ABSTRACT

Comprised primarily of data tables, this report provides data on fall 1994 enrollment in the University and Community College System of Nevada (UCCSN), and includes longitudinal data from 1984. Data are provided on student full-time equivalent and headcount enrollments; community college headcount enrollment; full- and part-time status of students; and gender, ethnicity, and age of students. Report highlights include the following: (1) UCCSN enrolled 65,598 state-supported students, and an additional 18,223 students in self-supported programs such as continuing education, correspondence courses, community services, and contract education programs; (2) student FTE enrollment for fall 1994 was 36,088, representing a 1.3% increase in FTE enrollment over fall 1993 and a 69.2% increase over fall 1984; (3) systemwide, state-supported fall headcount enrollment increased by 61.5% from 1984 to 1994, an increase of nearly 25,000 students; (4) total enrollment in the system's four community colleges increased more than 63%, from 20,197 students in 1984 to 32,980 students in 1994; (5) the community college increase accounted for 51% of total enrollment growth in the UCCSN over this period; (6) the majority of fall 1994 UCCSN student; were attending on a part-time basis, with only 33% of attending full-time; (7) at community colleges, 85% of the students were attending part-time, compared to 49% of university students; and (8) over half (56%) of the students attending UCCSN campuses in fall 1994 were women, and 75% were white. ENROLLMENT REPORT

The University and Community College System of Nevada (UCCSN) currently enrolls a total of 65,598 state-supported students. In addition, all campuses enroll students in non-state supported programs such as continuing education, correspondence courses, community services, and contract education programs. The community colleges reported an additional 18,223 students (unduplicated headcount) in self-supported programs.

Following a decline in FTE and headcount student enrollment in the fall of 1993, enrollment in the University and Community College System of Nevada experienced a modest increase in the fall of 1994. The fall 1994 state-supported headcount enrollment of 65,598 students is an increase of 0.73% from total system enrollment in fall 1993. Fall 1994 FTE enrollment increased by 1.3%, to a total enrollment of 36,088 full-time equivalent students.

Systemwide, state-supported fall headcount enrollment has grown 61.5% from 1984 to 1994. In ten years, enrollment has grown from 40,613 students to 65,598 students, an increase of nearly 25,000 students. Total enrollment in the four community colleges has increased by more than 63%, from 20,197 students in 1984 to 32,980 in 1994. The 12,783 student increase at the community colleges from 1984 to 1994 accounts for 51% of the total system headcount enrollment growth over this period.

Systemwide fall FTE enrollment has grown 69.2% from 1984 to 1994, a larger growth rate than headcount enrollment over the same period. Over the ten-year period 1984



to 1994, systemwide FTE enrollment has grown from 21,331 to 36,088, an increase of 14,757 FTE students. Total FTE enrollment in the two universities has increased 59.6% from 14,165 in 1984 to 22,603 in 1994. This increase of 8,438 students accounts for 57% of the total system FTE enrollment growth from 1984 to 1994. FTE enrollment in the four community colleges increased 6,319 FTE students from 7,166 in 1984 to 13,485 in 1994, a growth rate of 88.2%.

The majority of UCCSN students attend on a part-time basis. Thirty-three percent of 1994 students attend UCCSN campuses full-time, an increase over the proportion of students who attended full-time in 1993. Eighty-five percent of community college students attend part-time, and 49% of university students attend part-time. Fifty-six percent of students attending UCCSN campuses are women, and 73.6% are white.

HIGHLIGHTS

Growth

- The UCCSN currently enrolls 36,088 full-time equivalent (FTE) students. This represents an increase of 469 FTE students, or 1.3% from fall 1993 and an increase of 69.2% from the fall of 1984.
- The community colleges currently enroll 13,485 FTE students, a decrease of 94 students, or 0.7% from the fall 1993 semester and an increase of 88.2% from the fall of 1984.
- The universities currently enroll 22,603 FTE students, an increase of 563 FTE students, or 2.6% from the fall 1993 semester and an increase of 59.6% from the fall of 1984.
- The UCCSN is currently serving 65,598 state-supported students. This is an increase of 474 students or 0.7% from the fall of 1993 and an increase of 61.5% from the fall of 1984.
- The UCCSN community colleges currently serve 32,980 state-supported students, a decrease of 325 students, or 1.0% fewer than the number enrolled in fall 1993 and an increase of 63.3% from the fall of 1984.
- The total headcount for the UCCSN community colleges, including both state supported and non-state supported classes, is 51,203.
- The universities currently serve 32,618 state-supported students, an increase of 799 students or 2.5% over the number enrolled in fall 1993 and an increase of 59.8% over the fall of 1984.



Composition of the 1994 Student Body

- 67% of UCCSN students are part-time students.
- 49% of university students are part-time students, the same as in 1993.
- 85% of community college students are part-time students, down from 87% 1993.
- 56% of all students in fall 1994 are female, the same proportion as in 1993.
- 73.6% of all UCCSN students in fall 1994 are white, 18% are minority students, 3.1% are nonresident alien, and 5.3% are of unknown status.
- Student age data are collected every other year. The following UCCSN age data were reported for fall 1993:

Systemwide, 27.6% of students are between 18 and 21 years of age.

33.5% of students are 22 to 29 years of age.

20.4% of students are 30 to 39 years of age.

11.9% of students in 1993 are between 40 to 49 years of age, 5.5% are over 50 years of age, and 1.1% are under 18 years of age.



Student FTE Enrollment Fall 1984 - 1994





Student Headcount Enrollment (State Supported) Fall 1984 - 1994







Percent of Students Enrolled Full-Time/Part-Time Fall 1994




