ABSTRACT

This statistical report offers statewide and college-by-college data on enrollment at Mississippi's 15 public community and junior colleges, focusing primarily on data for fall 1997. The following nine tables are provided: (1) a statewide enrollment summary for fall 1997; (2) a comparison of fall 1996 and fall 1997 enrollment for academic, technical, vocational, and non-credit courses; (3) full- and part-time credit headcount enrollment in academic, technical, and vocational curricula by college and campus for fall 1997; (4) full- and part-time credit and non-credit headcount enrollment by college for fall 1997; (5) non-credit headcount enrollment by program (e.g., adult basic education, general equivalent diploma, high school vocational, industrial training, Job Training Partnership Act, and literacy) by college for fall 1997; (6) credit headcount enrollment by race and resident alien status by college for fall 1997; (7) change in enrollment by college between 1996 and 1997; (8) total fall 1997 enrollment by Mississippi county; (9) credit enrollment numbers and percentages by age by college for fall 1997; and (10) composite scores on American College Testing placement tests by college for fall 1997. 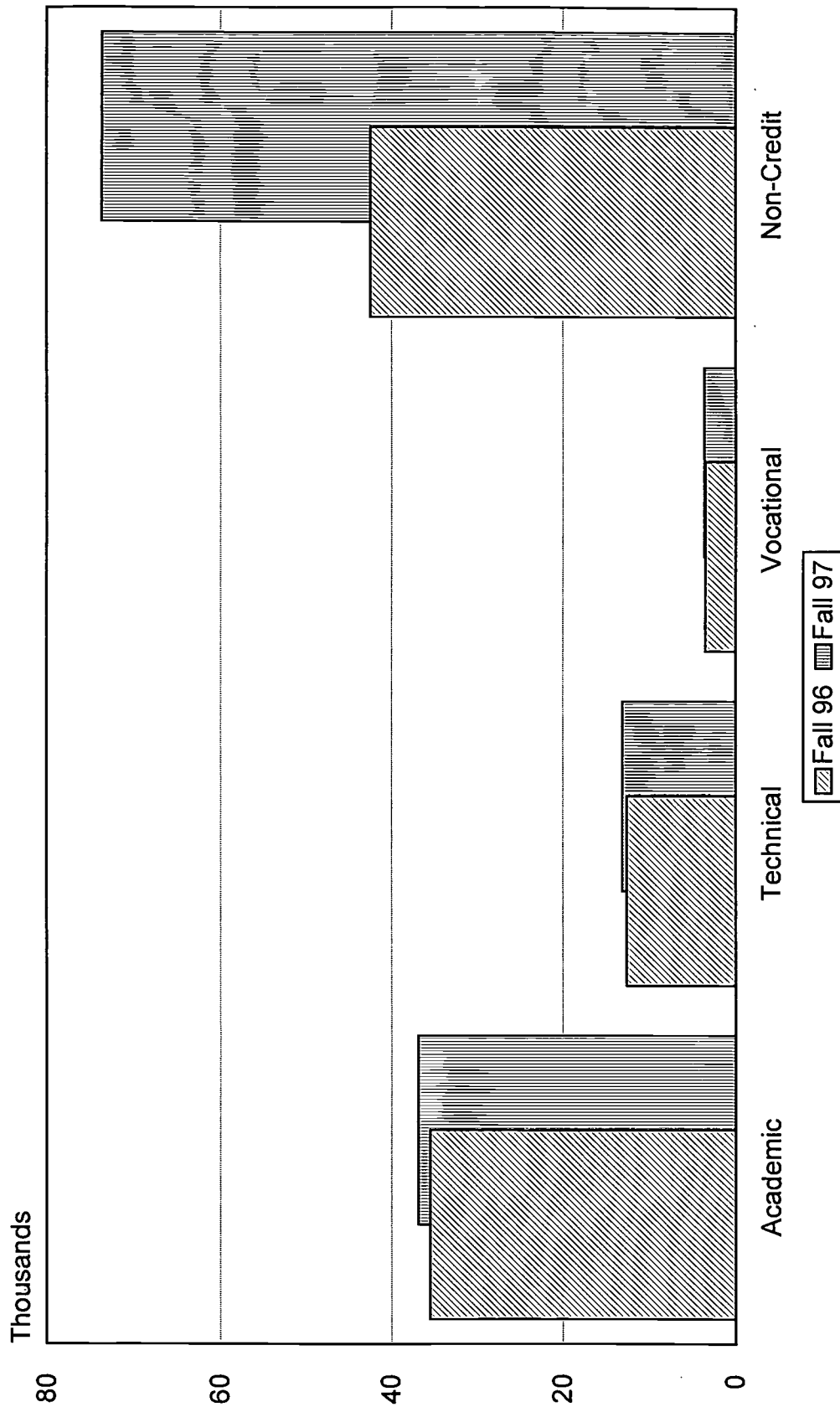
For the first time in the history of Mississippi public community & junior college system, total headcount enrollment exceeded the 100, 000 mark for a record enrollment of 127,019.

- Total headcount enrollment increased by 31,729 over Fall 1996, 33.8% • Female Students Accounted for 59.4% of all Credit Enrollment
- Total credit enrollment increased by 1,965 over Fall 1996, 3.8% • Freshman students accounted for 59.6% of all credit enrollment
- Total noncredit enrollment increased by 29,774 over Fall 1996, 70.2% • MS Students accounted for 96.9% of all credit enrollment
- Noncredit enrollment accounted for 93.8% of the total headcount enrollment increase • In-district students accounted for 85.9% of all credit enrollment
- Full-Time Academic Enrollment was up by 901, 4.0% • Minority students accounted for 32 % of all credit enrollment
- Full-Time Technical Enrollment was up by 703, 7.3% • The average age of students enrolled for credit was 25
- Full-Time Vocational Enrollment was up by 35, 1.1% • Of all students enrolled for credit, 33% was over the age of 24
- Part-Time Academic Enrollment was up by 348, 2.7% • The average ACT score of students enrolled for credit was 18
- Part-Time Technical Enrollment was down by -1, Unchanged • Of all students enrolled for credit, 30% had a composite ACT score less than 16 and 77% scored less than 21
- Part-Time Vocational Enrollment was down by -31, -9.8% • Six thousand eighty-two (6,082) students enrolled for credit were admitted on the basis of a GED
- Academic Students accounted for 68.9% of all Credit Enrollment
