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ABSTRACT

A study was conducted at William Rainey Harper College (WRHC) to develop a profile of students who withdrew from courses between summer 1992 and spring 1994. Between 1992 and 1994, 13.7% of the 175,000 course enrollments resulted in official withdrawals, representing a 0.4% decrease in withdrawals from the 1990-1992 cohort. An analysis of these withdrawals indicated the following: (1) one-fifth of course withdrawals resulted in complete withdrawal from WRHC, although nearly 75% of the students who withdrew planned to return to WRHC in the future; (2) 31% of those withdrawing gave reasons completely beyond WRHC's control, and only 7% indicated WRHC as the primary cause for withdraws; (3) the major reasons for withdrawal continued to be related to personal, family, or illness problems; (4) summer enrollees were less likely to withdraw because of falling behind on coursework or grades; however, inconvenient course times were often given as reasons for withdrawal; (5) close to 50% who completely withdrew from WRHC cited personal, family, or illness problems and job-related issues; (6) there was a lower percentage of withdrawals during the summer semester than during the spring and fall semester (11% versus 14%); (7) 32% indicated they had never consulted a counselor in the 2 years previous to withdrawal; and (8) 40% never talked to a counselor while at WRHC. 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ABSTRACT

OVER THE PAST TWO YEARS 13.7 PERCENT OF THE COURSE ENROLLEES OFFICIALLY WITHDREW FROM THEIR PAST COURSES. ONE-FIFTH OF THE WITHDRAWALS RESULT IN A COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL FROM HARPER. NEARLY THREE-FOURTHS OF THE STUDENTS WHO COMPLETELY WITHDRAW PLAN TO RETURN TO HARPER. CLOSE TO ONE-THIRD OF THOSE WITHDRAWING GIVE REASONS COMPLETELY BEYOND HARPER'S CONTROL AND ONLY 7 PERCENT INDICATED HARPER AS THE PRIMARY REASON FOR WITHDRAWAL. THE ABOVE INFORMATION IS NOT DIFFERENT FROM WHAT OUR PRIOR STUDIES FOUND.

THE MAJOR REASONS FOR WITHDRAWAL CONTINUE TO BE RELATED TO PERSONAL, FAMILY OR ILLNESS PROBLEMS. REASONS FOR WITHDRAWAL DIFFER SOMEWHAT BETWEEN THE SUMMER SEMESTERS AND THE FALL/SPRING SEMESTERS. SUMMER ENROLLEES CONTINUE TO BE LESS LIKELY TO WITHDRAW BECAUSE OF FALLING BEHIND ON COURSE WORK OR GRADES. HOWEVER, INCONVENIENT TIMES ARE OFTEN GIVEN AS REASONS FOR WITHDRAWAL. UNFORTUNATELY, WE ARE UNABLE TO DETERMINE WHICH COURSES AND THEIR SCHEDULED TIMES ARE THE MAJOR CAUSES FOR WITHDRAWAL. IF STUDENTS WITHDRAW FROM CLASSES DUE TO THE ASSIGNED CLASS TIMES BEING INCONVENIENT, TO WHAT EXTENT ARE POTENTIAL STUDENTS NOT ENROLLING ALTOGETHER FOR THE SAME REASONS? YOUNGER STUDENTS WITHDRAW FROM COURSEWORK FOR DIFFERENT REASONS THAN THE OLDER STUDENTS: OLDER STUDENTS WITHDRAW DUE TO JOB PRESSURES; YOUNGER STUDENTS WITHDRAW DUE TO FALLING BEHIND IN THEIR COURSEWORK. PERSONAL, FAMILY OR ILLNESS PROBLEMS ARE STATED BY BOTH AGE GROUPS.

CLOSE TO ONE-HALF OF THE STUDENTS WHO COMPLETELY WITHDRAW FROM HARPER WITHDRAW DUE TO PERSONAL, FAMILY OR ILLNESS PROBLEMS AND JOB RELATED ISSUES. ONE-THIRD OF THOSE COMPLETELY WITHDRAWING SAY THEY NEVER CONSULTED A COUNSELOR. OUR LAST REPORT INDICATED 40 PERCENT NEVER SAW A COUNSELOR.

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Purpose

The purpose of this report is to summarize data received by the survey given each student who withdrew from a course during the period from summer semester 1992 through spring semester 1994. The objective of the report is to provide general institutional background profiling students who withdraw from courses at Harper.

Population Surveyed

Students are asked to complete a survey form at the time they officially withdraw from a course. During the last two years, surveys have been completed for approximately 70 percent of the course withdrawals. However, one out of every three students drops more than one course and usually only one withdrawal form is filled out regardless of the number of courses a student drops. On the other hand, some students drop courses at different times which results in more than one survey per student being completed. In our last report we received surveys for 80 percent of the course withdrawals. The number of withdrawal surveys received for the school year 1993 was substantially fewer than compared to the prior school year.

Methodology

For the period from summer semester 1992 through spring 1994, each degree credit student who has officially withdrawn from a course has been asked to complete a survey form (shown in the appendix). This form was designed by the Office of Planning and Research and is distributed by the Registrar's Office. The data has been analyzed to show many comparisons to data within the survey and to some limited student characteristics data. Telephone and in-person registration information was obtained from reports from the Office of the Registrar. Enrollment and grade information was taken from Grade Analysis Credit semester reports.

Discussion of Results

The results found in this study are similar to our last study. During the two-year period from the summer 1992 through spring 1994, 13.7 percent of the 175,000 course enrollments resulted in official withdrawals. The last report indicated the percentage for withdrawals was 13.4 percent. Similar to our last report, one out of every five course withdrawals results in a complete withdrawal from Harper. Nearly three-fourths of these students plan to return to Harper.

Of those withdrawing, 31 percent withdraw for reasons completely beyond Harper's control and only 7 percent indicate Harper as the primary cause for withdrawing. These findings are mirrored by our last report. Those who withdraw for reasons beyond Harper's control are more likely to withdraw from Harper completely.

Discussion of Results (continued)

These statistics have remained fairly constant with prior studies.

The major reasons cited for withdrawals include personal, family or illness problems, inconvenient course times, job pressures, objectives didn't meet their needs, and fell too far behind or poor grades. Again, the reasons stated are similar to the reasons provided in prior reports. Personal, family, or illness problems remain the number one reason for withdrawal.

The percent of withdrawals during the summer semester continues to be less than the percent of withdrawals in the spring and fall semesters (11% vs. 14%). This is the exact ratio found in the last study. Students who withdraw during the summer are more likely to withdraw completely (25% vs. 17%) when compared to student withdrawals for the fall and spring semesters. This is not surprising since students take fewer courses during the summer than they do during the fall or spring semesters. Summer withdrawing students are less likely to have seen a counselor.

Reasons for withdrawal differ when comparing the summer semester to the spring and fall semesters. Summer enrollees continue to be less likely to withdraw because of falling behind on grades. However, more summer students withdraw due to inconvenient course times than students in the fall and spring semester. Prior reports have consistently reflected this difference. Our current method of capturing withdrawal information does not identify the course from which the student withdrew. Consequently, we cannot determine which courses and time allocations are causing the scheduling problems. The courses or time slots that the students consider inconvenient could also deter students from enrolling at all.

The percentage of students who register by phone is 32 percent. The percentage of students who provided us with a withdrawal survey - 35 percent - indicated they registered by telephone. A greater percentage of the students that register by telephone during the spring semester withdraw than those in the fall. Students over age 24 who register by telephone are more likely to withdraw than younger students who register by telephone.

During the past two years, about 32 percent of the students withdrawing say they have never consulted a counselor. The last report indicated 40 percent never talked to a counselor. Those who withdraw completely from Harper are less likely to have seen a counselor. Close to one-half of these students withdraw due to personal, family and illness reasons and job-related issues.

Discussion of Results (continued)

Younger students generally withdraw from courses for different reasons than the older students. Younger students withdraw because of falling behind in classwork or grades and personal, family and illness reasons. Older students rarely withdraw for falling behind in classwork or grades. Although personal, family and illness reasons are given for withdrawal, the older students are more likely to cite job pressures as an obstacle to completing their coursework. The different reasons for withdrawals by the two different age groups remain consistent through the years.

Major Conclusions

Over the past two years 13.7 percent of the course enrollees officially withdrew from their past courses. One-fifth of the withdrawals result in a complete withdrawal from Harper. Nearly three-fourths of the students who completely withdraw plan to return to Harper. Close to one-third of those withdrawing give reasons completely beyond Harper's control and only 7 percent indicated Harper as the primary reason for withdrawal. The above information is not different from what our prior studies found.

The major reasons for withdrawal continue to be related to personal, family or illness problems. Reasons for withdrawal differ somewhat between the summer semesters and the fall/spring semesters. Summer enrollees continue to be less likely to withdraw because of falling behind on coursework or grades. However, inconvenient times are often given as reasons for withdrawal. Unfortunately, we are unable to determine which courses and their scheduled times are the major causes for withdrawal. If students withdraw from classes due to the assigned class times being inconvenient, to what extent are potential students not enrolling altogether for the same reasons? Younger students withdraw from coursework for different reasons than the older students: Older students withdraw due to job pressures; younger students withdraw due to falling behind in their coursework. Personal, family or illness problems are stated by both age groups.

Close to one-half of the students who completely withdraw from Harper withdraw due to personal, family or illness problems and job-related issues. One-third of those completely withdrawing say they never consulted a counselor. Our last report indicated 40 percent never saw a counselor.




