Statistical data are reported on: percent of special education students by disability; the number of students in each disability category in state special schools and local education agencies (LEAs); the number of students receiving special education by age and disability; the number of students by intensity of disability and age for state schools and LEAs; the number and percent of students by gender for state schools and LEAs; the number and percent of students by race/ethnicity for state schools and LEAs; the number of enrollments for infant and toddler Part H programs (birth to age 3) by LEA; and the number of special education students, teachers, and aides by LEA. 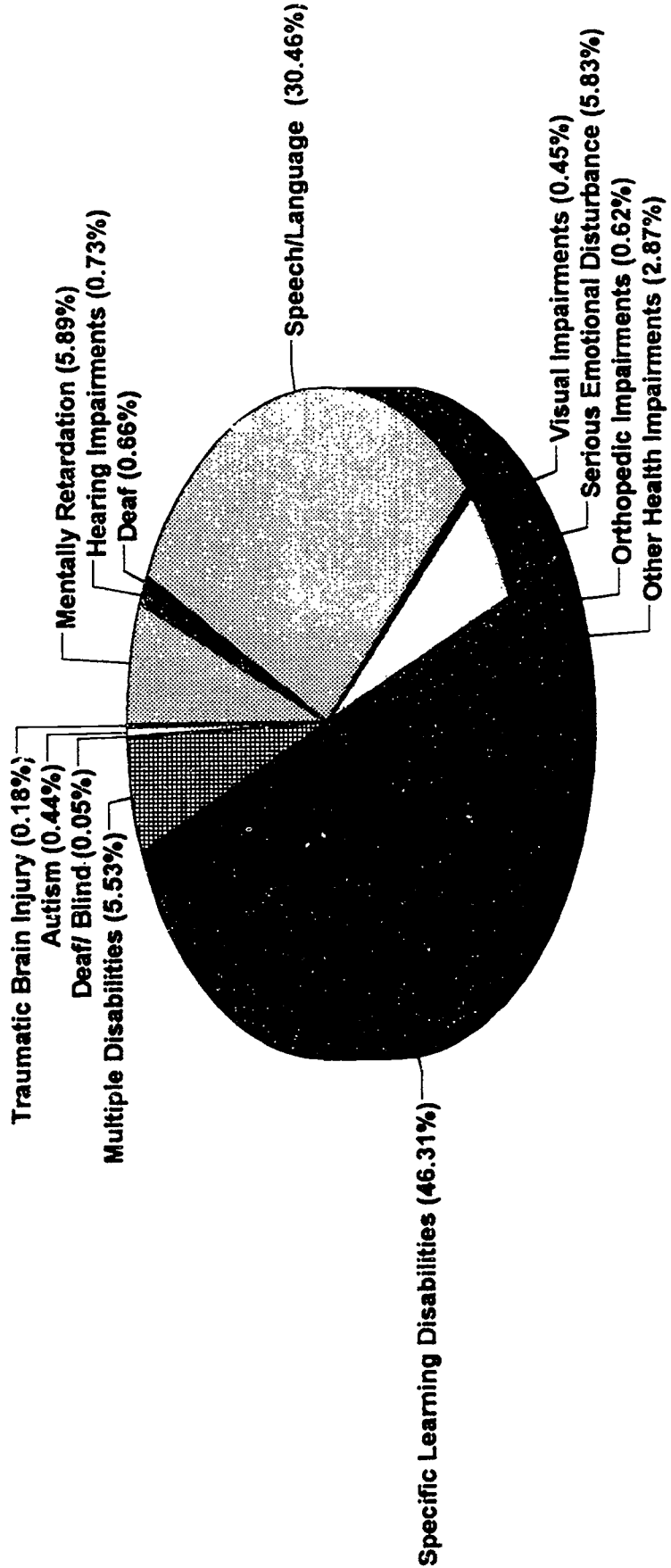

# Figure 1: State Totals by Disabilities



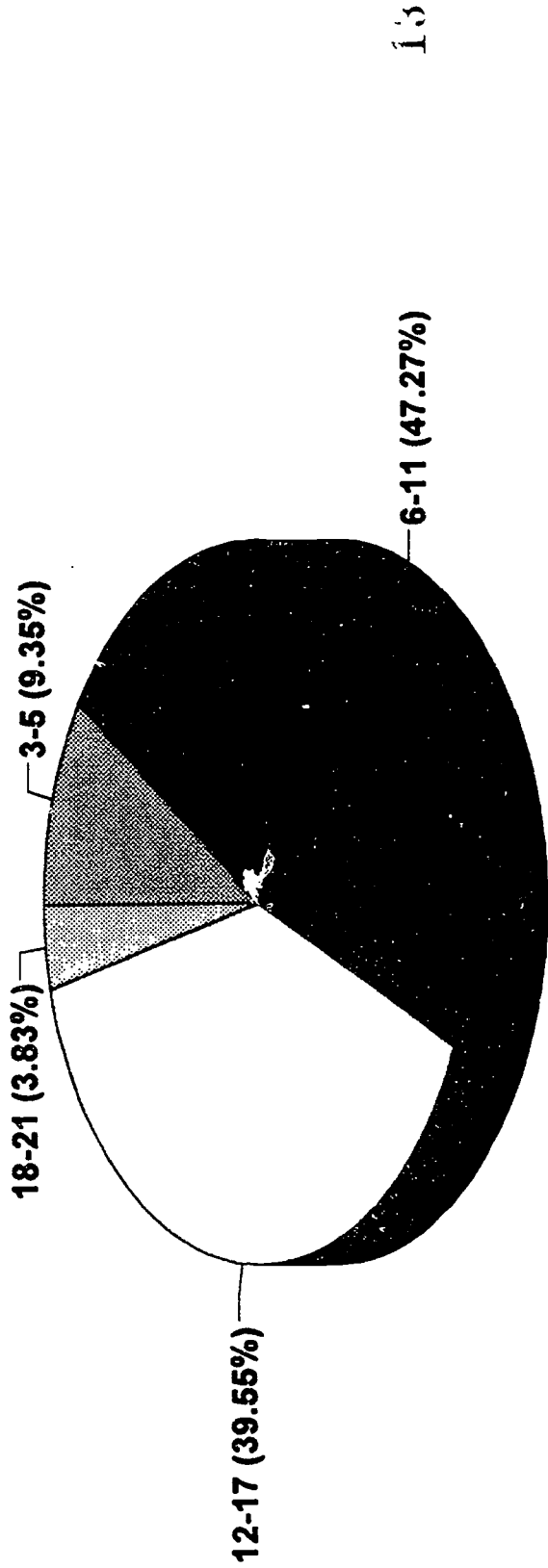

# Figure 3: State Totals by Intensity

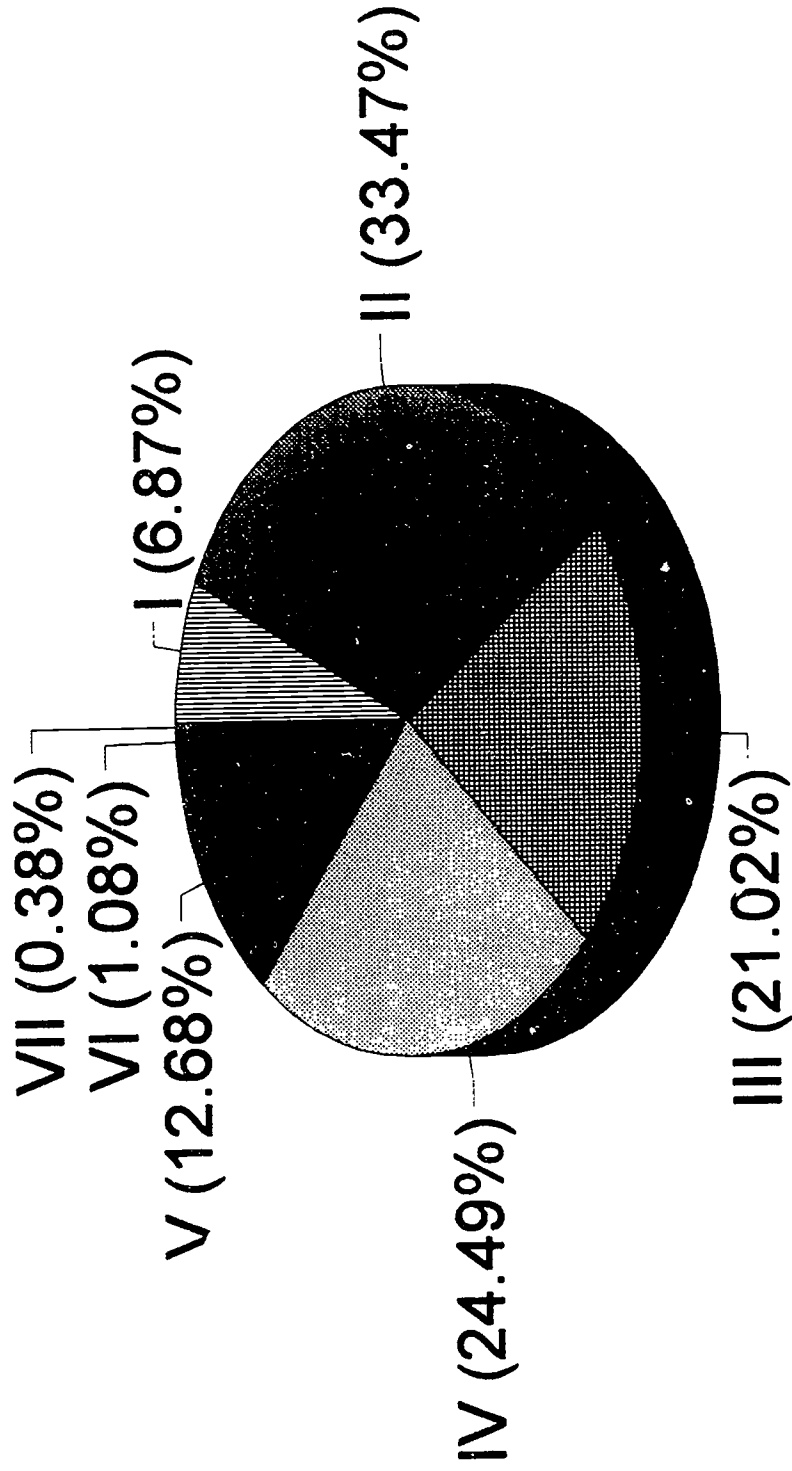

# Figure 4: State Totals by Gender

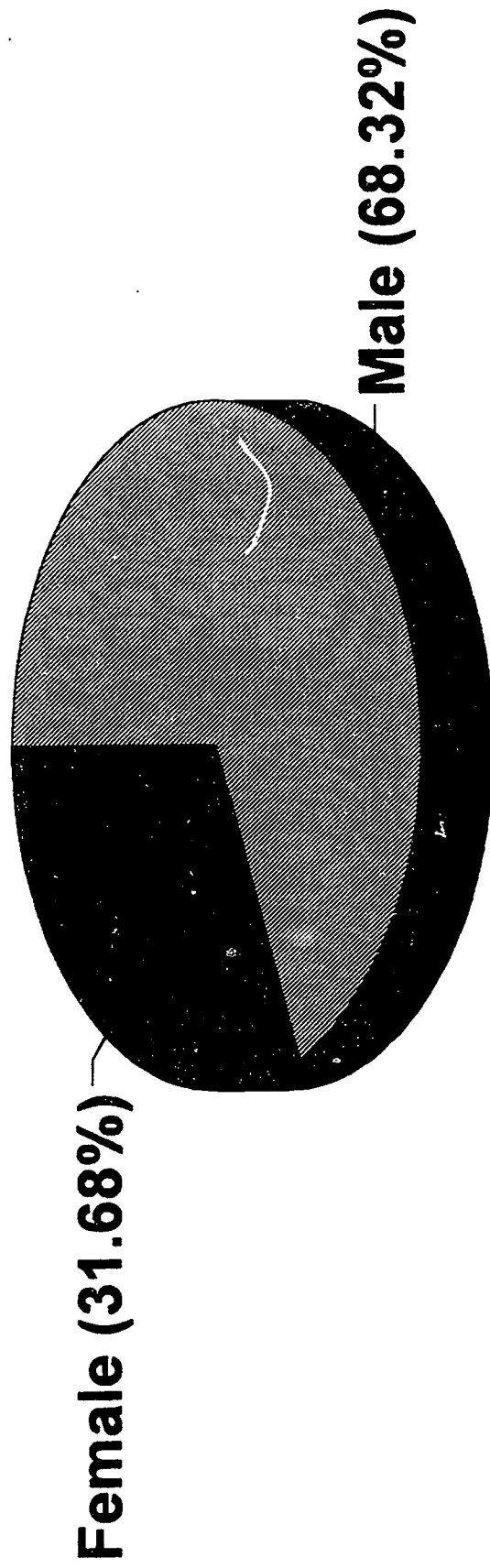


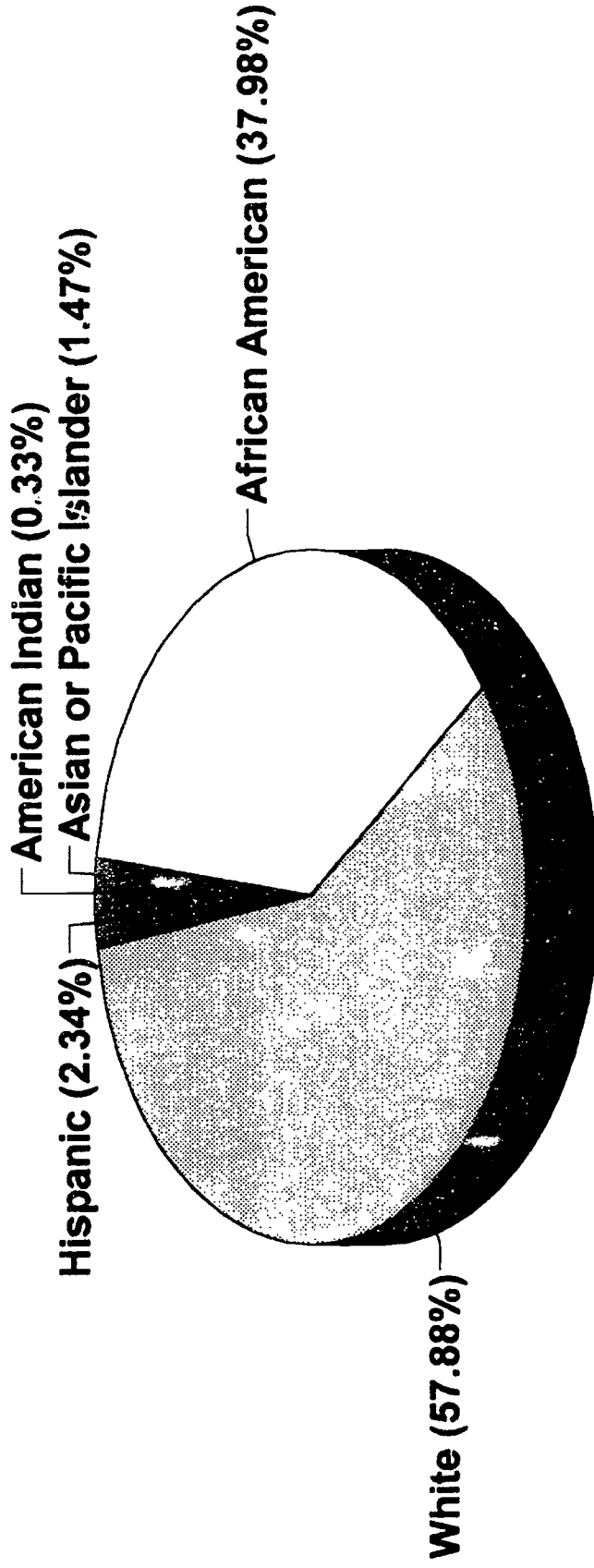
