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ABSTRACT

Information is presented about students in South Carolina public schools by grade. Information on sex and racial/ethnic composition is provided for each school, and each is characterized as rural, urban, or mixed. Student average daily membership counts are rounded at the school level. Of the 1,109 South Carolina schools, 482 are considered rural, 341 urban, and 286 mixed. The majority of students (434,703) are in elementary schools, with 194,413 in secondary schools and 915 in combined schools. Minorities constitute 43% of South Carolina students, and females make up 48.6% of the student body. South Carolina's schools vary in size from 2,580 to 14 pupils. There are nearly 37,000 full-time equivalent teachers in the state's schools. The information is presented in six tables. A glossary is provided. (Contains 5 references.) (SLD)

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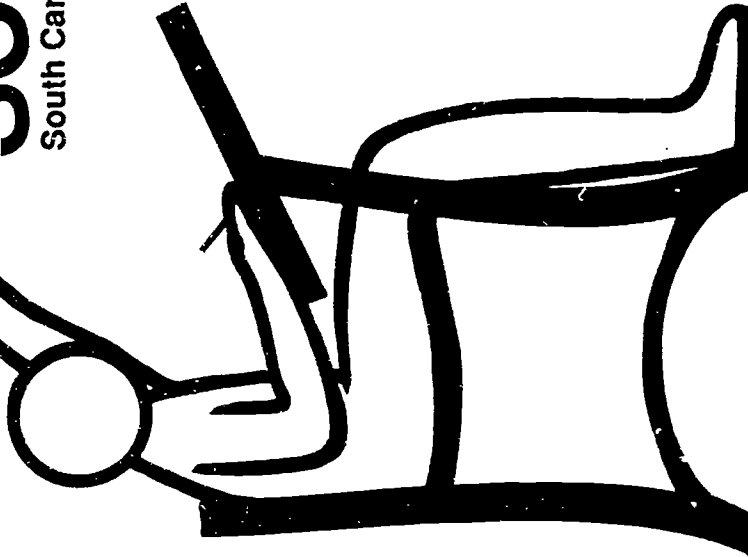

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

AREA VOCATIONAL CENTER (AVC): A specialized secondary school equipped to prepare students for immediate job entry and for continued specialization in post-high school vocational or technical instruction. Broad vocational programs are offered to meet the diverse occupational needs of students.

AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP (ADM): The aggregate number of days in membership divided by the number of days the school is in session produces the average daily membership. For the purpose of this publication, days in membership at the end of 135 days are utilized in calculating the displayed ADM.

BLACK: A racial/ethnic category used to designate a person having origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa. Category does not include persons of Hispanic origin.

CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER: An educational facility with a program designed to serve children who are 3, 4, and 5 years of age constitutes a child development center. However, for the purpose of this publication only kindergarten children are counted and displayed for use.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL: A school having curricula which offer work in any combination of grades kindergarten through eight. The program is concerned primarily with general education, including those skills, facts, and attitudes which are required by society of all its members.

ENROLLMENT, 180-DAYS: Cumulative 35-day enrollment at the end of 180 days of school. A pupil is counted in the 35-day enrollment on the 35th day the pupil has been present in school, provided he has not been counted in the 35-day enrollment of any other school in the state.

FULL-TIME EQUIVALENCY (FTE): The proportion of a full-time position expressed in tenths is referred to as a full-time equivalency.

HIGH SCHOOL: Generally considered a school having curricula which offer work in grades nine through twelve. Legally, "high school" means any public school which contains grades no lower than the seventh and no higher than the twelfth grade (§59-1-150, (6), 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990). The term secondary-level school is commonly used to refer to schools encompassing grades seven through twelve or combination of these grades. In legal terms, a secondary school is defined as a junior high school or a high school (§59-1-150, (4), 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL: A school having curricula which offer work in grades seven through nine. Legally the "junior high school" shall be considered synonymous with the term "high school" (§59-1-150, (5), 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

KINDERGARTEN: A specialized program generally for five-year olds which consist of experience and activities to enhance their physical, emotional, social, and intellectual growth and development. The program is designed to help each child obtain, at his own rate of speed, the educational goals set for the primary or elementary school. In legal terms, "kindergarten" is defined to mean any school which provides either education, instruction, or supervision below the first grade to children who will attain the age of five on or before the first day of November of the school year when they begin school (§59-1-150, (1), 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

MIDDLE SCHOOL: The term is used to refer to any public school which contains grades no lower than fifth and no higher than eighth (§59-1-150, (3), 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

MIXED: The school serves approximately the same number of students from urban areas as from rural areas, the school population is considered to be mixed urban/rural, regardless of the location of the school site.

PUPIL: A resident child of the state who is at least four years old as of November 1 and not more than twenty-one years old. When a pupil is in the graduating class and becomes, twenty-one years of age, he will be permitted to complete the term (§59-19-340, §59-63-20, 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

PUPIL - COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE: Children who are between the ages of five and seventeen, are required to attend regularly a public or private school or kindergarten of this State; however, the parent or guardian of a child who is not six years old on or before November 1 of a particular school year may elect in writing on a standard form for his child not to attend kindergarten (§59-65-10, 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

RACIAL/ETHNIC GROUP - OTHER: Category used in this publication to designate a person belonging to or identifying with American Indian or Alaskan native, Asian or Pacific Islander, Hispanic. This category includes all persons who do not identify as belonging to the racial/ethnic categories of black and white.

RURAL: The school serves a majority of students (approximately 65% or more) from incorporated cities, towns, or villages or unincorporated places of less than 2,500 inhabitants, the school population is considered to be rural regardless of the location of the school site.

SCHOOL: A school is defined as a division of the school system consisting of pupils composed of one or more grade groups, organized as one unit with one or more teachers to give instruction of a defined type, and housed in a school plant of one or more buildings. More than one school may be housed in one school plant, as in the case when elementary and secondary programs are housed in the same plant (§59-21-10, 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990). Also, a "public school" is operated by publicly elected or appointed school officials in which the program and activities are under the control of these officials and which is supported by public funds (§59-1-120, 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

SCHOOL DISTRICT: The term refers to any area or territory comprising a legal entity whose sole purpose is that of providing free school education, whose boundary lines are a matter of public record, and the area of which constitutes a complete tax unit (§59-1-160, 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990).

SPECIAL EDUCATION SCHOOL: A school which departs in character from the conventional or regular school and in the type of student served. Generally, a special education school is ungraded and offers curricula which are suited for students needing special educational services, special instruction, and special instructional aids. Pupils served possess severely handicapping conditions such as blindness, deafness, mental deficiencies, etc., and require services and aids which are suitable for their individual needs and are not generally found in regular schools. For accounting purposes, a student assigned to an ungraded school is reported by his nominal grade level which is the student's age as of November 1 of the current year minus five.



TEACHER: Legally, a "teacher" is defined as any person who is employed either full time or part time by any school district either to teach or to supervise teaching (§59-1-130, 1976 S. C. Code of Laws, Revised 1990). For the purpose of this publication, teachers collected through the Basic Educational Data System were utilized in this report and include teacher position codes, 03 (special education - itinerant teacher), 05 (kindergarten teacher), 06 (special education - self-contained), 07(special education - resource teacher), 08 (regular classroom teacher), and 09 (other professional instructional staff).

URBAN: The school serves a majority of students (approximately 65% or more) for any incorporated cities, towns, or villages of more than 2,500 inhabitants or any unincorporated places of 2,500 or more inhabitants, the school population is considered to be urban regardless of the location of the school site.

WHITE: A racial/ethnic category used to designate a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, or the Middle East. Category does not include persons of Hispanic origins.

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
