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ABSTRACT

This report provides information on degree and certificate programs offered and student program completions for the 1997-98 fiscal year in North Dakota's 19 public and private postsecondary educational institutions. Introductory material includes an explanation of the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP Code) system, criteria for program completion, a list of the members of the North Dakota State Board of Higher Education, basic information on each institution (address, chief administrator, and type), a chart of degree levels offered by institution, a fee schedule for North Dakota State University (tuition, fees, room and board), and a list of broad CIP program areas and corresponding CIP code. A table summarizes all programs offered, by CIP code by institution and by level of offering. A second table lists, by institution and by CIP code, the number of students completing programs. Separate breakdowns are provided for 1-year and 2-year programs, for bachelor's degree programs, and for master's degree and doctoral programs. Another table lists total numbers of North Dakota program completions by field of study for 1987-88, 1996-97, and 1997-98. (DB)

INTRODUCTION

- (4) Students at NDSU passed a Health/Wellness initiative in April. With this initiative the BHE has approved a \$38 increase, effective the second semester. Fees for first semester are \$165, and will increase to \$203 second semester.
