ABSTRACT

In fall 1994, Owens Community College (OCC), in Ohio, conducted a follow-up study of all 956 graduates from 1993-94 to determine their level of educational satisfaction, employment status, and other background information. Completed surveys were returned by 664 of the graduates, for a response rate of 70%. Survey results included the following: (1) respondents were 95.6% Caucasian, 60% female, and 62% were older than 25; (2) 94.9% indicated that they were satisfied with their education at OCC and 87.4% were satisfied with college facilities; (3) 85.9% agreed that they were a more valuable employee because of their education; (4) 91.7% of the graduates were employed, with 81.8% of these employed full-time; (5) for graduates employed full-time, 10.7% earned less than \$13,000, 31.6% earned between \$13,000 and \$20,999, 36.9% earned between \$21,000 and \$28,999, and 20.7% earned \$29,000 or more; (6) 79.7% of graduates stated that their employment was related to their program of study; (7) 74.8% were not in their current position prior to their enrollment at OCC; (8) only 7.7% indicated that the OCC Placement Office was instrumental in securing their job; (9) 21.6% were currently continuing their education; (10) 68% had been certified or licensed in their field since graduating; (11) 62% would be interested in taking classes at OCC in the future; and (12) 95.1% would recommend the college to others. Extensive data tables are included. An institutional effectiveness flowchart and the survey instrument are appended. (KP)

Executive Summary

The 1993-1994 graduates were surveyed as a function of the Institutional Effectiveness Process (IEP). The survey was designed to assess educational satisfaction, employment status, continuing education status, and graduate background information. The survey also provided data required by the Program Review and Evaluation Process (PREP), the maintenance of the Carl D. Perkins grant, and the partial fulfillment of the service expectations for Ohio's two-year colleges.

The results of the graduate follow-up survey are reported in the format of data tables. These tables list the survey item and show the results in summation and by individual program. The tabled results pertaining to the PREP have been indicated for ease of location.

Of the 956 graduates surveyed, 70 percent returned a completed survey. Follow-up studies of this sort typically yield return rates of less than 50 percent. The greatest percentage of graduates were female (63%) and older than twenty-five (62%). Ninety-five percent of the graduates reported to be satisfied with their education and ninety-four percent who sought employment reported to have obtained employment. A class description and an overview of significant survey results are presented below.








Employment status of graduates seeking a job:



Annual salary of graduates employed full-time:







Employment Status




Year of Graduation

Introduction

The purpose of the Owens Community College Graduate Follow-Up Study is to gather information for the operational planning cycle of the Institutional Effectiveness Process (IEP) and to help meet the service expectations for Ohio's two-year colleges. The operational planning cycle includes the components of Program Review and Evaluation Process (PREP) and marketing.

The Institutional Effectiveness Process

The Institutional Effectiveness Process (IEP) integrates the components of strategic and operational planning, academic and support services departmental review and evaluation, program outcomes assessment, market planning, and budget development into a system which leads to institutional improvement and accountability. The entire process is driven by the institutional minimum and purpose which describes why the college exists and how it serves and meets the needs of the community.

The IEP components are grouped into the sequential cycles of strategic planning, operational planning, resource allocation, and evaluation (see Appendix A). The strategic planning cycle provides the focus for the academic program review and evaluation and college support services departmental review and evaluation. The academic areas review and evaluate key aspects of their programs to identify strengths and weaknesses. Additionally, all academic areas assess their stated program and student learning outcomes and determine where strengths and weaknesses exist. Support service areas conduct a thorough review and evaluate key aspects of their departmental operations to identify strengths and weaknesses. Data gathered through these processes are used as resource data in the operational planning cycle of the IEP.

During operational planning, academic areas and support service departments develop mission/purpose statements, goals, and objectives. Data gathered in the college mission and purpose, strategic initiatives, outcomes assessment (for academic areas) and Program Review and Evaluation Process PREP phases are used as resource information for the development of the entire operational plan. The results of the Graduate Follow-Up Study are used as operational planning resource information.

Concurrent with operational planning is market planning. Market planning assesses academic and support service against program/service promotion, program development, pricing and place of program offering. Coupled with operational planning, market planning drives the budget development process.

During budget development, academic and support service resource needs are compiled. All fiscal needs must flow from the operational and market planning phases. Fiscal needs are reviewed, prioritized, and adjusted as necessary.

Between planning cycles, contingency planning allows for modifications and changes to be made to the strategic, operational, and market planning documents. Every three to five years, each phase of the IEP is evaluated.



Service Expectations for Ohio's Two Year Colleges

The State of Ohio has adopted nine service expectations for its two-year colleges. The service expectations provide a framework for evaluating the effectiveness of each college in meeting the needs of its community. Each two-year college in Ohio is evaluated in terms of performance indicators specified for each of the nine service expectations. The Ohio Board of Regents plan to link a significant and growing proportion of two-year college funding to those evaluations. The **Graduate Follow-Up Study** specifically addresses two of the nine service expections which deals with trends in job placements for degree and certificate programs.



Method

Graduates Participating in the Follow-Up Study

The entire 1993-1994 graduating class was selected to participate in the Graduate Follow-Up Study. Of the nine hundred and fifty-six graduates surveyed, 664 returned completed surveys yielding a 70 percent response rate. Sixty three percent of the graduates were female, 96 percent were caucasian, and the average age of the graduates was 30 years.

The Graduate Follow-Up Survey

A 25-item survey (see Appendix B) was developed to assess graduate educational satisfaction, employment status, continuing education status, and background information.

Survey Procedure

The entire 1993-1994 Owens Community College graduating class was mailed the graduate follow-up survey, Fall semester 1994. Survey directions read as follows: "This survey is being given to selected Owens Community College graduates. The information you provide on this survey will help us become more effective in the delivery of programs and services. Your answers will not be shown to anyone and you can omit any survey item if it requests information that you do not wish to provide." The graduates were instructed to return the completed survey via the provided postage-paid addressed envelope. The graduates were offered a free grade transcript as an incentive to return the completed survey. Mail and telephone follow-ups were conducted for nonrespondents to assure an adequate response rate.



Results

The results of the Graduate Follow-Up Study are presented via data tables. The tables present results for the entire graduating class and for each educational program. A "how to read" sample table is provided for the reader's convenience on page 10. A listing of tables can be located in the table of contents. The survey items that are used for the **Program Review and Evaluation Process (PREP)** have been indicated for the reader's convenience.










