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ABSTRACT

This publication presents findings from two national enrollment surveys on 10 year trends in higher education enrollment by racial/ethnic category in 17 tables. The surveys used are the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS) and the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). The data presented are for about 3,600 accredited postsecondary institutions in 50 states and the District of Columbia. Tables present data on the following: enrollment trends for institutions of higher education by racial/ethnic categories and by selected student and institutional characteristics; final fall enrollments in institutions of higher education by state and by racial/ethnic category for 1990, 1991, and 1992; the number of postsecondary and higher education institutions in 1992 by state; the response rates to the IPEDS fall enrollment survey; and the impact of imputation on the data. Among 12 conclusions highlighted are the following: (1) enrollment in 1992 showed an overall increase over 1982 of 17 percent with minority enrollment increasing more than enrollment by whites; (2) during this time enrollment increased 8.7 percent for Whites, 26.6 percent for Blacks, 83.9 percent for Hispanics, 98.5 percent for Asians or Pacific Islanders, 35.1 percent for American Indians or Alaskan Natives, and 38.3 percent for nonresident aliens. 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Highlights ¹

- Enrollment in higher education institutions increased by approximately 132,000 students between 1991 and 1992, an increase of only 1 percent—substantially less than the 540,000 increase (3.9 percent increase) between 1990 and 1991 (derived from table 1).
- Enrollment in public institutions accounted for nearly 80 percent of the total enrollment at institutions of higher education in 1992. About 79 to 87 percent of the blacks, Hispanics, Asian or Pacific Islanders, and American Indian or Alaskan Natives and 67 percent of the nonresident aliens enrolled in institutions of higher education were at public institutions (derived from table 1).
- Enrollment in 1992, as compared to 1982, shows an overall increase of 17 percent, with enrollment by minority students increasing more than enrollment by white, non-Hispanics. In this time period, enrollment increased 8.7 percent for white, non-Hispanics, 26.6 percent for blacks, 83.9 percent for Hispanics, 98.5 percent for Asians or Pacific Islanders, 35.1 percent for American Indians or Alaskan Natives, and 38.3 percent for nonresident aliens (derived from table 1).
- Although the comparison of 1992 and 1982 shows that enrollment at institutions of higher education by white, non-Hispanics increased by approximately 9 percent, their overall enrollment declined by 1.1 percent between 1991 and 1992. Specifically, enrollment in this period by white, non-Hispanics declined by 1.6 percent in public institutions while their enrollment increased by .6 percent in private institutions. Enrollment by male white, non-Hispanics declined by 2 percent in public institutions and by .3 percent in private institutions. Enrollment by female white, non-Hispanics, also declined by 1.2 percent at public institutions but increased by 1.5 percent at private institutions (derived from tables 1 through 1d).
- Enrollment growth by minority students continued between 1991 and 1992. Specifically, enrollment by blacks increased 4.4 percent, by Hispanics 10.1 percent, by Asians or Pacific Islanders 9.4 percent, by American Indian or Alaskan Natives 4.5 percent, and by nonresident aliens 9.9 percent (derived from table 1).
- Approximately 56 percent of all postsecondary students were enrolled full-time in the period between 1990 and 1992. Among full-time students approximately 74 percent attended public institutions and 75 percent attended 4-year institutions (derived from tables 1c, 1d, 2c, and 2d).

¹Percentages reported in the highlights were calculated prior to rounding while numbers reported in tables 1, 2, and 4 are rounded to the thousands. Rounding obscures differences, particularly when numbers are small.

- Of the 44 percent of all students who attended postsecondary institutions part-time in the fall of 1992, approximately 42 percent attended 2-year institutions and approximately 85 percent attended public institutions (derived from tables 1c, 1d, 2c, and 2d).
- About 53 percent of the net increase in enrollment in institutions of higher education between 1991 and 1992 occurred in 2-year institutions (71,000 of 132,000). However, during the 10-year period covered by this report, the proportion of total enrollment accounted for by 2-year institutions—approximately 39 percent—changed very little (derived from table 2).
- Women accounted for 55 percent of total enrollment in 1992 and for 82 percent of the increase in total enrollments between 1991 and 1992 (derived from table 3).
- Undergraduate enrollment in higher education increased 15 percent between 1982 and 1992, and 1 percent between 1991 and 1992. From 1991 to 1992, enrollment at the undergraduate level by white, non-Hispanics declined, while it increased for blacks, Hispanics, Asians or Pacific Islanders, American Indians or Alaskan Natives, and nonresident aliens (derived from table 4).
- Graduate enrollment increased by 35 percent between 1982 and 1992 and by approximately 1.9 percent between 1991 and 1992. Between 1991 and 1992, graduate enrollment by minorities and nonresident aliens increased by approximately 5.4 percent and enrollment by white, non-Hispanics increased by less than 1 percent (derived from table 4).
- First-professional enrollment has not changed dramatically over time. The number enrolled in 1992—281,000—approximates the 1991 level, the largest since 1982 when enrollment was at 278,000. The continued decline in enrollment by white, non-Hispanic first-professional students (from 246,000 to 221,000 between 1982 and 1992) has been offset primarily by increased enrollment by blacks, Hispanics, Asian or Pacific Islanders, and nonresident aliens (derived from table 4).

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Introduction

This E.D. TABS presents findings from two institutional-based postsecondary education fall enrollment surveys conducted by the National Center for Education Statistics: the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS), and the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) surveys which replaced HEGIS in 1986. HEGIS contains biennial enrollment data by racial/ethnic category from 1976 to 1984. Since 1990, the race/ethnicity data have been reported annually, reflecting a change in the reporting cycle. The IPEDS data reported here pertain only to institutions accredited at the higher education level.

Seventeen tables included in this report summarize the fall enrollment information. The data presented are limited to approximately 3,600 postsecondary institutions accredited at the higher education level in the 50 states and the District of Columbia. Tables 1 through 4a show enrollment trends for institutions of higher education by racial/ethnic categories and by selected student and institutional characteristics. Tables 5a, 5b, and 5c include final fall enrollment in institutions of higher education, by state and by racial/ethnic category for 1990, 1991, and 1992. Tables 6 through 8 show the number of higher education institutions in the 50 states and the District of Columbia for 1992, the response rates to the IPEDS fall enrollment survey, and the impact of imputation on the data.

Technical Notes

Data Sources

In this E.D. Tabs, the enrollment statistics for racial/ethnic categories are derived from two data sources. The information for 1982 through 1984 comes from data reported biennially by institutions of higher education in the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS), "Fall Enrollment and Compliance Report of Institutions of Higher Education." The data for 1986 through 1992 are from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) "Fall Enrollment" survey. The IPEDS data were reported biennially between 1986 and 1990, and annually since 1990.

Note that data reported here for 1990 and 1991 differ somewhat from those reported in other sources. Modifications have been made to the 1990 and 1991 data with the addition of late arriving data as well as corrections and updates forwarded by institutions.

Data for this E.D. TABS are exclusively from higher education institutions in the 50 States and the District of Columbia. Data from noncollegiate institutions (which were sampled) are not included.

*Imputations*²

Although the HEGIS and IPEDS data reported here are historically comparable in terms of the reporting institutions (i.e., those accredited at the college level by agencies recognized by the Secretary, U.S. Department of Education), there are some differences in the imputation procedures used in the two surveys.

In the case of totally nonresponding institutions (i.e., those that did not return an enrollment survey form), HEGIS data were imputed whenever possible by using previously reported information. In a few cases, imputations could not be performed; thus, enrollment by racial/ethnic category was slightly less than the total enrollment reported by the institutions. However, this was not a major problem because totals by racial/ethnic category were always within 0.3 percent of the actual totals. In IPEDS, a procedure similar to that used for the prior HEGIS surveys was followed, except that "hot-deck" imputations (computer matching with a similar institution of higher education) were performed when previously reported data were unavailable.

² In the fall of 1992, the response rate was 94.3 percent for institutions of higher education, while in the fall of 1991 the rate was 90.9 percent (table 7). For 1992, imputed enrollment data (for nonresponding institutions and those with incomplete data) accounted for .7 percent of the data for 4-year public institutions, and 4.9 percent for 2-year public institutions. The proportion of imputed data in 4-year private institutions was 2.9 percent and in 2-year private institutions it was 8.5 percent. For a discussion regarding imputations, see the cautionary notes at the end of these notes.

For responding institutions with incomplete or missing data for racial/ethnic categories, the imputation procedures were as follows:

- The difference between the sum of the data across the racial/ethnic categories and the reported totals was redistributed in proportion to the institution's reported racial/ethnic enrollment.
- For IPEDS institutions that did not report students by racial/ethnic categories, data were imputed by using the same proportions reported for each racial/ethnic category at the state level for a given type and control of institution. Prior to 1986 (i.e., HEGIS survey years), data were imputed only for institutional totals and not across racial/ethnic categories.
- Data reported in the "race/ethnicity unknown" category were distributed back in proportion to the reported data in the manner described above; however, "race/ethnicity unknown" data were not distributed to the "nonresident alien" category.

Race/Ethnicity Unknown

Beginning in 1990, the category "race/ethnicity unknown" was incorporated into the fall enrollment survey. To allow for analysis of enrollment trends by race/ethnicity, the race/ethnicity unknown data were distributed across all racial/ethnic categories in proportion to the reported data (see description of distribution process under the imputation procedures discussed above). As a result of the distribution process, enrollment counts increased proportionately for all racial/ethnic categories.

Cautionary Notes

Table 4 contains data by level of study (undergraduate, graduate, and first-professional), which may differ from data in other NCES publications. Specifically, HEGIS data, which appear in publications prior to 1986, contained information on unclassified students by level (only undergraduate and graduate student categories).

The reader should be cautious when interpreting data by type and control of institution because data for 2-year public and private institutions were imputed at a higher rate than data for 4-year institutions. Data for these institutions were totally imputed in some states, although few institutions may exist in these states (see table 6 for number of HEGIS institutions in each state by level and control). The larger percentage of imputed data affects the quality of the data in the 2-year sector at the national level. The reader should refer to table 8 which reports the percentage of enrollment that was imputed, by type and by control of institution for each state.

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
