ABSTRACT

The tables in this report on professional salaries were prepared using data submitted by Maryland's 24 public school systems in the fall of 1997. Salaries include annual pay for 10-, 11-, and 12-month employees in positions listed. All data reflect the conversion of part-time employees to a full-time equivalent. The position types used in the report are based on definitions included in the Instructional for the Annual Staff Reporting, Maryland Public Schools, April 1997. Directors, coordinators, and supervisors include persons in charge of instructional and noninstructional services within the school system. A figure provides data on amount above/below statewide average teacher salary. Three tables provide data on salaries of professional staff employed in Maryland public schools, teachers' salaries indexed to region, and average salaries for selected positions and 10-year percent change. Highlights of the report include: (1) the average salary for principals increased about 3 percent from 1996-1997 to 1997-1998; (2) compared to the 1996-1997 results, the mean on statewide teacher's salary is slightly higher in 1997-1998; (3) the average teacher salary increased in four geographical regions of Maryland (western, southern, lower shore, and upper shore); and (4) pupil personnel/school social workers showed the biggest gain in average salary. Introduction

The tables in this report were prepared from the data submitted by the 24 Maryland public school systems in the fall of 1997. Salaries include annual pay for 10, 11, and 12 month full-time and part-time employees in the positions shown. All data reported reflect the conversion of part-time employees to a full-time equivalent.

Calculations

The average (mean) is computed by dividing the sum of the individual salaries by the sum of the full-time-equivalent positions. The value of the mean can be distorted by extremely high or low salaries in the distribution and may not provide an accurate estimate of the population average. Therefore, the median (middle value) is also provided as another estimate of "average." The median represents the salary which divides the group in half. The first and third quartiles are provided as an estimation of the distribution of salaries across groups. Quartiles represent a division point similar to the median. The first quartile indicates the salary below which twenty-five percent of salaries fall while the third quartile represents the point above which twenty-five percent of salaries fall. Inspection of Table 1, page 8, reveals that twenty-five percent of teachers in Maryland are paid \$30,488 or less while twenty-five percent make \$48,970 or more.

Highlights

- ◆ The average salary for principals in Maryland public schools increased about 3% from \$69,974 in 1996-97 to \$72,057 in 1997-98.
- ◆ Compared to the result (\$41,257) from the 1996-97 school year, the mean on statewide teacher's salary is slightly higher in 1997-98 (\$41,404) which is about a 0.4% increase.
- ◆ The teacher average salary increased in four geographical regions of the state, including western Maryland, southern Maryland, lower shore and upper shore. The increase ranges from \$394 to \$836.
- ◆ Pupil personnel/school social workers showed the biggest gain in the average salary, increasing from \$50,874 to \$56,155 between 1996-97 and 1997-98.

Position Classifications

The position types used in this report are based on definitions included in the *Instructions for the Annual Staff Reporting, Maryland Public Schools, April 1997*. Directors, coordinators, and supervisors include persons in charge of instructional and noninstructional services within the school system.

Maryland Public Schools: October 1997**


