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ABSTRACT

The National Collaboration for Youth is a coalition of 17 of the largest national youth-serving organizations in the United States. Comparative data on community-based, youth-development organizations has been lacking. This report presents findings of a study that measured the compensation, benefits, minimum educational requirements, number of position vacancies, and average tenure of youth-development professionals in community-based agencies affiliated with the National Collaboration for Youth. In January 1995, a total of 2,057 surveys were sent to member agencies of the Boys and Girls Clubs of America, Camp Fire Boys and Girls, Girl Scouts of the USA, Girls Incorporated, National Network for Youth, and YWCA of the USA. A total of 899 surveys were completed, a 44 percent response rate. The document includes data and job descriptions for the following job categories: executive/managerial positions, middle management, functional administrative specialists, supervisors, direct-service providers, direct-service support staff, and seasonal staff. Section 1 presents data on compensation, vacancies, tenure, and minimum education requirements. Section 2 provides information on leave-time practices. Sections 3 through 5 offer data regarding insurance practices, other benefits, and salary increments. Numerous tables are included. Appendices contain a list of positions not included in the report and additional youth-development positions identified by survey respondents. (LMI)

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## Introduction

### Purpose

The National Collaboration for Youth is a coalition of seventeen of the largest national youth serving organizations in the country. Its mission, as an affinity group of the National Assembly of National Voluntary Health and Social Welfare Organizations, is to raise public awareness of the needs and contributions of young people and the agencies and organizations that serve them. Given its membership, the National Collaboration for Youth is in a unique position to bring attention to the youth development field and the compensation and benefits of professionals. While single-organization salary and benefit surveys are conducted by several individual organizations of the National Collaboration for Youth, they are not designed to permit comparative analysis of data from other youth development organizations. While a few national comparative compensation studies on nonprofit agencies exist, none provide comparative data specifically on community-based youth development organizations. To address this gap, the National Collaboration for Youth undertook this project. The results may provide a basis for developing

policy and program recommendations for the youth development profession as a whole and facilitate salary administration in community-based youth development organizations.

### Scope

This survey was intended to measure the compensation, benefits, minimum educational requirements, number of position vacancies, and average tenure of youth development professionals in community-based agencies affiliated with the National Collaboration for Youth.

In January 1995, 2,057 surveys were sent to member agencies of the Boys & Girls Clubs of America, Camp Fire Boys and Girls, Girls Scouts of the USA, Girls Incorporated, National Network for Youth, and YWCA of the USA. A total of 899 surveys were completed, representing a 44% response rate. The survey data represents 20,459 youth development employees (11,133 full-time and 9,326 part-time employees).

Full-time staff positions were defined as those who work 35 or more hours a week and at least 40 weeks per year. Part-time staff positions were defined as those who work less than 35 hours a week and/or less than 40 weeks per year. Seasonal staff are those who work for only part of the year, usually during the summer.

Survey respondents identified the state in which their agency was located and the size of their agency budget. This data made it possible for salaries to be compared by region and size of agency budget. When agencies did not specify their state or agency budget, the data from the agency was not included in the analysis.

## Interpreting the Data

The *Survey of Salaries and Benefits in the Youth Development Field - 1995* was designed to obtain compensation and benefit data on youth development professionals in different types of nonprofit youth development agencies affiliated with six national organizations. Each of these national organizations operate and are structured to facilitate different developmental goals for young people. Therefore most agencies did not have information for all of the job titles listed on the survey. When there was insufficient data on a particular position collected, the position was not included in this report. The positions excluded from this analysis are listed in Appendix A.

The data has been analyzed to the maximum degree possible and in some cases this has resulted in small sample sizes. *Whenever there are fewer than 10 agencies responding, a dash (-) has been inserted and compensation data is not provided.* For sample sizes larger than ten, a tentative hypothesis can be made. However, the reader is advised that the conclusions provided in this report may not be an accurate reflection of the general population. Usually, the larger the sample size, the more valid the statistics which are reported.

If a position involved several different job responsibilities, respondents were requested to pick the position that best described the individual's most often performed job duties. However, staff members in some agencies are required to perform a number of job responsibilities that do not neatly fit within one job description. Consequently, data on compensation, number of vacancies, tenure, and minimum educational requirements provided for particular positions listed and described in the survey must be considered with caution.

If there was only ONE person employed in a particular job position, survey respondents were instructed to identify the individual's income for the position. If there was MORE THAN ONE person employed in a particular position, respondents were instructed to identify the lowest income paid to employees in the position and the highest income paid to employees in the position. In these cases, while there may be a large number of employees in a particular position, the data indicates only the income of the lowest and highest paid employees in the position.

When there was one person in a particular position, the first quartile (25%), median (50%), and third quartile (75%) of salary and hourly rates are provided in this report. When there was more than one person in a particular position, the median of the lowest salaries reported and median of the highest salaries reported are provided for each position in this report.

The "median" is defined as the middle salary or hourly rate (or the average of the two middle salary/hourly rates) of a group of values when they are arranged from largest to smallest. In contrast, averages represent the total sum of all responses, divided by the number of the responses. The advantage of providing the median is that it provides a measure of central tendency that is not unduly influenced by very high or very low data (atypical incomes). Providing the median salary and hourly rates also has the advantage of controlling for experience, education, and seniority.

The first and third quartile data are measures of dispersion. When all of the incomes are arrayed from highest to lowest, the first quartile is the income below which 25% of the cases fall and third quartile is the income below which 75% of the cases fall. The quartile data provides information on the range of compensation for particular position. Incomes in the first and third quartile may be influenced by experience, education, and seniority.

Survey respondents were instructed not to include data on unpaid volunteers in positions. However, in several instances \$00.00 was identified as the hourly pay for employees in the 25th quartile. The reader may assume that for these positions agencies may have provided data on unpaid volunteers.

It should be emphasized that data presented in this report represent what full-time and part-time employees in some youth development agencies earn, *not what they should earn*. The report should not necessarily be used for setting salaries, but as tool for comparing the salaries of those who provide critical and valuable services to young people in America.

The following is a list of possible uses for this report that were identified by agencies who responded to the survey:

- To make presentations to Board of Directors, board personnel committees, and relevant task forces who review salaries and revise salary and personnel policies;
- To compare an agency's salary and benefits with the average national findings, particularly those agencies in similar regions and with similar budget size.
- To justify wages to funding agencies when applying for grants from public and/or private sources.
- To identify "benchmark" wages for salary administration. The information may be used as a guide for reviewing current salaries, establishing salary ranges, projections, increases, and budgeting.

### Position Definitions

Survey respondents were requested to provide data only on staff members in the youth development field whose "primary goal is facilitating the positive development of young people into adulthood." This included paid full-time and part-time employees whose primary work responsibility is working directly with youth or on their behalf. For the purposes of this report, direct service, supervisory, management, and executive staff are considered "youth development professionals".

Data was not requested for support staff such as accountants, administrative assistants, secretaries, cooks, or maintenance workers. However, a number of survey respondents provided compensation information on additional youth development professionals not identified on the survey. A summary of job titles, job descriptions, and compensation of additional positions identified by survey respondents are listed in Appendix B.

The following is a list of positions and job descriptions included in the survey and this report.

### Executive/Managerial Positions

**Chief Executive Officer or Executive Director.** Primary administrative position in the agency. Provides leadership to the Board of Directors, attains and distributes resources to accomplish goals, and establishes agency policies and practices.

**Deputy, Associate, or Assistant Executive Director.** Serves as the second in authority and acts for the Executive Director in his/her absence. Responsible for specific aspects of the agency's operation.

**District, Area, or Membership/Marketing Director.** Responsible for developing, coordinating, administering, and directing the delivery of services and expanding programs within a geographical area. Develops and implements a marketing plan for membership growth. May have subordinate area, site, field, or regional managers.

### Mid-Management Positions

**Branch, Center, or Unit Director.** Responsible for program operations in a center, unit or branch. Supervises program directors and/or direct service workers, develops and administers a budget, responsible for maintenance of facilities and equipment.

**Program Administrator, Director of Operations.** Directs the administrative functions of the agency. Plans, develops, and coordinates services. May supervise staff and volunteers, coordinate staff development activities, write funding proposals, and conduct record keeping activities.

### **Functional Administrative Specialists**

**Fund Development Director.** Directs coordinates, and supervises all of the organization's fund development programs, such as annual fund, direct mail and special events.

**Finance Director, Financial Manager.** Responsible for providing management and direction to the financial and bookkeeping operations.

**Functional Administrative Specialist.** Survey participants were instructed to use this position if it is not adequately described elsewhere. Provides direction and coordinates a combination of administrative activities, including fund development, public relations, and volunteer development.

**Human Resource Director or Manager of Employment Services.** Develops and administers all organizational policies and procedures for staff employment.

**Public Relations or Communications Director.** Develops, coordinates, directs, and administers all public relations related policies. May be responsible for writing speeches for staff members and communicating new programs, agency developments, and other information to the media.

**Volunteer Development Director.** Directs and coordinates all volunteer services, such as recruiting, selecting, orienting, training, and placing volunteers in agency positions. Supervises recognition and retention programs and oversees record keeping and documentation.

### **Supervisory Positions**

**Casework Supervisor.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the casework service delivery and supervising staff and volunteers.

**Counseling Supervisor or Clinical Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the individual, group, and family counseling services and program and supervising staff and volunteers.

**Cultural Enrichment Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the visual and creative arts, crafts, and cultural activities and supervising staff and volunteers.

**Day Care Director, Before - After School Coordinator.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the day care and/or after-school program for children and/or youth at one or several sites. Also responsible for supervising staff members and volunteers.

**Educational Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating educational and tutorial programs and supervising staff and volunteers.

**Environmental (Outdoor) Education Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the environmental education program and supervising staff and volunteers.

**Field Director.** Responsible for expanding and maintaining program membership by recruiting volunteers and program participants. Ensures the availability of program activities and utilization of program resources for participants.

**Health Promotion and Education Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing health education programs and advocating for healthy lifestyles (eg. preventing drug and alcohol use, pregnancy, sexually transmitted diseases).

**Housing (Emergency Shelter) Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the housing and/or shelter program and supervising staff and volunteers.

**Physical Education or Athletic Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the physical education (fitness and gymnasium) program and supervising staff and volunteers.

**Program Supervisor, Director, or Manager.** Survey respondents were instructed to use this position if it is not adequately described elsewhere. Develops, manages, and supervises youth development programs. May be responsible for directing a number of different programs (eg. cultural enrichment, education, camp).

**Recreation Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the social recreation program and supervising staff and volunteers.

**School-based Programs Director.** Responsible for supervising all school-based programs (eg. self esteem, teen sexuality) and evaluating programs and activities. May be responsible for supervising staff and volunteers.

**Swim (Aquatics) Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the aquatics program and supervising staff and volunteers.

#### *Direct Service Providers*

**Before and After School Child Care Worker.** Responsible for conducting before and after-school activities for youth. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Caseworker.** Responsible for coordinating, monitoring, and managing social services for young people and their families in the program and assisting them in obtaining resources and services. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Child and Youth Care Worker.** Responsible for working with youth in a residential treatment or group home setting. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Coach.** Responsible for coaching youth in physical education, fitness, and/or competitive sports activities. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Counselor.** Responsible for conducting individual, group and family counseling to promote positive mental health and problem solving (eg. substance abuse, violence prevention, sexual abuse counseling). Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Day Care Teacher.** Responsible for instructing preschool children in a day care setting. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Direct Service Worker.** Survey participants were instructed to use this position if it is not adequately described elsewhere. Responsible for delivering program services to youth. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Group Leader, Group Worker.** Responsible for conducting and leading group activities for youth, including field trips, arts and crafts, special programs, etc. May be responsible for transporting youth. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Instructor or Educational Specialist.** Responsible for instructing youth on specific topics (ie: graphic arts, entrepreneurial skills, computer skills, etc). Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Outreach Worker.** Plans, organizes and works with community groups concerned with addressing the needs of youth in the community.

#### *Direct Service Support Staff*

**Aide and/or Assistant.** Responsible for assisting staff in providing services or supervising young people in any youth development program (eg. after school, physical education, counseling, etc).

#### *Seasonal Staff*

**Camp Counselor.** Responsible for providing services to youth in a camp setting. Limited supervisory or managerial responsibilities.

**Camp Director.** Responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, evaluating the camp program and supervising staff and volunteers. May also be responsible for maintenance of the camp and equipment.

**Lifeguard.** Responsible for supervising pool activities and insuring safety of young people. May coordinate special activities and provide instruction.

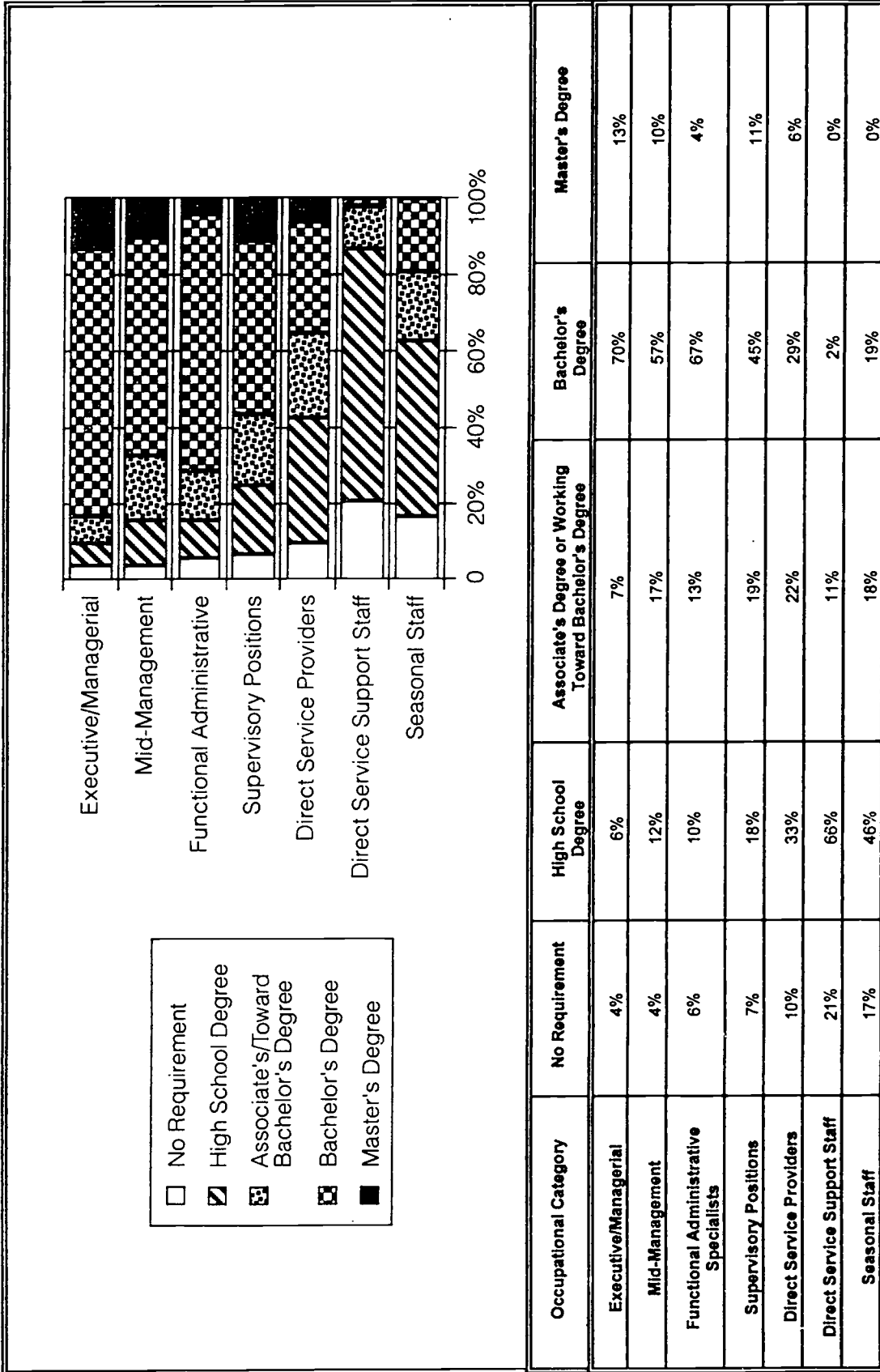

## Summary of Personnel Practices and Benefits

### Leave Time Practices

The predominant practice with regard to the length of vacation leave is to provide two weeks for full-time employees after the first year of employment. After five years of employment, most agencies offer three or four weeks vacation. The predominant practice is to provide 12 days of sick leave annually for full-time employees.

Almost a quarter (22%) of agencies provide no personal time to their employees, in addition to vacation and sick leave. Of the agencies that do provide personal leave, the predominant practice is to provide three days. The median number of paid holidays provided to full-time employees per year is 10.

### Insurance Practices

The majority of agencies who participated in the survey provide medical (95%) and dental (60%) insurance coverage for their full-time employees. With regard to coverage for the employee's dependents, the predominant practice is for organizations to pay none of the insurance premium.

The average increase for medical insurance premiums was 7.1% in 1993, 5.7% in 1994, and 3.6% in 1995. The reasons for the recent decrease was identified by some agencies as 1) the agency had experienced budget cuts and no longer provide full health insurance coverage for their employees or 2) the agency had changed the type of health coverage that is available to employees. Agencies indicated that the change was often to a managed care program within a health maintenance organization.

In several cases, survey respondents explained that they offer flexible benefit/cafeeteria/Section 125 plan. These agencies indicated that they offer full-time employees \$100 to \$300 credit a month toward insurance premiums of their choice.

### Other Benefits for Employees

In addition to health and dental insurance, the most common benefits offered to full-time employees include life insurance (79%), retirement (76%), long-term disability insurance (63%), tax deferred annuity (48%), and/or short-term disability insurance (38%). Of the agencies that offer their executive directors additional supplemental benefits, conferences and training (34%), professional dues (24%), and social/service club dues (22%) are the most common.

A large portion of agencies (38%) do not offer any benefits to their part-time staff. Of those who do offer benefits on a pro-rated basis, vacation, sick leave, retirement, and health care coverage are most common (in descending order). Agencies indicated that paid leave benefits were provided to part-time staff when they worked at least 20 hours a week. Retirement coverage was often provided only to part-time staff who worked at least 30 hours a week.

### Salary Increments

The average salary increase in 1994 was 3.49% compared to 3.63% expected salary increase in 1995. Agencies with budgets under \$200,000 will provide the largest salary increases in 1995 of 3.84%. Agencies in the Southeast region will provide the largest salary increases in 1995 of 3.94%.
