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ABSTRACT

Data on geographic origins of students in Kentucky's public and independent colleges and universities are reported in 29 tables. All higher education institutions, including two-year colleges, four-year colleges, and universities, are included. Tables present information on total and first-time freshmen enrollment by county and state of student origin for each institution type and for first-professional enrollments by county and state of origin for state-supported universities. Additional tables contain figures for total enrollment as a percentage of population and first-time freshmen as a percentage of high school graduates by county of origin for both state-supported and independent institutions. Of 27,618 first-time freshmen in the fall of 1994, 84.1 percent had Kentucky origins, 15.1% were from other states, and 0.9 percent were foreign students. In the first-professional degree programs at state-supported universities, 78.3 percent of students had origins in Kentucky, 20.3 percent were from other states, and 1.4 percent were foreign. (JLS)

ORIGIN OF ENROLLMENTS

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THE COUNCIL ON HIGHER EDUCATION

The Council on Higher Education serves as the coordinating agency for higher education in Kentucky. Among its responsibilities, the Council:

- Develops and implements plans for a coordinated system of higher education;
- Sets the mission for each public higher education institution;
- Reviews and authorizes all degree programs at the public colleges and universities;
- Establishes minimum admission requirements for the public institutions;
- In cooperation with the university presidents, devises, establishes and periodically reviews formulas to be used in making funding recommendations;
- Develops and presents the biennial budget request for public higher education;
- Sets tuition rates for the public colleges and universities; and
- Directs or coordinates statewide higher education programs.

The Council is composed of 17 voting citizen members appointed by the Governor, including a student representative, and the Commissioner of Education as a nonvoting ex officio member. The membership is drawn from the seven congressional districts and the baccalaureate alumni of the eight public universities as well as members-at-large.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report displays information on the geographic origin of students enrolled in Kentucky higher education institutions in fall 1994. These institutions include state-supported universities and community colleges and independent four-year and two-year colleges and universities. Bible colleges licensed by the Council on Higher Education and submitting data to the Council are also included.

State-supported and independent colleges and universities enrolled a total of 176,871 students in fall 1994. Kentucky origin was reported for 85.0 percent of these students; 13.0 percent were from other states and 1.9 percent were from foreign countries and territories. State-supported universities reported 82.4 percent of their enrollment with Kentucky origin; the community colleges reported 96.9 percent. Students with Kentucky origin made up 73.5 percent of the enrollment at independent four-year institutions and 96.0 percent at the two-year colleges. Independent bible colleges reported Kentucky origin for 63.1 percent of their enrollment.

Other states supplied 13.0 percent of the total enrollment and students from foreign countries and territories made up the remaining 1.9 percent. State-supported universities reported 14.8 percent of their students from other states and 2.8 percent from foreign countries and territories; community colleges had 2.9 percent enrollment from other states and 0.1 percent foreign students. Students from other states represented 24.8 percent of the four-year independent enrollment with an additional 1.7 percent foreign students. Comparable percentages at the independent two-year colleges are 2.1 percent from other states and 1.9 percent foreign. Independent bible colleges reported 35.2 percent from other states and 1.7 percent from foreign countries. Detailed data by specific county and state are in Reports 1 through 12.

Of the 27,618 first-time freshmen enrolled in Kentucky's state-supported and independent institutions in fall 1994, 84.1 percent had Kentucky origin, 15.1 percent were from other states and 0.9 percent were foreign students. State-supported universities reported that 81.5 percent of their first-time freshmen were from Kentucky, and the community colleges reported 96.7 percent. Kentucky students represented 67.2 percent of the first-time freshmen at four-year independent institutions, and 96.6 percent at the two-year colleges. Independent bible colleges reported Kentucky origin for 62.5 percent of their enrollment. Reports 13 through 24 provide county and state data on first-time freshmen.

In the first-professional programs at the state-supported universities, 78.3 percent of the students had origin in Kentucky, 20.3 percent were from other states and 1.4 percent were of foreign origin. Reports 25 and 26 contain detail on first-professional enrollment by program and by county and state.

Comparisons of Kentucky county populations, high school graduates and first-time freshmen appear in Reports 28 and 29.

Data in this publication were compiled by the Council on Higher Education staff from the Council on Higher Education data files, the 1990 United States Census, and the Kentucky Department of Education report on high school graduates.

The following definitions are those officially established for the reporting of enrollment data to the Council on Higher Education. Data in the report are based on net headcount enrollment as of the last day to add a course for credit. This date is the one established by each institution as the official cut-off date.

County, State, Territory, or Foreign Country Of Origin

County, state, territory or country of student's legal residence at time of first admission to an institution

First-Professional Student

Student enrolled in dentistry, law, medicine, or "Pharm-D" programs

First-Time Freshman

Student who has not previously attended any college or university, or who attended college level courses as a high school student and is currently enrolled for the first time since high school graduation

Kentucky High School Graduate

Student graduating from a Kentucky high school

In-State Enrollment (Resident Student)

Student who is a legal resident of Kentucky as determined by the Kentucky Council on Higher Education's "Policy on Classification of Students for Fee Assessment Purposes at State-Supported Institutions of Higher Education"

Out-Of-State Enrollment (Nonresident Student)

Student who is not a legal resident of Kentucky as determined by the Kentucky Council on Higher Education's "Policy on Classification of Students for Fee Assessment Purposes at State-Supported Institutions of Higher Education" (foreign students are out-of-state)

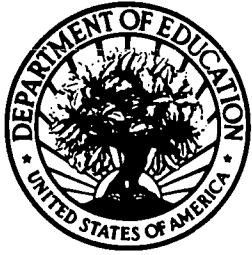
