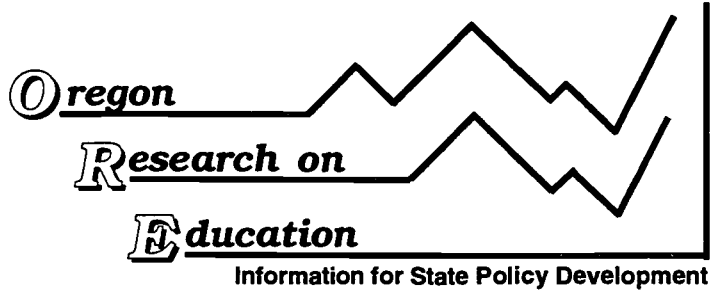

ABSTRACT

This document presents data in lists and in tabular form on colleges attended by graduates of Oregon secondary schools for the fall of 1994. The lists presented include the seven state universities, 16 community colleges, and 20 private colleges and universities within the state attended by these students. The first table presents a breakdown by county of 1994 high school graduates admitted in the same year to Oregon colleges. Out of a total of 28,237 high school graduates, 11,743 (42 percent) were enrolled in Oregon Colleges. Of these college freshmen, 4,500 were attending state institutions, 5,801 were at community colleges, and 1,442 were enrolled in private institutions. A breakdown of Oregon high school graduates admitted by Oregon colleges the fall following graduation for the years 1985 to 1994 is also given. The remaining tables list the number of high school graduates of the class of 1994 enrolled in state colleges and universities by college attended; in community colleges by college attended; and in independent colleges and universities by college attended.
