ABSTRACT

Every year the Maryland State Department of Education summarizes the enrollment and staff counts for nonpublic schools in the State using data from surveys sent to nonpublic schools in August. In 1996, the survey achieved a response rate of 94.5%. In 1996, 1,105 nonpublic schools, of which 166 were Catholic, enrolled students in Maryland. Of the state's 165,690 nonpublic school students, most (116,705) were in the elementary grades. There were 48,985 students in nonpublic secondary schools, and 5,976 graduates of nonpublic high schools. Catholic schools enrolled 59,534 students and graduated 3,171 from high school. ## Introduction

Annually, the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) summarizes the enrollment and staff counts for nonpublic schools of Maryland. This collection is authorized under Section 2-205, (o) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland which states:

“REPORTS FROM PRIVATE SCHOOLS - with the advice of the State Superintendent, the State Board shall require each private educational association, corporation, and institution to report annually, on or before August 31, it's enrollment and courses of study on the forms that the Board provides.”

In August of each year, enrollment surveys are sent to each nonpublic school registered with the State of Maryland. This list of schools includes both accredited and church exempt entities. To assure a strong response, follow up activities for nonpublic schools not responding include repeat mailings and telephone calls to the school. The data reported in this release are a summary of the data reported to MSDE. In 1996, this survey process achieved a response rate of 94.5 percent.

## Definitions

The following definitions are for the number of schools tables:

- Elementary - A school organization with the primary purpose of educating students in grades prekindergarten through 8.
- Middle - A school organization with the primary purpose of educating students in grades 6 through 8.
- High - A school organization with the primary purpose of educating students in grades 9 through 12.
- Combined - A school organization with the primary purpose of educating students in grades which have some overlapping combination of elementary, middle and high schools.
