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ABSTRACT

This report contains a collection of statistical data and facts concerning institutions of higher education in Kentucky for the period 1986-1995. Introductory material provides definitions of terms and lists Kentucky colleges and universities. It includes data for state-supported institutions and independent colleges and universities, bible colleges, and seminaries. Tables are grouped into those providing data on enrollment, degrees conferred, faculty and staff, finances, and facilities. Each section is preceded by selected data highlights. Among highlights are the following: total headcount enrollment at state-supported institutions increased by 29 percent; black student enrollment increased by 46 percent during the same period; total degrees conferred increased by 24 percent during this period; degrees awarded to older students increased by 50 percent; the greatest increase in employment at both universities and community colleges was in professional nonfaculty; total revenue increased by 89 percent while expenditures increased by 84 percent; the total value of the physical facilities was estimated at \$2.2 billion; Data are also provided for independent institutions for enrollment and degrees conferred. Kentucky's public higher education system is made up of 8 universities and 14 community colleges. A separate board governs each university, with the community college system as a part of the University of Kentucky. This publication includes data for the public institutions as well as independent colleges and universities, bible colleges, and seminaries that are licensed by the CHE or are members of the Association of Independent Kentucky Colleges and Universities.

The CHE serves as the coordinating agency for the public institutions. As such, it is the CHE's responsibility to engage in analysis and research to determine the overall needs of higher education in the Commonwealth. This responsibility is made possible by a comprehensive data base collected and maintained by CHE staff.

This ten-year *Information Digest* contains a collection of statistical data and facts collected by the CHE, and is designed as a reference tool for those with an interest in, or a need for, information on higher education. The selection of material for this volume has been based on requests most frequently made of CHE staff, and may be utilized to complement three other annual Council publications: *Kentucky College and University Enrollments*, *Kentucky College and University Origin of Enrollments*, and *Kentucky College and University Degrees and Other Formal Awards*.

- ***Kentucky College and University Enrollments:*** Provides statistical data on fall enrollments by student classification, full-time equivalent, black students, residency status, credit hours, degree field, and first-time transfers. The institutions included are Kentucky state-supported universities and community colleges, independent four-year and two-year institutions, and theological seminaries. Also included are other private colleges that are licensed by and submit data to the Council on Higher Education.
- ***Kentucky College and University Origin of Enrollments:*** Provides statistical fall enrollment data on the geographic origin of students. The institutions included are Kentucky state-supported universities and community colleges and independent four-year and two-year institutions. Also included are other private colleges that are licensed by and submit data to the Council on Higher Education.
- ***Kentucky College and University Degrees and Other Formal Awards:*** Provides statistical data on associate, baccalaureate, master's, specialist's, doctoral, and first-professional degrees and other formal awards conferred between July 1 and June 30. The institutions included are Kentucky state-supported universities and community colleges, independent four-year and two-year institutions, and theological seminaries. Also included are other private colleges that are licensed by and submit data to the Council on Higher Education.

The Kentucky Council on Higher Education does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age or disability in employment or the provision of services and provides, upon request, reasonable accommodation including auxiliary aids and services necessary to afford individuals with disabilities an equal opportunity to participate in all programs and activities.

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THE KENTUCKY COUNCIL ON HIGHER EDUCATION

The Kentucky Council on Higher Education (CHE) serves as the coordinating agency for higher education in Kentucky. Among its responsibilities, the CHE:

- Develops and implements plans for a coordinated system of higher education;
- Sets the mission for each public higher education institution;
- Reviews and authorizes all degree programs at the public colleges and universities;
- Establishes minimum admission requirements for the public institutions;
- In cooperation with the university presidents, devises, establishes and periodically reviews formulas to be used in making funding recommendations;
- Develops and presents the biennial budget request for public higher education;
- Sets tuition rates for the public colleges and universities; and
- Directs or coordinates statewide higher education programs.

The CHE is composed of 17 voting citizen members appointed by the Governor, including a student representative, and the Commissioner of Education as a nonvoting ex officio member. The membership is drawn from the seven State Supreme Court districts and the baccalaureate alumni of the eight public universities as well as members-at-large. Terms of members are for six years, except for the student member, whose term is for one year.

DEFINITIONS

Academic Support - Includes funds budgeted or expended primarily to provide support services for the institution's primary missions - instruction, research, and public service. This category includes the subprograms of museums and galleries, audiovisual services, academic computing support, ancillary support, academic administration, academic personnel development, and course and curriculum development.

Associate Degree - A degree below the baccalaureate level requiring at least two, but fewer than four, academic years of postsecondary education work.

Baccalaureate Degree - A degree generally requiring four to five academic years of college work.

Benchmark Institutions - The benchmarks are institutions which are similar to the Kentucky institutions in roles and missions, size, and programmatic composition; they are located primarily in the seven states contiguous to Kentucky.

County, State, Territory, or Foreign Country of Origin - County, state, territory, or country of student's legal residence at time of first admission to an institution.

Degree - An award conferred by a college, university, or other postsecondary educational institution as official recognition for the successful completion of a program of studies.

Doctoral Degree - The highest academic degree in a specified discipline.

Endowment Income - Includes: 1) unrestricted income of endowment and similar funds, 2) restricted income of endowment and similar funds to the extent expended for current operating purposes, and 3) income from funds held in irrevocable trust by others.

Executive/Administrative/Managerial - All persons whose assignments require primary (and major) responsibility for management of an institution, or a customarily recognized department or subdivision thereof. Assignments require the performance of work directly related to management policies or general business operations of the institution department or subdivision, etc. Assignments in this category customarily and regularly require the incumbent to exercise discretion and independent judgement, and to direct the work of others. This

category includes all officers holding such titles as President, Vice President, Dean, Director, or the equivalent, as well as officers subordinate to any of these administrators with such titles as Associate Dean, Executive Officer of academic department heads or the equivalent, if their principal activity is administrative.

Faculty - All persons whose specific assignments customarily are made for the purpose of conducting instruction, research, or public service as a principal activity (or activities), and who hold academic-rank, titles of professor, associate professor, assistant professor, instructor, lecturer, or the equivalent of any of these academic ranks. Also included in this category are Deans, Directors, or the equivalent, as well as Associate Deans, Assistant Deans, and executive officers of academic departments (chairpersons, heads, or the equivalent) if their principal activity is instructional.

Federal Revenue - Includes all restricted and unrestricted funds appropriated to an institution by the federal government to be expended for current operations. Also includes funds from the federal government for specific projects and programs (e.g., research).

First-Professional Degree - A degree requiring at least two years of college work prior to entrance to the program (specific degree programs are dentistry, medicine, pharmacy, law and theology).

First-Time Freshman - Student who has not previously attended any college or university, or a student who was enrolled as a high school student with early admission.

Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment - The unit of enrollment derived by the following formula: (undergraduate student credit hours divided by 16) + (graduate student credit hours divided by 12) + (law student credit hours divided by 14) + headcount of other first-professional students + headcount of post-doctoral students + headcount of doctoral dissertation students + headcount of house staff.

Full-Time Instructional Faculty - Instruction/Research staff employed full-time (as defined by the institution) and whose major regular assignment is instruction, including those with released time for research.

Full-Time Status - An undergraduate student enrolled for at least twelve semester credit hours; or a graduate student enrolled for at least nine credit hours (hours vary for first-professional full-time status).

Graduate Student - A student who holds a baccalaureate or first-professional degree, or equivalent, and is taking courses at the postbaccalaureate level.

Headcount Enrollment - The net total number of students enrolled.

House Staff (Residents and Interns) - An individual with a recognized terminal professional degree in one of the health professions who is engaged in postgraduate training in a program in the individual field (conducted in the university hospital or one of its affiliated institutions).

Institutional Support - Includes funds budgeted or expended for those activities carried out to provide for both day-to-day functioning and the long-range viability of the institution as an operating institution. Subcategories include executive management, fiscal operations, general administration and logistical services, administrative computing support, and public relations/development.

Instruction - Includes all funds budgeted or expended for credit and noncredit courses for academic, vocational, and remedial purposes in regular, special, and extension sessions. Expenditures for departmental research and public service that are not separately budgeted are also included. This category includes subcategories for general academic instruction, occupational/technical instruction, summer and special session instruction, community education, and preparatory/adult basic education.

Investment Income - Includes current funds revenue, interest, and dividends not reported under endowment or any other non-expendable fund income.

Joint Doctoral Student - A student enrolled in a doctoral program at a Kentucky institution with formal arrangements for earning credit at both a doctoral degree granting institution and the participating institution. A student enrolled in a doctoral program at an out-of-state institution with arrangements for earning credit at a Kentucky participating institution is reported as graduate nondegree.

Libraries - Includes all funds budgeted or expended for all activities that directly support the collection, cataloging, storage, and distribution of published materials in support of an institution's academic programs. To be included in this activity, a library should be separately organized and serve more than one academic department or activity.

Local Revenue - Includes all restricted and unrestricted funds appropriated to an institution by local government which are to be expended for current operations or a specific project or program.

Master's Degree - A degree customarily granted on successful completion of one or two academic years of work beyond the baccalaureate level.

Operation and Maintenance of Plant - Includes all funds budgeted or expended for the operation and maintenance of the physical plant, net amounts charged to auxiliary enterprises, hospitals, and/or independent operations. This category includes subcategories for physical plant administration, building maintenance, custodial service, utilities, landscape and grounds maintenance, and major repairs and renovations.

Other Formal Awards - Certificate or diploma designed for completion in programs less than one year, at least one but less than two years, or two but less than four academic years.

Part-Time Status - An undergraduate student enrolled for fewer than twelve semester credit hours; or a graduate student enrolled for fewer than nine semester credit hours (hours vary for first-professional part-time status).

Post-Doctoral Student - Student pursuing work in a discipline in which he or she has been awarded the terminal degree.

Private Gifts, Grants and Contracts - Includes amounts from individuals or nongovernmental organizations. The funds included in this revenue source are of two types: (1) private gifts and grants, and (2) private contracts. Private gifts and grants include those funds received from private donors for which no legal consideration is involved, i.e., no specific goods or services must be provided to the donor in return for the funds. Private contracts include those funds received for which specific goods and services must be provided to the funder as a stipulation for receipt of the funds. This category includes all unrestricted gifts, grants, and bequests as well as all restricted gifts, grants, and contracts to the extent that revenues received are expended in the year received.

Professional Nonfaculty - Persons employed for the primary purpose of performing academic support, student service, and institutional support activities and whose assignments would require either college graduation or experience of such kind and amount as to provide a comparable background. Included in this category are librarians, accountants, personnel, counselors, systems analysts, coaches, lawyers, and pharmacists.

Public Service - Includes funds budgeted or expended for activities established primarily to provide noninstructional services beneficial to individuals outside the institution. This category includes subcategories for community service, cooperative extension service, and public broadcasting services.

Race/Ethnicity - Categories used to describe groups to which individuals belong, identify with, or belong in the eyes of the community. The categories do not denote scientific definitions of anthropological origins. A person may be counted in only one group. The categories are:

American Indian or Alaskan Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

Asian or Pacific Islander - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian Subcontinent, or Pacific Islands. This includes people from China, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands, Samoa, India, and Vietnam.

Black, Non-Hispanic - A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa (except those of Hispanic origin).

Hispanic - A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

Nonresident Alien - A person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely.

White, Non-Hispanic - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, or the Middle East.

Research - Includes funds budgeted or expended for activities specifically organized to produce research outcomes, whether commissioned by an agency external to the institution or separately budgeted by an organizational unit within the institution. Subject to these conditions, it includes funds budgeted or expended for individual and/or project research as well as those of institutes and research centers. Funds for departmental research that are separately budgeted specifically for research are included in this category.

Sales and Services of Auxiliary Enterprises/Hospitals - Includes all revenues, including funds assigned to debt service generated by the auxiliary enterprise and/or hospital operations. Hospital revenue is net of discounts, allowances, and provision for doubtful accounts and does not include revenues for research and other specific purpose gifts, grants, and endowment income restricted to the hospital.

Secretarial/Clerical - All persons whose assignments typically are associated with clerical activities or are specifically secretarial in nature. Included are personnel who are responsible for internal and external communications, recording and retrieval of data (other than

computer programmers) and/or information and other paper work required in an office, such as bookkeepers, stenographers, clerk typists, office machine operators, statistical clerks, payroll clerks, etc. Also included are sales clerks such as those employed full-time in the bookstore, and library clerks who are not recognized as librarians.

Service/Maintenance - Persons whose assignments require limited degrees of previously acquired skills and knowledge and in which workers perform duties which result in or contribute to the comfort, convenience, and hygiene of personnel and the student body or which contribute to the upkeep and care of buildings, facilities, or grounds of the institutional property. Included in this category are chauffeurs, laundry and dry cleaning operators, cafeteria and restaurant workers, truck drivers, bus drivers, garage laborers, custodial personnel, gardeners and groundskeepers, refuse collectors, construction laborers, and security personnel.

Scholarships and Fellowships - Includes funds budgeted or expended for scholarships and fellowships in the form of outright grants to students selected by the institution and financed from current funds, restricted or unrestricted. Also includes trainee stipends, prizes, and awards, except trainee stipends awarded to individuals who are not enrolled in formal coursework, which are charged to instruction, research or public service, as appropriate. Aid to students in the form of tuition or fee remissions is included in this category.

Skilled Craft - Persons whose assignments typically require special manual skills and a thorough and comprehensive knowledge of the processes involved in the work, acquired through on-the-job training and experience or through apprenticeship or other formal training programs. Included in this category are mechanics and repairers, electricians, stationary engineers, skilled machinists, carpenters, compositors and typesetters, and upholsterers.

Specialist's Degree - Degree in specific disciplines requiring work beyond the master's degree.

State General Fund - Includes all restricted and unrestricted funds appropriated to an institution by the General Assembly which are to be expended for current operations.

Student Services - Includes funds budgeted or expended for those activities whose primary purpose is to contribute to the student's intellectual, cultural, and social development outside the context of the formal instruction program. This category includes subcategories for student services administration, social and cultural development, counseling and career guidance, financial aid administration, student admission, student records, student health services, and intercollegiate athletics. Intercollegiate Athletics is categorized as a student services "educational and general" expenditure unless it is operating as a self-supporting activity and, therefore, reported as an auxiliary enterprise operation. Examples of intercollegiate athletics expenditures are salaries of coaches and trainers, officiating, travel, grants-in-

aid, ticket sales, and advertising. Excluded from intercollegiate athletics are those activities that relate to intramural athletics and to student financial aid.

Technical/Paraprofessional - Persons whose assignments require specialized knowledge or skills which may be acquired through experience or academic work such as is offered in many two-year technical institutes, junior colleges, or through equivalent on-the-job training. Included in this category are computer programmers and operators, drafters, engineering aides, junior engineers, mathematical aides, licensed practical or vocational nurses, dietitians, photographers, radio operators, scientific assistants, technical illustrators, technicians (medical, dental, electronic, physical sciences), and similar occupational-activity categories but which are institutionally defined as technical assignments. Also included are persons who perform some of the duties of a professional or technician in a supportive role, which usually require less formal training and/or experience normally required for professional technical status. Such positions may fall within an identified pattern of staff development and promotion under a "New Careers" concept.

Tenure - Status of a personnel position, or a person occupying a position or occupation, with respect to performance or position.

Tenure Track - Positions that lead to consideration for tenure.

Tuition and Fees - Includes all charges (net of refunds) against students for educational and general purposes. Charges for room, board, and other services rendered by auxiliary enterprises are not included in this category, but are classified as auxiliary enterprises revenue.

Undergraduate Student - A student enrolled in a four-year or five-year baccalaureate degree program, in an associate degree program, or in a vocational or technical program below the baccalaureate.

ENROLLMENT

- Total headcount enrollment at the state-supported institutions increased by 29 percent from Fall 1986 to Fall 1995. University enrollment increased by 18 percent, and UK Community College enrollment increased by 71 percent.
- Full-time equivalent enrollment at the state-supported institutions increased by 30 percent during the same time period.
- Between Fall 1986 and Fall 1995, first-time freshman enrollment increased by 7 percent at the state-supported universities and by 60 percent at the UK Community Colleges.
- Black student enrollment at the state-supported institutions increased by 46 percent during the same time period.
- Students from Kentucky made up 86 percent of the total Fall 1995 state-supported enrollment.
- In Fall 1986, part-time students made up 38 percent of the total state-supported enrollment; by Fall 1995, this decreased to 36 percent. Part-time student enrollment at the UK Community Colleges decreased from 57 percent in Fall 1986 to 53 percent in Fall 1995.
- In Fall 1986, nontraditional students (age 25 and older) made up 38 percent of the total state-supported enrollment; in Fall 1995, nontraditional students represented 40 percent of the enrollment.

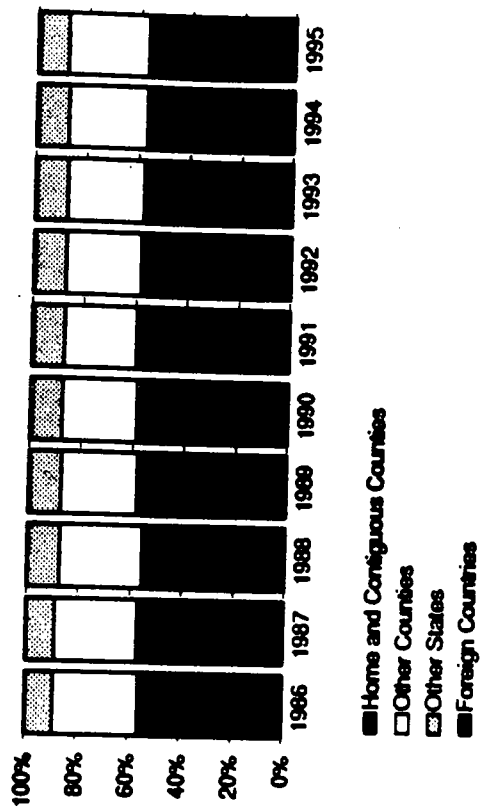

KENTUCKY STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS - FALL 1995**

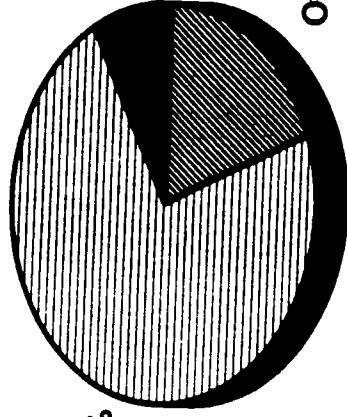

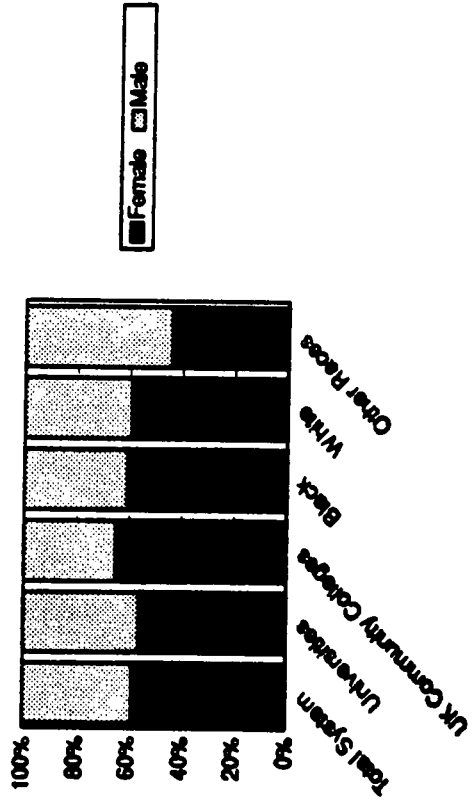

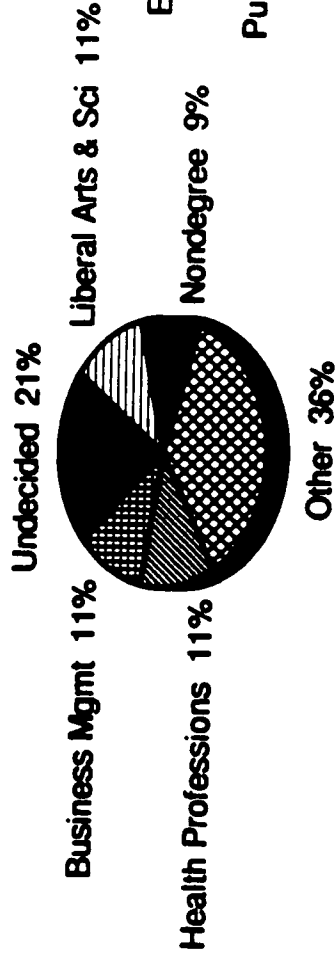

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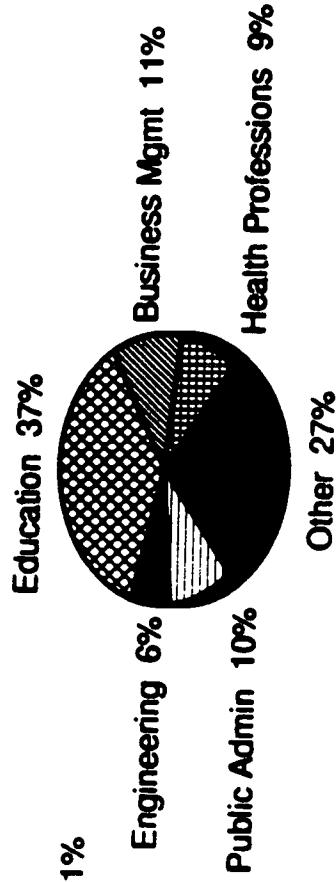
HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT BY DISCIPLINE - FALL 1995

UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT



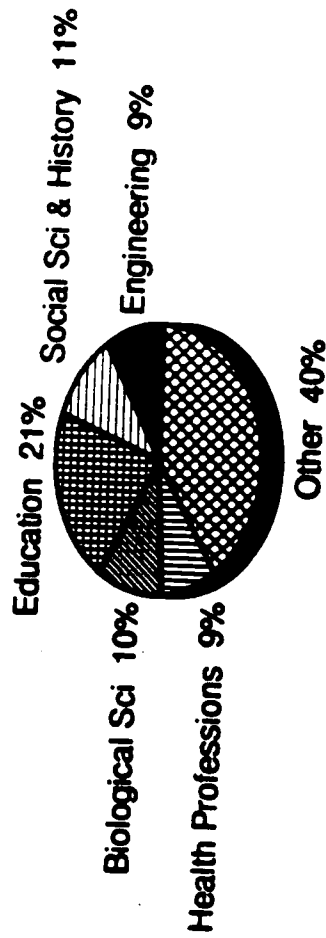

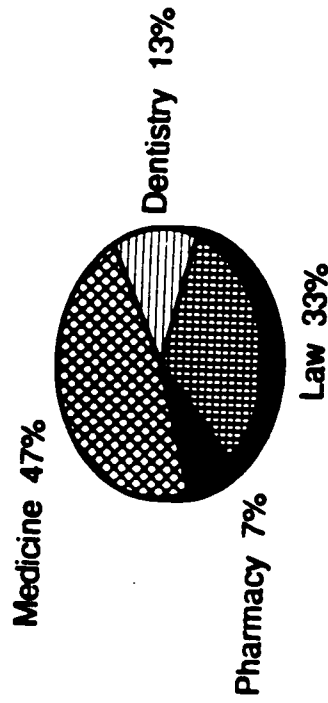

FIRST-PROFESSIONAL ENROLLMENT

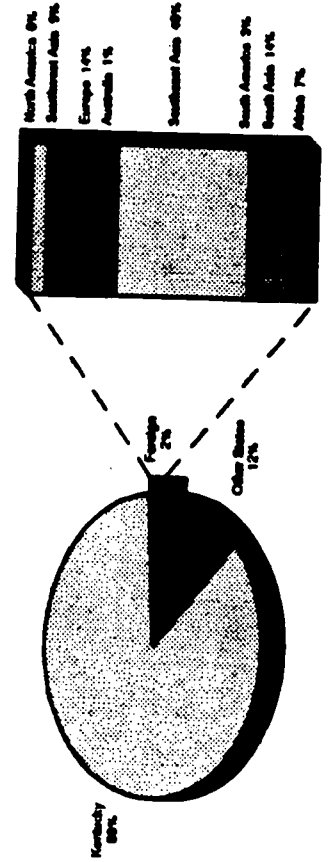

DEGREES CONFERRED

- Total degrees and other formal awards conferred by the state-supported institutions increased by 24 percent between 1985/86 and 1994/95. The universities experienced a 21 percent increase, while the UK Community Colleges experienced a 41 percent increase in degrees awarded.
- During this same period, degrees awarded by state-supported institutions decreased by 3 percent to students 24 years and under, and increased by 50 percent to nontraditional students (age 25 years and older).
- Nontraditional students made up 34 percent of the 1985/86 university undergraduate degree recipients, and 46 percent of the 1994/95 university undergraduate degree recipients. UK Community College nontraditional degree recipients increased from 54 percent in 1985/86 to 71 percent in 1994/95.
- Degrees awarded to black students by state-supported institutions increased by 33 percent between 1985/86 and 1994/95.
- During this same time period, degrees awarded by state-supported institutions to male students increased by 11 percent. Degrees awarded to female students increased by 34 percent.

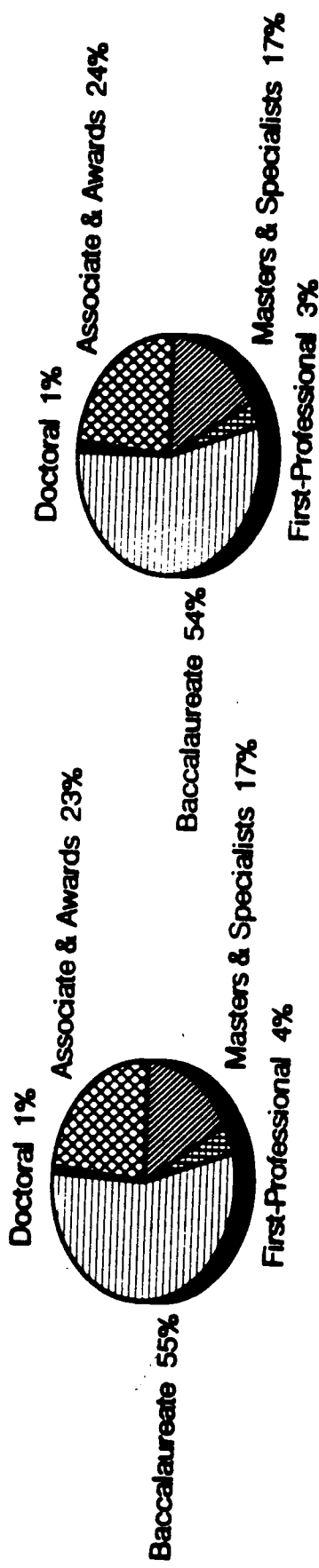

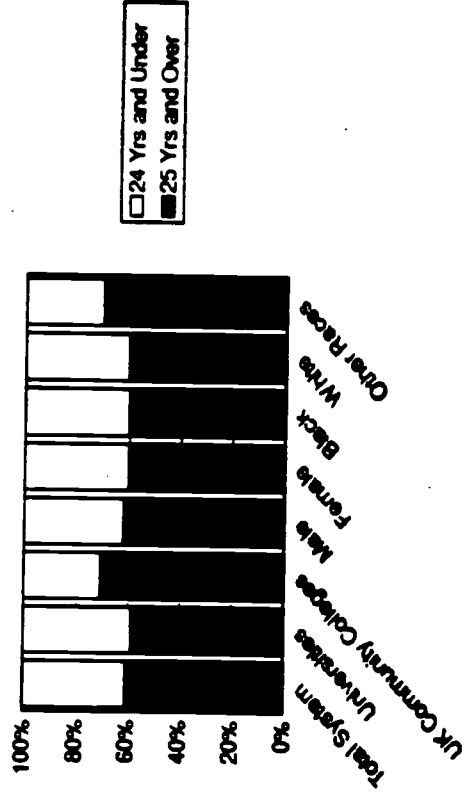

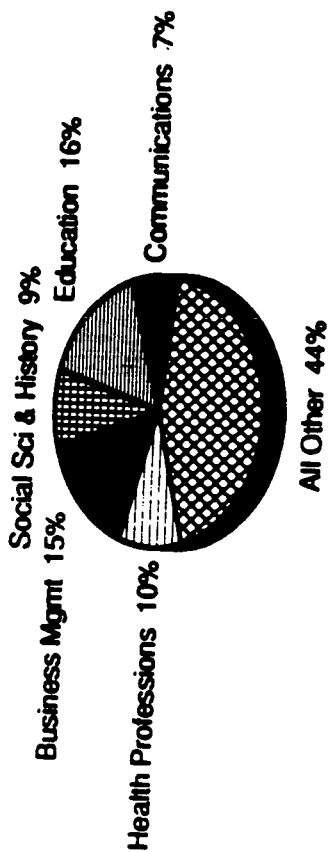

Baccalaureate Degrees



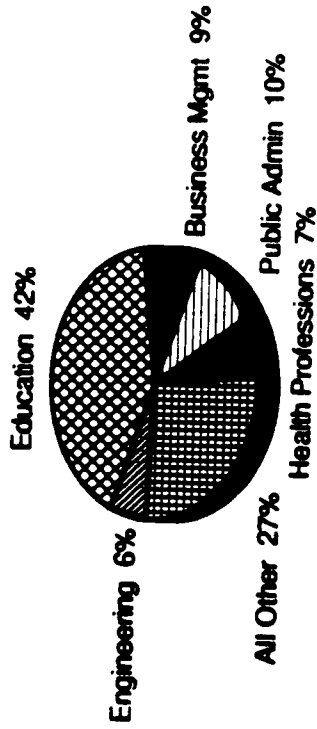

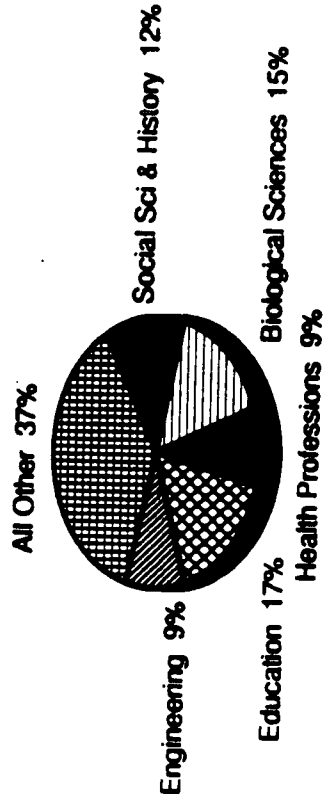

Masters & Specialists Degrees



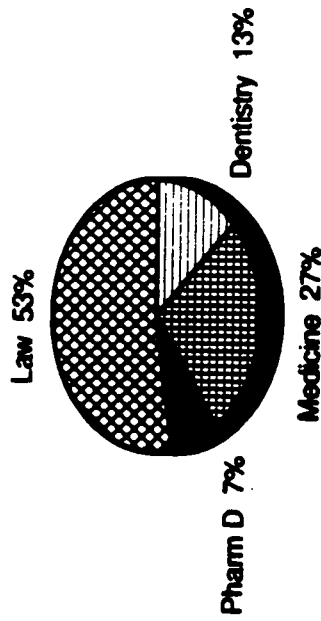

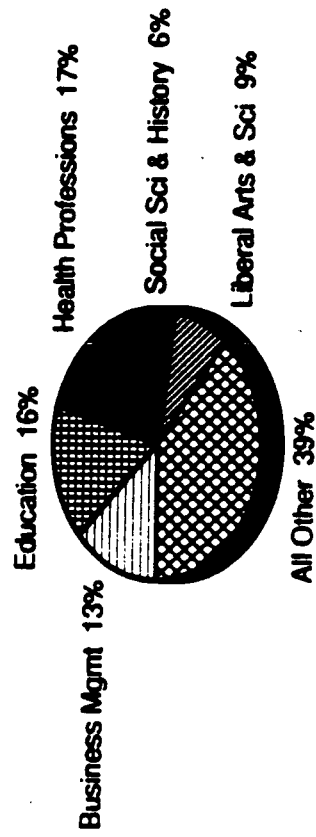

FACULTY AND STAFF

- The largest increase in employment between Fall 1986 and Fall 1995 was in Professional Nonfaculty, by 53 percent at the universities and by 228 percent at the UK Community Colleges.
- During this same time period, full-time faculty increased by 12 percent at the universities and by 60 percent at the UK Community Colleges.
- Full-time tenured faculty increased by 12 percent, and nontenured faculty increased by 18 percent at the state-supported institutions.

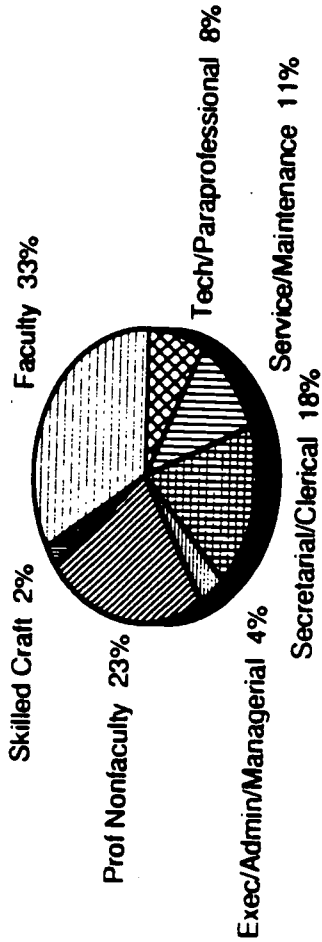

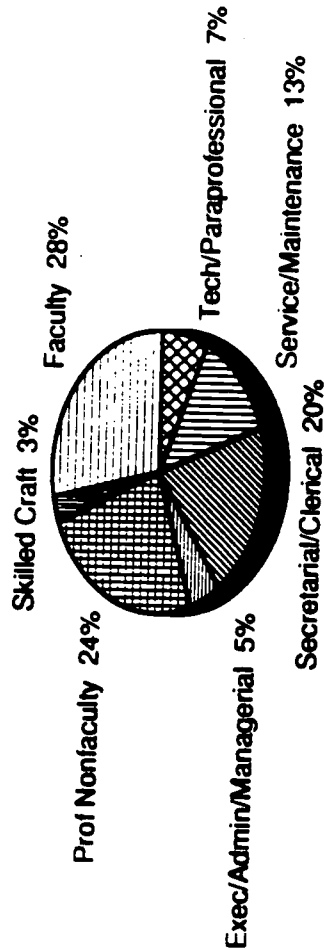

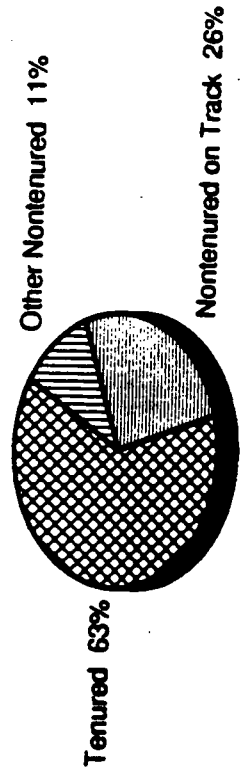
TOTAL FACULTY AND STAFF BY EEOC CATEGORY



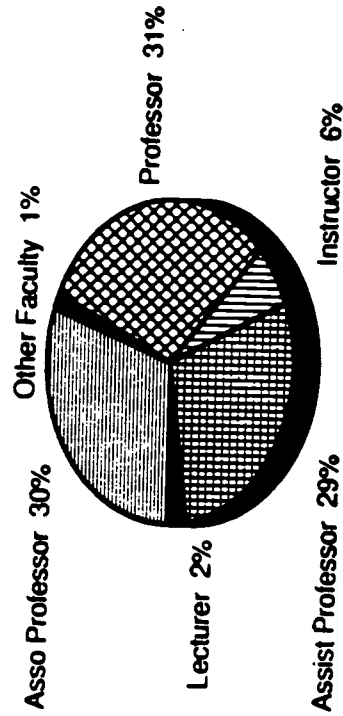
FULL-TIME FACULTY AND STAFF BY EEOC CATEGORY

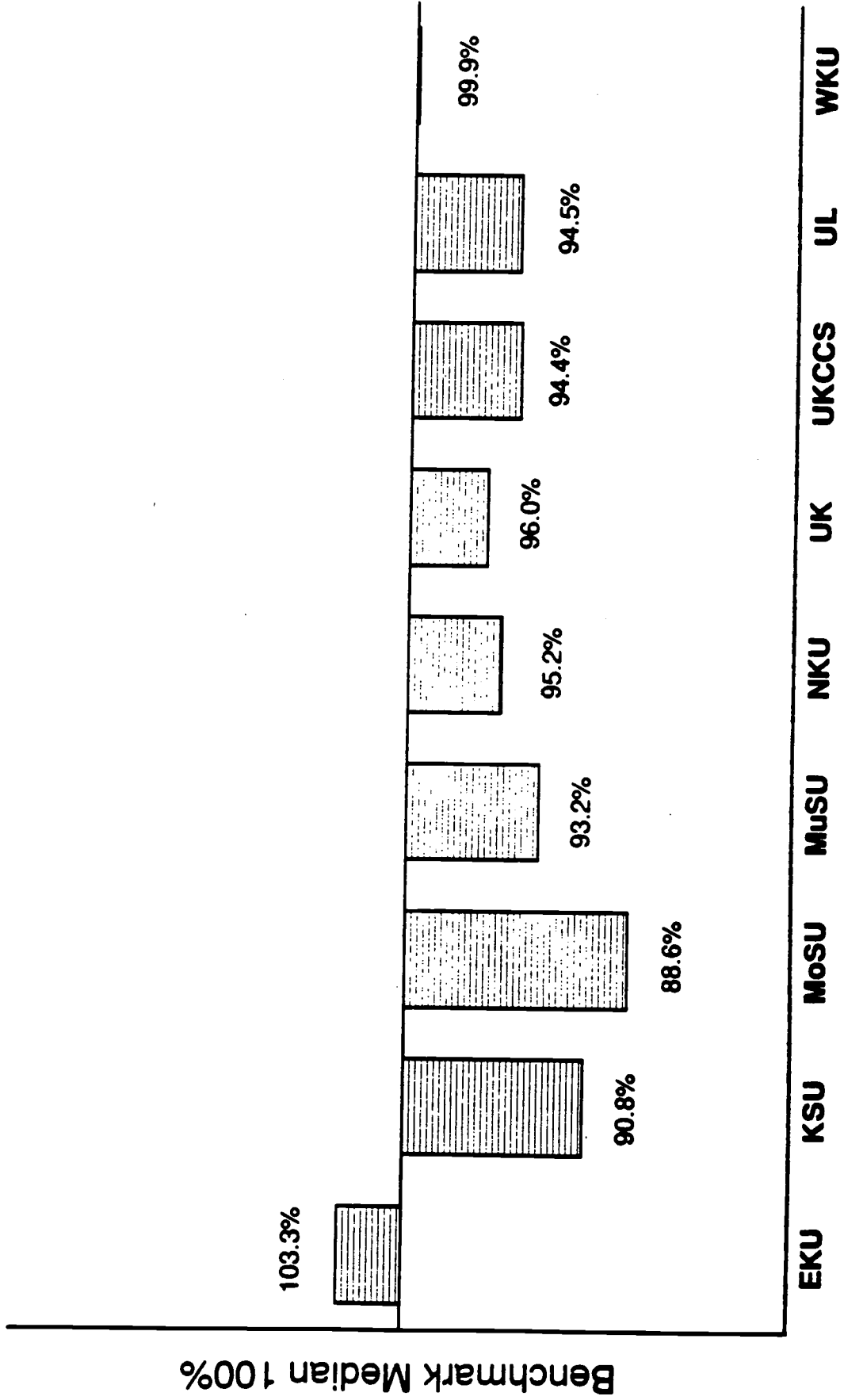

FINANCES

- Between 1985/86 and 1997/98, resident undergraduate tuition will increase:
 - ▶ 110 percent at the doctoral institutions (UK and UL);
 - ▶ 104 percent at the master's institutions (EKU, KSU, MoSU, MuSU, NKU, and WKU); and
 - ▶ 96 percent at the UK Community Colleges.
- Total revenue increased from \$976.1 million in 1985/86 to \$1,842.4 million in 1995/96 - - an increase of 89 percent.
 - ▶ State General Fund, as a percent of total revenue, decreased from 45 percent in 1985/86 to 37 percent in 1994/95.
 - ▶ Tuition and Fees, as a percent of total revenue, increased from 13 percent in 1985/86 to 17 percent in 1994/95.
- Total expenditures increased from \$962.6 million in 1985/86 to \$1,770.7 million in 1994/95 - - an 84 percent increase.
 - ▶ Expenditures for instruction decreased from 29 percent of total expenditures in 1985/86 to 28 percent in 1994/95.

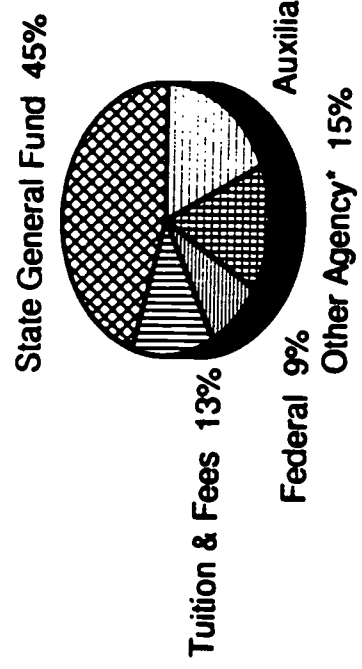

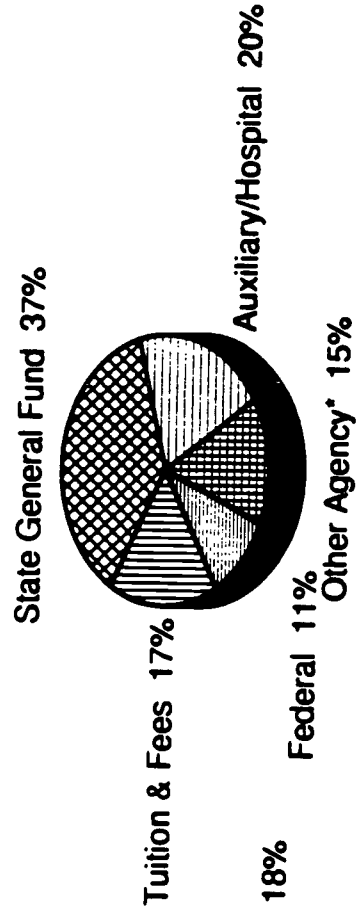

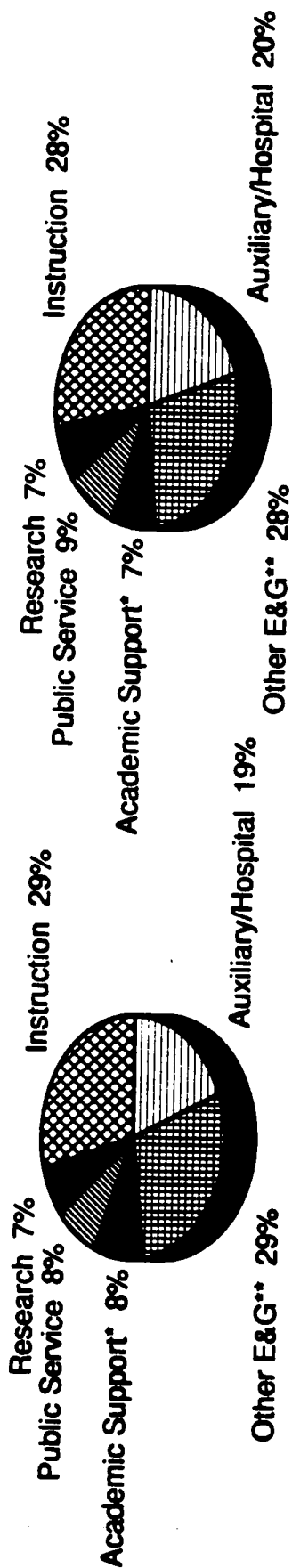

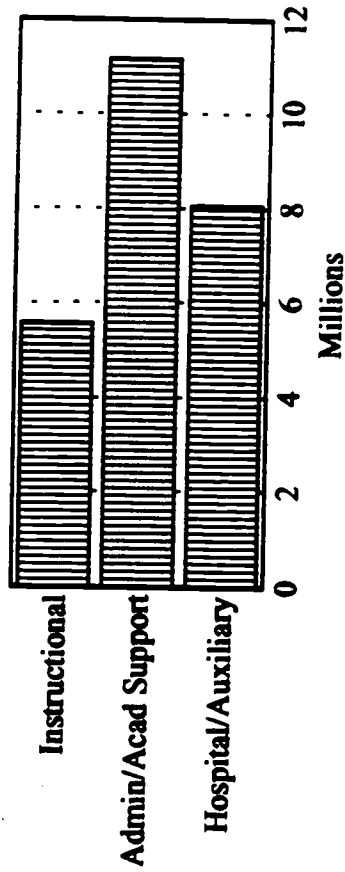

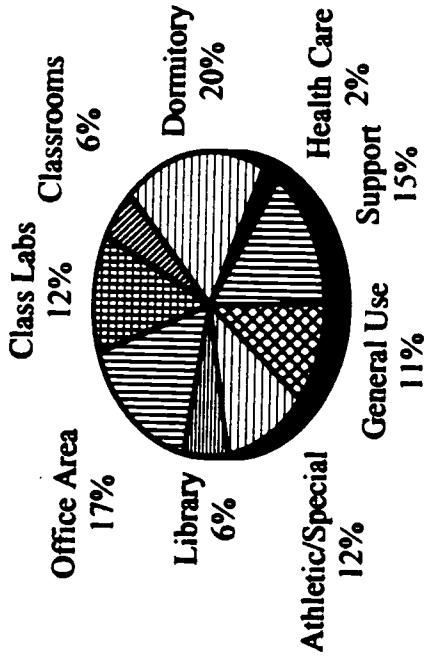

KENTUCKY STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS FALL 1995

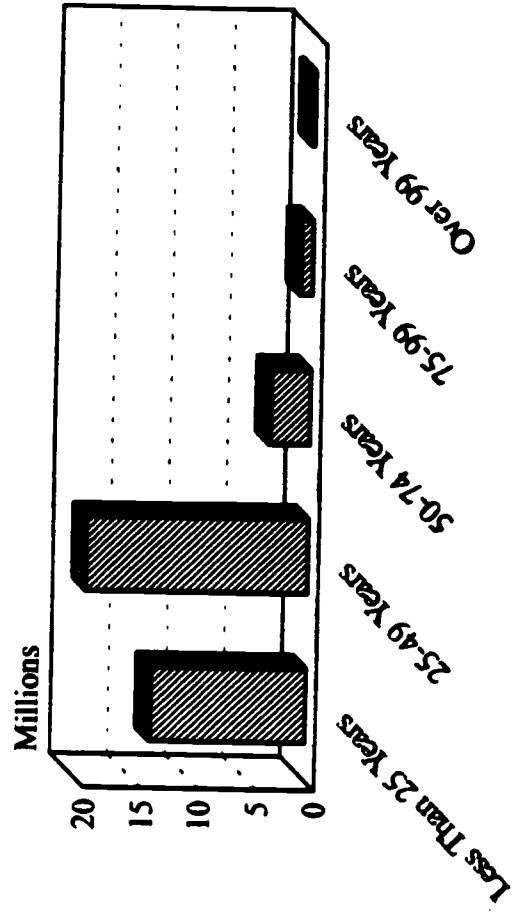
ROOM SQUARE FOOTAGE BY CLASSIFICATION



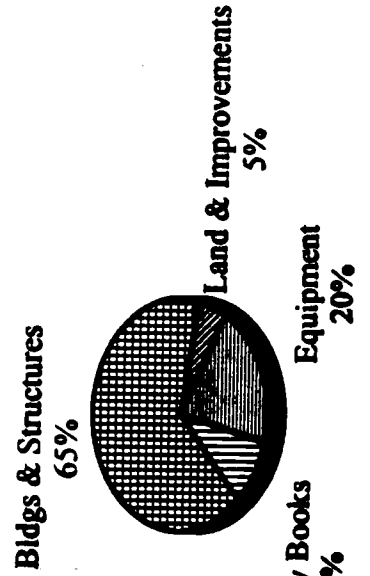
ASSIGNABLE SPACE BY TYPE

INDEPENDENT INSTITUTIONS

- Between Fall 1986 and Fall 1995, total headcount enrollment increased by 14 percent at the two-year and four-year independent institutions. (Complete ten-year data is not available for the other independent institutions.)
- Part-time students made up 28 percent of the total enrollment at the two-year and four-year independent institutions in Fall 1995.
- During the five-year period from Fall 1991 to Fall 1995, black student enrollment at the two-year and four-year independent institutions increased by 1 percent.
- In Fall 1995, students from Kentucky made up 74 percent of the total enrollment at the two-year and four-year independent institutions.
- Between 1985/86 and 1994/95, total degrees and other formal awards conferred by the two-year and four-year independent institutions increased by 11 percent.
- In 1994/95, 4 percent of the total degrees were awarded to black students by the two-year and four-year independent institutions
- In 1994/95, 35 percent of the total degrees were awarded by the two-year and four-year independent institutions to male students; 65 percent of the total degrees were awarded to female students.

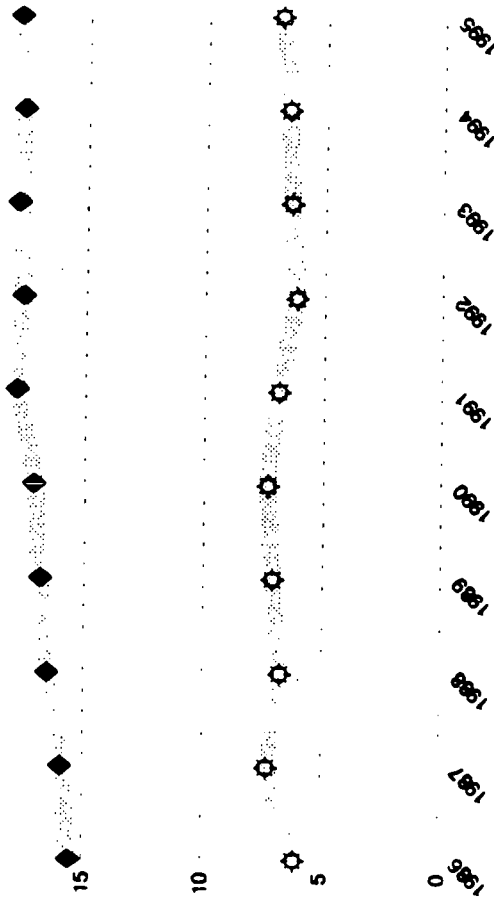

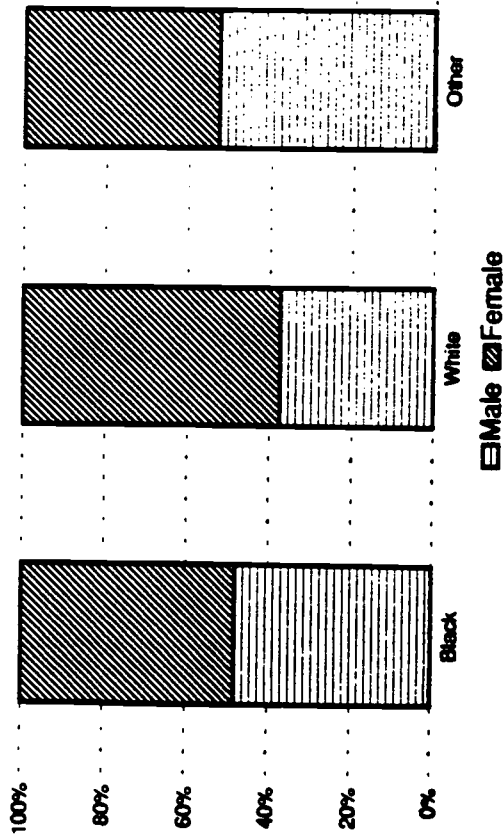
KENTUCKY FOUR-YEAR AND TWO-YEAR INDEPENDENT INSTITUTIONS - FALL 1995

HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT BY FULL-TIME/PART-TIME STATUS

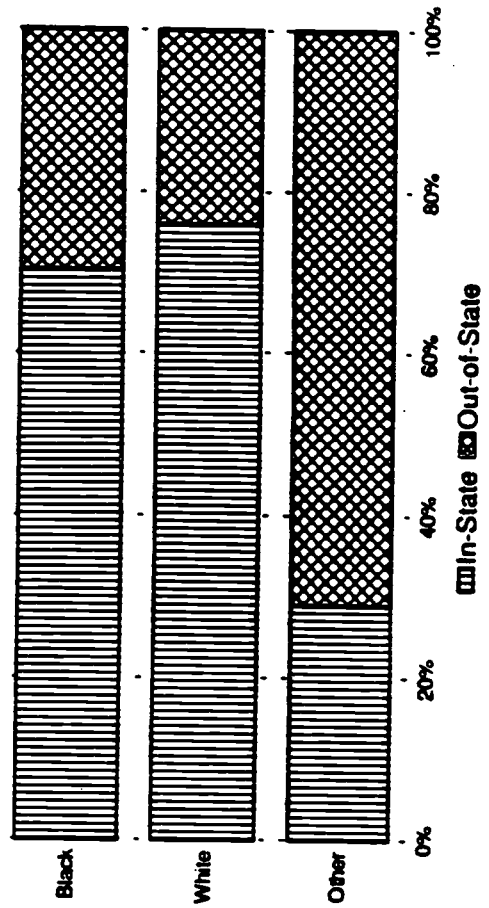
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HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT BY RACE AND GENDER

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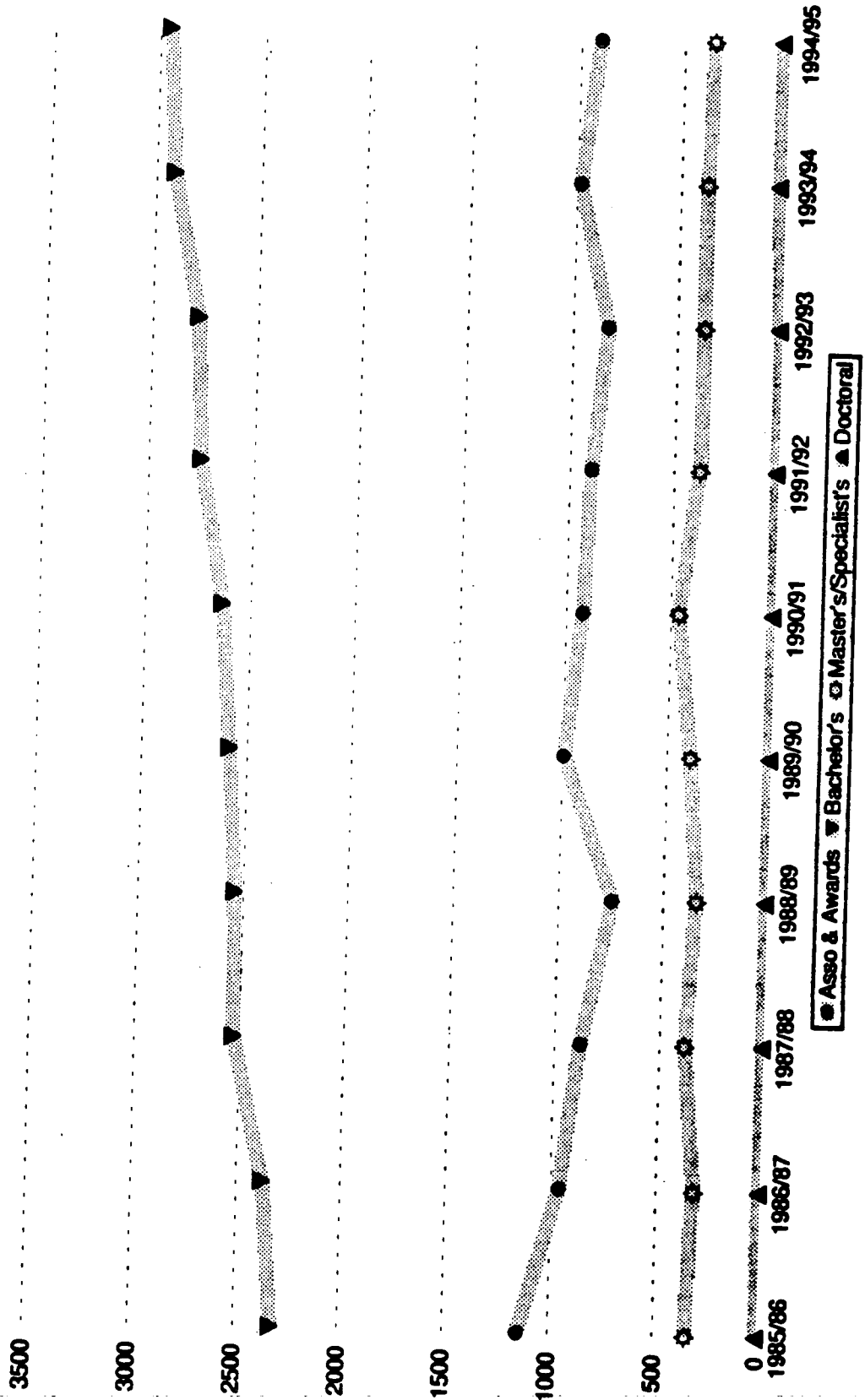

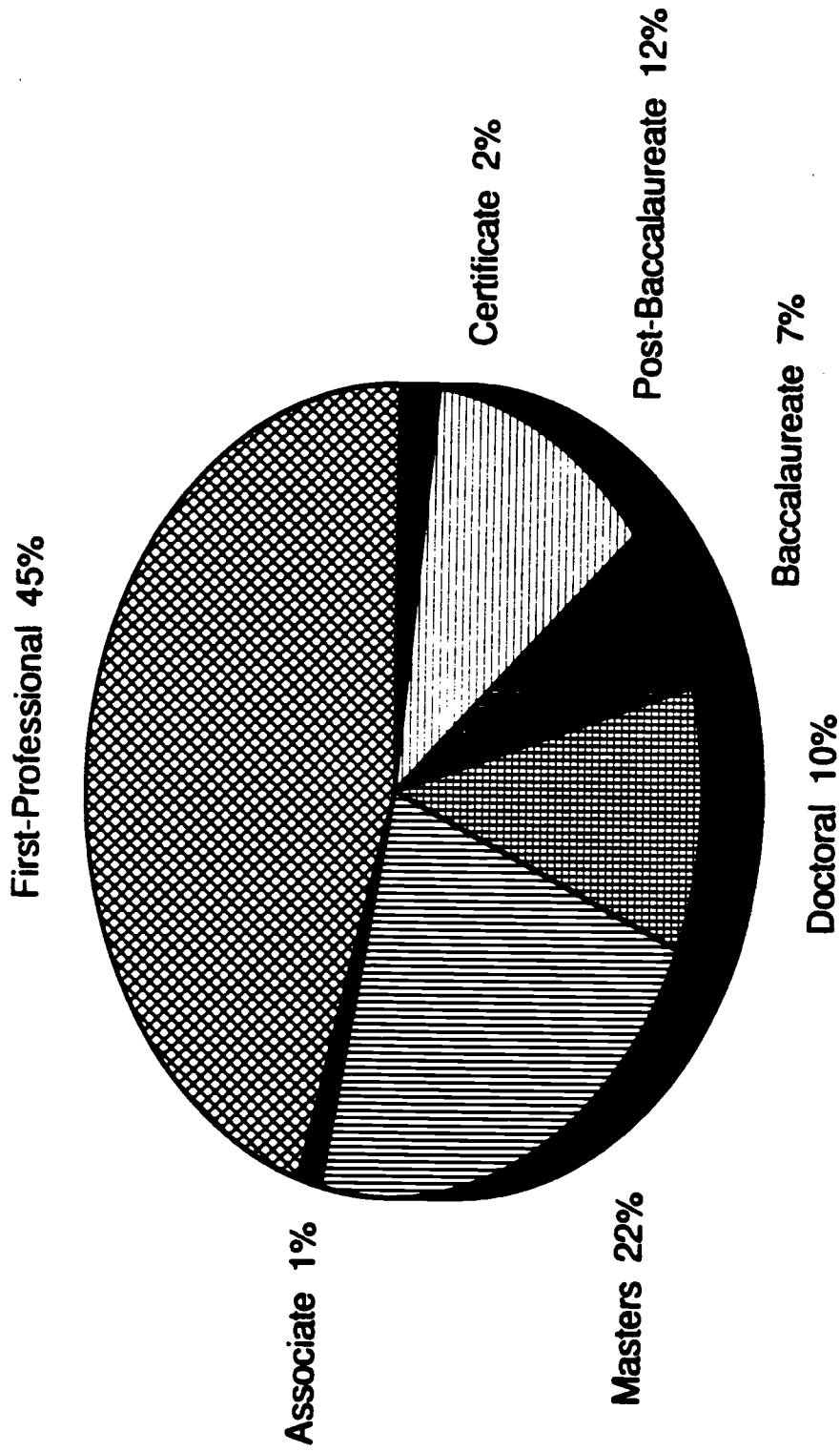
**DEGREES AND OTHER FORMAL AWARDS CONFERRED
