind, however, that small errors or omissions in data for small high schools can result in large percentage differences. This report should be used as an "indicator" report not as proof or evidence.

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
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
