ABSTRACT

This report provides 17 tables which summarize total associate, baccalaureate, master's, specialist's, doctoral, and first-professional degrees, and other formal awarded conferred between July 1, 1995 and June 30, 1996 by Kentucky institutions of higher education. These institutions include state-supported universities and community colleges, independent four-year and two-year colleges and universities, and theological seminaries. Of the 26,061 degrees awarded, 21,484 degrees were awarded by state-supported institutions, 17,776 at the eight universities and 3,708 at the 14 community colleges. Independent four-year and two-year institutions granted 4,345 degrees. Theological seminaries awarded 648 degrees. Overall, more degrees (first and second majors) were generated in education, business management and administrative services, and health professions and related sciences than other degree program areas. At the baccalaureate level, 16 percent of the majors were in business and 15 percent in education. Forty-five percent of the master's and specialist's majors were in education. Education led the doctoral degree programs (24 percent) followed by biological sciences (12 percent). At the associate degree level, health sciences (35 percent) and liberal arts and sciences (32 percent) were the most popular degree programs. Almost half (49 percent) of the first professional degrees were in law followed by medicine (28 percent). (DB)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report is a summary of total associate, baccalaureate, master's, specialist's, doctoral, and first-professional degrees, and other formal awards conferred between July 1, 1995 and June 30, 1996 by Kentucky institutions of higher education. These institutions include state-supported universities and community colleges, independent four-year and two-year colleges and universities, and theological seminaries. Other independent institutions licensed by the Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education and submitting data to the Council are also included.

Please note some changes in this report from previous publications. The number of second majors completed by students earning a degree at a Kentucky state-supported institution is included in all reports of degrees awarded by degree field (Reports 3, 4, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13) for these institutions. Second major information is not available for independent institutions and theological seminaries (Reports 3, 5, 6, 8, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17). The summary of degrees reports (1 and 2) continue to reflect only the number of degrees awarded.

A total of 26,061 degrees and awards were granted during this reporting period. Of the 21,484 awarded by state-supported institutions, 17,776 were earned at the eight universities and 3,708 at the 14 community colleges. Independent four-year and two-year institutions granted 4,345 degrees; 4,139 by the 20 senior institutions and 206 by the two junior colleges. Other independent institutions awarded 232 degrees. Details of these degrees by level and institution may be found in Reports 1 and 2.

The four theological seminaries awarded a total of 648 degrees; Report 17 provides details by institution and degree.

Overall, more degrees (first and second majors) were generated in education, business management and administrative services, and health professions and related sciences than other degree program areas. At the baccalaureate level, 16 percent of the majors were in business and 15 percent in education. Forty-five percent of the master's and specialist's majors were in education, 10 percent in public administration, and 9 percent in business. Education led the doctoral degree programs (24 percent) followed by biological sciences (12 percent). At the associate degree level, health sciences (35 percent) and liberal arts and sciences (32 percent) were the most popular degree programs. Almost half (49 percent) of the first-professional degrees were in law; medicine generated an additional 28 percent, followed by dentistry with 14 percent and pharmacy with the remaining 10 percent. Reports 3 through 16 provide data by specific degree program.

Data in this report were summarized by Council on Postsecondary Education staff from the U. S. Department of Education's IPEDS Survey, Postsecondary Completions, July 1, 1995 - June 30, 1996 and from the CPE data base. DEFINITIONS

The following definitions are those officially established for the reporting of degrees conferred data to the Kentucky Council on Higher Education:

Associate Degree

Degree below the baccalaureate level requiring at least two, but fewer than four, academic years of postsecondary education work.

Bachelor's Degree

Degree generally requiring four to five academic years of college work.

Degree Field

Student's major program of study.

Doctoral Degree

The highest academic degree in a specified discipline.

First Major

For a student who has declared intent to earn a degree with more than one program of study (double major), the area of primary interest.

First-Professional Degree

Degree requiring at least two years of college work prior to entrance to the program (specific degree programs are dentistry, medicine, pharm-d, law, and theology).

Master's Degree

Degree customarily granted on successful completion of one or two academic years of work beyond the Bachelor's level.

Other Formal Awards

Certificate or diploma offered by postsecondary education institutions designed for completion in programs less than one year, at least one but less than two years, or two but less than four academic years.

Second Major

For a student who has declared intent to earn a degree with more than one program of study (double major), the area of secondary interest.

Specialist's Degree

Degree in specific disciplines requiring work beyond the master's degree.
