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ABSTRACT

The report presents data on the rate of Oklahoma high school graduates going on to colleges within the state. Two kinds of rates are reported: (1) for students proceeding directly to college after high school graduation (linear), and (2) for students who have delayed college entry for a year or more after graduation. Tables present data on: percentage rates for these groups, by county, for each of the years 1994, 1995, and 1996, and as a three-year average; three-year average rates (numbers and percentages) of college attendance for both groups (linear and combined) for each county and each high school; and annual rates for both groups for each county and high school. ## HIGH SCHOOL TO COLLEGE-GOING RATES: FOR OKLAHOMA HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES TO OKLAHOMA COLLEGES

As part of the State Regents' cooperative effort with the State Department of Education to provide measures or "indicators" of educational performance, the High School Indicators Project has produced the "High School to College-Going Rates of Oklahoma High School Graduates" report.

The data used to construct this report comes from two sources, the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. Data derived from the State Department is aggregate data reported to the Department by individual high schools each year. The data is aggregate in that it is total numbers of graduates and does not contain information on individuals. The State Regents' data is created from the Unitized Data System (UDS). The UDS is a data collection system whereby institutions collect a number of distinct "units" of data for each individual student each and every semester. These units of data are then "aggregated" into numbers by computer programs designed to create the information reports needed from the larger database. The data sources, then, cannot be merged in a true sense. Therefore, in order to obtain the needed college-going rates, like-type populations were created and compared because tracking "individuals" from high school into college was not possible.

The counts from the current annual report and reports of the previous two years have been averaged to provide a three-year average Oklahoma college-going rate. This average provides an opportunity to consider a trend in addition to single-year activity by high school site. The following single-year reports are also provided for each of the three years used to construct the average college-going rates: (1) the college-going rate for 1993-94 high school graduates going to college in 1994-95, (2) the college-going rate for 1994-95 high school graduates going to college in 1995-96, and (3) the college-going rate for the 1995-96 high school graduates going to an Oklahoma college in 1996-97.

There are two kinds of rates shown on these reports. The first rate is the Linear College-Going Rate. This rate measures the movement of Oklahoma high school graduates who go directly to an Oklahoma college the following year. This is the way most people think of a "college-going rate," but in actuality it is seldom used because in most states the detailed information needed to ascertain such a rate is not available. The second measure of movement is that of the Combined College-Going Rate. This method of examining the flow of high school graduates into higher education combines those students who are attending directly out of high school with those students who have delayed entry for one year or more.

The average Linear College-Going Rate for Oklahoma colleges in 1996-97 was 54.8 percent of the Oklahoma high school graduates from 1993-94, 1994-95, and 1995-96. Six of the seventy-seven Oklahoma counties had an average college-going rate greater than sixty percent. As shown in Table 1, those six counties in ascending order were: Alfalfa with 70.2 percent, Harper with 66.1

percent, Kingfisher with 65.1 percent, Grant with 64.4 percent, Canadian with 63.0 percent, and Woods with 61.4 percent.

The Linear College-Going Rate for Oklahoma colleges in 1996-97 was 51.6 percent of the high school graduates from 1995-96. For this single year snapshot which is also shown in Table 1, only four of the 77 counties had a college-going rate higher than 60 percent. These four counties were: Alfalfa with 71.7 percent, Harper with 69.0 percent, Woods with 62.1 percent, and Kingfisher with 61.2 percent.

The average Combined Rate for Oklahoma was 92.9 percent of the high school graduates from 1993-94, 1994-95, and 1995-96. A county comparison shown on Table 2 reveals six counties with 85 percent or greater college-going rate. Canadian county has the highest three-year average combined rate with 93.8 percent followed by Muskogee county which had a rate of 92.8 percent. To round off the top six counties, Alfalfa had 92.4 percent; Blaine had 89.9 percent; Kingfisher had 88.6 percent; and Oklahoma had 85.7 percent.

The Combined Rate for Oklahoma was 80.4 percent of the high school graduates from 1995-96. For the single year 1995-96, none of the 77 counties had a rate higher than 85 percent. Six counties did have a rate of 75 or greater. Those counties were: Blaine, 84.1 percent; Grant, 79.5 percent; Alfalfa, 78.9 percent; Kingfisher, 78.3 percent; Marshall, 76.3 percent; and Major, 76.0 percent.

It should also be kept in mind that the data displayed in this report is not complete in several respects. First, there are several private high schools and home schooled students in Oklahoma not reported on the State Department of Education database. Second, there are several private colleges and universities that did not participate in State Regents' Unitized Data System. Third, the coding of first-time freshmen depends entirely on institutional input. If a higher education institution mis-codes an ACT high school code or improperly codes the student's level or status, data will be lost to the report.

The report, of course, does not track students out-of-state, nor does it take into account those students who received GEDs or dropped out of high school prior to graduation but went on to college as an adult or through admission to an "open-door" institution for which high school graduation is not required.

For the present, this report is as complete as can be constructed. Keep in mind, however, that small errors or omissions in data for small high schools can result in large percentage differences. This report should be used as an "indicator" report not as proof or evidence.
