#### **ABSTRACT**

Providing population projections from two sources for the Santa Clarita Community College District, in California, this report offers tables showing future conditions for the College of the Canyons (CoC) and the district. First, the two sets of projections are described as figures developed by the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG), including population figures for the district from the 1990 Census and projections for the years 2000 to 2010, and estimates developed by a consulting firm working with CoC to develop a second college site in the district, including 1990 Census figures, population estimates for 1993, and projections for 1998 for a 5- and 10-mile radius from the college. Tables of projections for the district from 1990 to 2010 are then presented, including population, growth in numbers of households, and employment growth. A map of district census tracts and tables of district population, household, and job growth from 1990 to 2010 by tract are then provided. Finally, tables showing projected population growth and growth by race/ethnicity within 5 and 10 miles of CoC are presented for 1990 to 1998. Highlighted findings include the following: (1) 1990 census data indicate that the district serves 151,052 people, while SCAG is projecting that by 2010 the district will serve 482,102; (2) predicted growth in households is from 48,196 in 1990 to 137,854 in 2010; and (3) a 148% increase in employment is predicted by the year 2010. 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#### Population, Household and Employment Projections

This report contains two population projections for Santa Clarita.

#### The District

The first was developed by the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) and includes population figures for the Santa Clarita Community College District from the 1990 Census and projections for the years 2000 and 2010. Also included are SCAG's projections for number of households and employment. Detailed information is provided by Census tracts within the District.

#### Service Area

The second set of estimates and projections were developed in April 1993 by UDS for Maas, Rao, Taylor and Associates, the consulting firm working with the college to develop a second college site within the District. In addition to the 1990 Census figures, population estimates are provided for 1993 and projections for 1998 for both a 5- and 10-mile radius from the college.

#### Discussion

SCAG has projected more than a doubling of the District population from the 1990 Census to the year 2000, an increase of more than 162,000 people. The District is then projected to increase by another 168,000 people by the year 2010, bringing the total population to 482,102.

It is important to note that the SCAG and UDS projections are for quite different geographic areas.

Both the 5 and 10-mile radius UDS projections are for areas smaller than the District. While the District covers 367 square miles, the 5-mile radius encompasses 78.5 square miles and the 10-mile radius includes 314.2 square miles. The 10-mile radius projections also include areas to the south in the San Fernando Valley which are not included within the District.


The UDS projection for the area within 5 miles of the college predicts a 31 percent population increase from 1990 to 1998, an additional 21,000 people.

• The projected population increases will have a severe impact on the existing facilities at College of the Canyons.



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# PROJECTED POPULATION GROWTH OF THE SANTA CLARITA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT 1990 to 2010





The Southern California Association of Governments' upcoming report projects a 182 percent increase in households for the Santa Clarita Community College District from the 1990 Census to the year 2010.





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## Projected Employment Growth by Census Tract of the Santa Clarita Community College District, 1990 to 2010



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### PROJECTED POPULATION GROWTH WITHIN 5 AND 10 MILES OF COLLEGE OF THE CANYONS


