ABSTRACT

This report presents 43 tables presenting detailed data on students attending the 13 institutions which comprise the University of Wisconsin System. Data are usually broken down by individual institution and often include data from the last 10 years for trend analysis. Data for undergraduate and graduate students are usually presented separately. Data tables are grouped into the following categories: (1) headcount enrollments, (2) full-time equivalent enrollments, (3) resident/nonresident status, (3) class and entrance status, (4) sex, (5) multicultural status and sex, (6) full-time status, geographic origin, (7) Wisconsin inter-institutional transfers, (8) credits carried, (9) degrees conferred, and (9) enrollment by age. 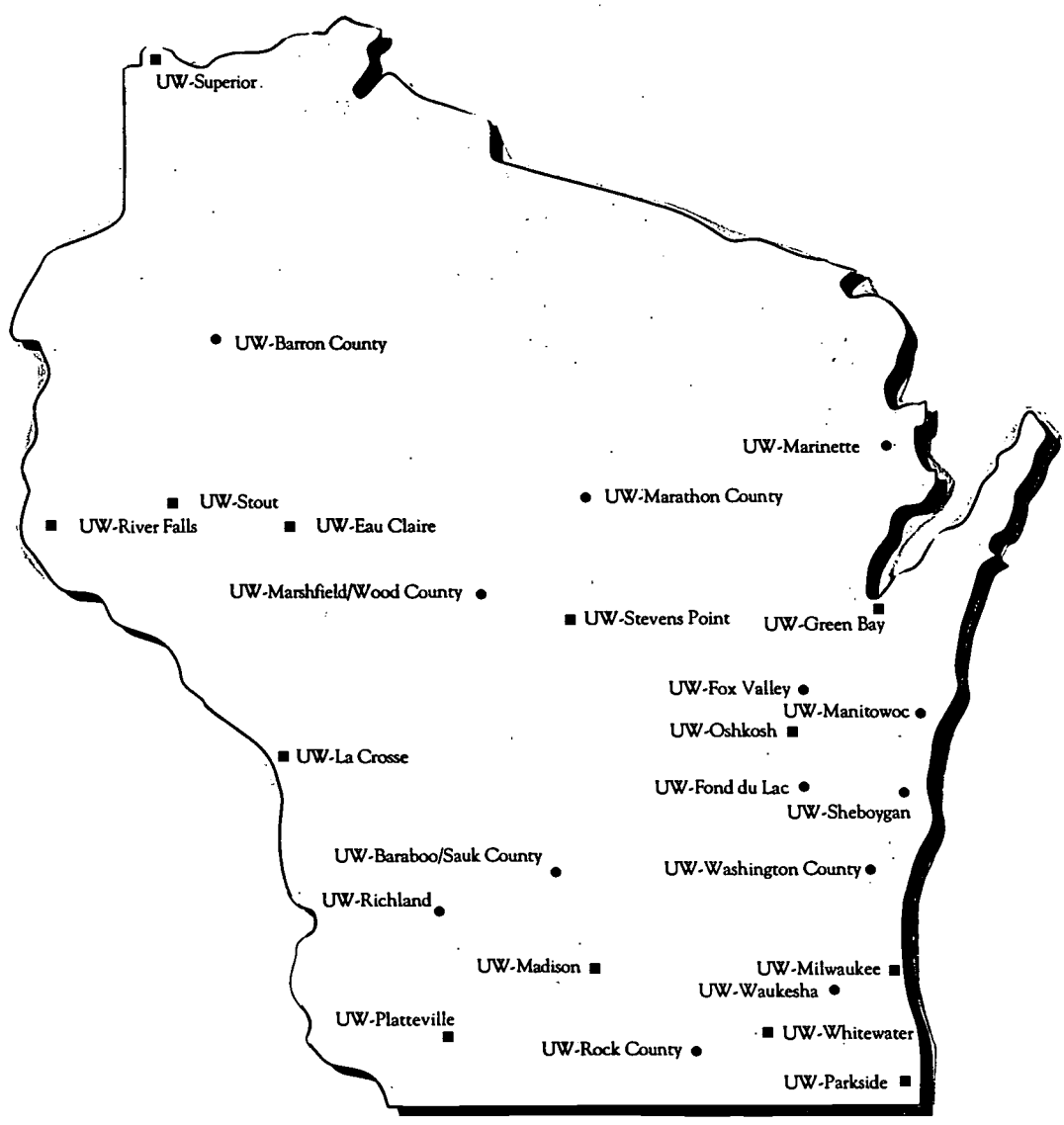
