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ABSTRACT

This report examines the status of general enrollment fee (GEF) waivers and nonresident tuition (NRT) waivers at Oklahoma state institutions of higher education for 1996-97. First, an overview section summarizes the purpose of the waivers, which is to provide assistance to Oklahoma residents with demonstrated financial need and to attract specific out-of-state students. The overview also reviews the state statute authorizing the program, its history, its benefits and points of emphasis, and restrictions. Among highlights of data presented for 1996-97 are: over 36,500 students received GEF and NRT waivers worth about \$39 million, which was equivalent to about 17.7 percent of total student fee revenue; freshmen and sophomore students received the greatest amounts of GEF waivers; minority students received 22.5 percent of GEF waivers; graduate students accounted for 29.8 percent of NRT waiver recipients, compared to only 15.2 percent of GEF waiver recipients; and 18 percent of NRT waivers went to international students. Tables present both summary data and data for each of the 32 Oklahoma institutions for both GEF and NRT waivers, with information on recipients' classifications, gender, race, residency, field of study, academic level, and semester. A comparison of the amount of GEF waivers compared to maximum amount authorized for each institution is also provided.

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General Enrollment Fee Waivers and Nonresident Tuition Waivers

An Overview

Purpose:

General Enrollment Fee (GEF) Waivers are scholarships to cover the resident tuition charge. They are intended to provide assistance to Oklahoma students with demonstrated financial need and to promote scholarship throughout all academic and professional fields of study as outlined in State Regents' Policy II-4-44. Further, the scholarships are intended to be equitably available to students at all academic levels.

Nonresident Tuition (NRT) Waivers apply to all or part of the additional tuition charged to nonresidents above the resident tuition (general enrollment fee). They allow institutions the discretion to attract out-of-state students who contribute to the vitality and academic climate of the institution.

Authorization:

General Enrollment Fee Waivers: State statute, Title 70, Section 3218.12, authorizes the State Regents to establish a system of fee waiver scholarships. Title 70, Section 2281 specifically authorizes fee waivers for former POW's or MIA's and their dependents, while Title 70, Section 3218.7 authorizes fee waiver scholarships for the children of police or firefighters killed in the line of duty. State Regents' policy sets further guidelines for the use of general enrollment fee waivers. Regents' policy also establishes several additional categories of eligibility for fee waivers, including senior citizens (for auditing of courses), institutional staff, and graduate assistants.

Nonresident Tuition Waivers: State statute, Title 70, Section 3226, also authorizes any institution to award nonresident tuition waivers as part of a scholarship.

History:

General Enrollment Fee Waivers: The current general enrollment fee waiver scholarship system (resident) has its roots in legislation adopted in 1947, which authorized a "system of student scholarships" for Oklahoma institutions. In 1953, the State Regents implemented a scholarship program limited to an amount equivalent to 0.5% of each institution's educational and general budget. The limit was increased to 1% in 1976 and to 1.5% in 1982. As consecutive tuition increases were authorized in the late 1980's, the State Regents broadened the limitation to 2% in 1986 and 3% in 1989 to allow institutions more resources to meet the financial needs of students.

In 1977, the Legislature adopted specific "fee waiver" language in relation to the scholarship system. In 1988, this section of law was amended to include students participating in the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Scholars Program.

In addition, other specific categories of general enrollment fee waivers, namely those for POW/MIA's and their dependents (1973) and dependents of police or firefighters killed in the line of duty (1988 & 1989) were authorized by the Legislature.

The State Regents adopted a provision in April 1994 that would allow institutions to award a general fee waiver scholarship to students who qualify for the Regional University Scholarships. Students who are eligible for the Regional University Scholarship must be Oklahoma residents and meet criteria established in State Regents Policy II-4-72. This is the second year that recipients of this scholarship are included in the fee waiver report. An additional 2200 awards were granted in the FY97 than in FY96.

Also included in this report is the National Guard Scholarship fee waiver. The State Regents approved guidelines for this scholarship in June 1995, which provided that fee waivers awarded under the National Guard eligibility be excluded from the provisions of financial need, distribution across fields of study and academic level, and excluded from the three percent limitation.

In May 1996, a comprehensive revision of the State Regents' policy governing fee waivers was adopted. The revision provided that any portion of a student's tuition not covered by the Academic Scholar cash award or the Regional University Baccalaureate Scholarship could be waived. Also, language was adopted that clearly identified that the fee waivers mandated by statute or State Regents' policy would not be subject to the three percent limitation.

Nonresident Tuition Waivers: The State Regents adopted a provision in March 1985 that authorized institutions to award a limited number of nonresident tuition waivers to graduate and professional students to assist the awarding institution on the achievement of social justice purposes. A statutory provision extended nonresident tuition waivers throughout the State System in 1987. The current State Regents' policy provides authorization to any institution to award a scholarship that includes a nonresident tuition waiver.

Nature of the Scholarship: The scholarship is not a grant, as the student does not receive a check for the award. Rather, the scholarship is essentially an accounting entry on the student's bill of charges waiving all or part of the amount due for general enrollment fees or nonresident tuition.

General Enrollment Fee Waivers cover only the course enrollment fee; they do not cover other mandatory special fees, such as activity fees, facility fees, health fees, and special course fees.

Nonresident Tuition Waivers cover only the course enrollment cost in excess of the resident rate. An out-of-state student who receives a nonresident tuition waiver must still pay the same general enrollment fees and special fees that Oklahoma residents pay (the only authorized exceptions to this policy are graduate assistants, students in the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Scholars program, and children of police or firefighters killed in the line of duty).

Benefits / Points of Emphasis:

General Enrollment Fee Waivers:

- GEF waivers are a substantial source of financial aid to Oklahoma students. In FY97, over \$20 million, including National Guard waivers, was awarded to Oklahoma students, of which 46% (\$9.6 million) was awarded on the basis of financial need.
- GEF waivers are especially important to institutions that have limited privately funded scholarships for students.
- The ability to use GEF waivers for graduate assistants employed at least one-quarter time, both residents and nonresidents, is a cost-effective means of compensation. Without the waivers, institutions would have to pay graduate assistants higher wages, and the corresponding payroll taxes, in order for graduate assistants to pay their general enrollment fees.

Nonresident Tuition Waivers:

- NRT waivers provide Oklahoma institutions the ability to attract out-of-state students, especially graduate students, with special academic abilities and talents who contribute to the vitality and diversity of the state's campuses.
- Oklahoma institutions located near the state's borders are especially sensitive to serving geographic areas where the population, tax dollars, property ownership, etc. cross state borders with great frequency. NRT waivers allow institutions to serve the area to the benefit of the institution and its students and without detriment to Oklahoma residents.
- It is unlikely that the elimination of NRT waivers would mean an equivalent increase in tuition dollars paid to state institutions. A nonresident student, in many cases, might simply choose not to attend an Oklahoma institution without the benefit of the waiver.

Restrictions:

General Enrollment Fee Waivers: State Regents' policy sets the following guidelines on the use of general enrollment fee waivers.

- GEF waivers may be awarded only to Oklahoma residents, with the following exceptions: (1) State Regents' Academic Scholars, (2) graduate assistants employed at least one-quarter time, and (3) deceased police/firefighter dependents.
- GEF waivers given by an institution may not exceed 3% of the institution's E&G I budget. The various classes of statutorily or policy mandated recipients are exempt from this limit.
- At least 50% of the institution's discretionary GEF waivers must be awarded on the basis of financial need.

Nonresident Tuition Waivers: State statutes provide that "any institution in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education may award a scholarship that includes a waiver of nonresident tuition." State Regent's policy mirrors this language.

1996-97 Summary and Highlights

Overall Summary: In 1996-97, over 36,500 students in Oklahoma higher education institutions received general enrollment fee waivers and nonresident tuition waivers worth slightly more than \$39 million. This dollar amount was the equivalent of about 17.7% of the \$220 million in total student fee revenue.

General Enrollment Fee Waivers: General Enrollment Fee Waivers were granted to 28,145 students in amounts that totaled \$20.4 million.

- Freshman and sophomore students received the largest amounts of total GEF waivers, 27.5% and 24.4% respectively, compared to 13.9% for juniors, 18.5% for seniors, and 15.6% for graduate students and unclassified students combined.
- Female students accounted for 53.8% of the GEF waiver recipients.
- Minority students (Asian-Pacific Islander, Black, Hispanic, and Native American/Alaskan Native) made up 22.5% of the GEF waiver recipients.
- Fewer than 4% of the students receiving GEF waivers were nonresident students.
- The single largest field of study for GEF waiver recipients was the arts and sciences at 40%; business, education, technical and other programs, each accounted for between 10% and 14% of recipients, while agriculture, Human Sciences and engineering composed between one and six percent.
- System-wide, institutions awarded 59.1% of the maximum authorized amount. (3% of E&G 1 budget) Excluding the professional schools (OCOM-OSU, OSU Vet. Med., OU Law, and OU Health Sciences Center), which historically utilize fee waivers to a much lesser extent than other institutions, over 80% of the remaining institutions awarded at least 50% of the maximum authorization.

Nonresident Tuition Waivers: Approximately 8,800 students received \$18.7 million in Nonresident Tuition Waivers.

- Graduate students (masters and doctorate level) make up a much higher proportion of NRT waiver recipients – 29.8% compared to only 15.2% of GEF waiver recipients.
- Females accounted for only 44.4% of the NRT waiver recipients, compared to 53.8% of GEF waiver recipients.
- Almost 82% of the nonresident students receiving NRT waivers were from the United States; the remaining 18% were international students.
- Minority students (Asian-Pacific Islander, Black, Hispanic, and Native American/Alaskan Native) composed 39% of the NRT recipients.

- Arts and sciences majors made up 41.2% of the NRT waiver recipients.
- The largest portion of NRT waivers were granted for scholarship (72%) while graduate assistantships accounted for 22% of the waivers. Academic Scholars recipients composed the third largest group at 5%.
