ABSTRACT

This report presents statistics on Fall enrollments at institutions of higher education across Texas for Fall 1994 and compares them with 1993 figures. The enrollment figures are based on a preliminary count of the 12th class day enrollments reported by the institutions. The first table gives an overview of headcount enrollments for both years and percent change for different types of institutions. The next table gives headcount enrollment for both years and percent change for each institution. Individual institutions are grouped by type including public universities, public community colleges, independent colleges and junior colleges, and dental and medical institutions. The next section lists the institutions which are grouped by type. Information provided for each institution includes the leading administrator or president, a telephone number, and preliminary fall headcount enrollment figures. Highlights of the report include the following: (1) enrollment at all public and independent institutions increased by 1,800 students over Fall 1993; (2) the state's public universities reported a decrease of 745 students while enrollments at public health-related institutions increased 4.3 percent; and (3) public community colleges reported a decrease of 67 students, down a fraction of a percent from the previous year though the Texas State Technical College System reported an 8.14 percent enrollment increase. AUSTIN, Oct. 21, 1994 -- Enrollment at Texas' public and independent higher education institutions increased by 1,800 students this fall over fall 1993, according to preliminary figures released by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

The state's public universities reported 406,569 students, a decrease of 745 students and down a fraction of a percent from 407,314 students in fall 1993. Enrollments at public health-related institutions increased 4.3 percent to 14,569 students this fall.

Public community colleges reported 400,081 students, a decrease of 67 students and down a fraction of a percent from 400,148 students in fall 1993. The Texas State Technical College System reported an 8.14 percent enrollment increase to 7,823 students this fall. Last fall, the TSTC System enrolled 7,234 students.

Independent colleges and universities reported an addition of 1,457 students this fall, increasing their enrollments to 92,027 students. Independent health-related institutions enrollments increased by 25 to 1,615 students. Independent junior colleges reported 619 students, down 59 from fall 1993.

Twenty-one public university campuses reported enrollment increases totaling 4,120 students this fall, while another 14 reported decreases totaling 4,865 students. In fall 1993, 17

university campuses reported increases and 18 reported decreases.

Enrollment increases totaling 11,962 students were reported by 31 public community college districts and one Lamar University System lower-level, two-year institution. Eighteen public community college districts and two Lamar University System lower-level, two-year institutions reported decreases totaling 12,029 students. One community college district reported no change.

The enrollment figures are based on a preliminary count of the 12th class day enrollments reported by higher education institutions to the Coordinating Board.
