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ABSTRACT

This report presents salary data on selected administrative positions from all public higher education institutions, governing boards, and other higher education state-level agencies in Colorado. Table 1 presents, by institutional type, the median and mean salaries for 1994-95, as well as the frequency and range of salaries, for the following positions: chief executive officers, executive vice presidents, chief academic officers, chief general studies officers, chief vocational education officers, directors of institutional research, deans of continuing education, chief business officers, chief planning officers, chief budgeting officers, chief personnel officers, directors of affirmative action, chief information systems officers, chief physical plant officers, comptrollers, chief public relations officers, directors of information, chiefs of student affairs, chief admissions officers, registrars, directors of student financial aid, and directors of athletics. Table 2 provides average salary data for 1992-93, 1993-94, and 1994-95. Definitions for each position are also presented. (MDM)

SUMMARY POSITION DESCRIPTIONS¹

- 101.00 CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A SYSTEM/DISTRICT/MULTICAMPUS OPERATION (PRESIDENT/CHANCELLOR):** The principal administrative official responsible for the direction of all operations of a system, district, or multicampus structure.
- 102.00 CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A SINGLE INSTITUTION (PRESIDENT/CHANCELLOR):** The principal administrative official responsible for the direction of all operations of a campus or an institution of higher education.
- 103.00 EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT:** The principal administrative official, in lieu of the Chief Executive Officer, responsible for the direction of all operations of an institution of higher education. Reports to the Chief Executive Officer.
- 201.00 CHIEF ACADEMIC OFFICER (MAY ALSO BE TITLED PROVOST):** The senior administrative official responsible for the direction of the academic program of the institution. Functions typically include teaching, research, extension, admissions, registrar, and library activities. Reports to the Chief Executive Officer.
- 204.00 DIRECTOR, INSTITUTIONAL RESEARCH:** The administrative staff official responsible for the conduct of research and studies on the institution itself. Functions performed or supervised typically include data collection, analysis, reporting, and related staff work in support of decision making.
- 216.00 DEAN, CONTINUING EDUCATION:** Services as the principal administrator of the continuing education division.
- 301.00 CHIEF BUSINESS OFFICER:** The senior administrative official responsible for combined functions of administrative and financial affairs. Functions typically include purchasing, physical plant management, property management, auxiliary enterprises, personnel services, investments, accounting and related matters.
- 302.00 CHIEF PLANNING OFFICER:** The senior administrative official responsible for the direction of long-range planning, and the allocation of resources. Functions typically include budget planning, institutional research and facilities planning, and may also include responsibility for current planning and budgeting, as well as state and federal regulations. Reports to the Executive Officer.
- 303.00 CHIEF BUDGETING OFFICER:** The senior administrative officer responsible for the current budgetary operations. May also include responsibility for long-range planning unless there is a separate planning officer.
- 306.00 CHIEF PERSONNEL/HUMAN RESOURCES OFFICER:** The senior administrative official responsible for administering institutional personnel policies and practices for staff and/or faculty. Functions typically include personnel records, benefits, staff employment, wage and salary administration, and, where applicable, labor relations.
- 307.00 DIRECTOR, AFFIRMATIVE ACTION/EQUAL EMPLOYMENT:** The senior administrative official responsible for the universitywide program designed to ensure equality of opportunity on an individual basis without giving preference in opportunity to any group.

- 309.00 CHIEF INFORMATION SYSTEMS OFFICER:** Directs the institution's major academic and administrative computing activities and voice and data communications.
- 312.00 CHIEF PHYSICAL PLANT/FACILITIES MANAGEMENT OFFICER:** The senior administrative official responsible for the construction, rehabilitation, and maintenance of physical plant facilities. Functions typically include supervision of new construction and remodeling, grounds and building maintenance, power plant operation, and parking.
- 313.00 COMPTROLLER:** Directs accounting, payroll, cashiering, and related functions. May also have responsibility for office services, such as mail and telephone.
- 402.00 CHIEF PUBLIC RELATIONS OFFICER:** The senior administrative official responsible for public relations programs. Functions typically include public relations, news media relations, legislative relations, alumni relations, and information office services.
- 410.00 DIRECTOR, INFORMATION OFFICE:** Directs the provision of information about the institution to students, faculty, and the public. Functions typically include news media relations, preparation or review of news releases and photographs, and preparation and distribution of newsletters, magazines, and other publications.
- 501.00 CHIEF STUDENT AFFAIRS OFFICER:** The senior administrative official responsible for the direction of student services and student life programs. Functions typically include student counseling and testing, career development and placement, student union, campus/student activities, minority student support programs, residence life, and related functions.
- 502.00 CHIEF ADMISSIONS OFFICER:** The administrative official with primary responsibility for the admission of undergraduates. May also be responsible for the admission of graduate and professional students, or for scholarship administration or similar functions.
- 504.00 REGISTRAR:** The administrative official with principal responsibility for student registrations and records. Functions typically include registration, classroom scheduling, maintenance of student records, and related matters.
- 506.00 DIRECTOR, STUDENT FINANCIAL AID:** Directs the administration of all forms of student aid. Functions typically include assistance in the application for loans or scholarships; administration of private, state, or federal loan programs; awarding of scholarships and fellowships; and maintenance of appropriate records.
- 518.00 DIRECTOR, ATHLETICS:** Directs intramural and intercollegiate athletic programs for men and women. Functions typically include scheduling and contracting for athletic events, employment and direction of athletic coaches, publicity, ticket sales, and equipment and facilities maintenance.
