#### ABSTRACT

Highlights of this summary of trends in enrollment within the University of Wisconsin (UW) system include: fall 1998 full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment (128,371) was up 2.4 percent from fall 1997; fall 1998 headcount enrollment (152,926) was up 1.6 percent from fall 1997; and the UW system achieved its fall 1998 FTE enrollment target. Seven tables provide historical profile data by individual institution from fall 1988 to fall 1999 on: (1) FTE enrollment; (2) headcount enrollment; (3) undergraduate FTE enrollment; (4) undergraduate headcount enrollment; (5) graduate/professional FTE enrollment; (6) graduate/professional headcount enrollment; and (7) percent deviation from FTE targets. The final table compares UW system actual and target enrollment by institution for fall 1998. (DB)



- Undergraduate headcount enrollment increased 2,872 from Fall 1997. This represents a 2.2% increase from Fall 1997 and is the highest headcount enrollment since 1992.

- Graduate/Professional FTE enrollment has continued to decline since Fall 1993 and remains lower than 1988's enrollment.
- In Fall 1998, graduate/professional FTE enrollment declined by 55, or 0.4%, from Fall 1997.
- The increase in UW-Madison's graduate/professional FTE enrollment and headcount enrollment (Table 6) is mainly due to UW-Madison's changes to its Pharmacy program offerings. These changes have shifted enrollments from undergraduate to graduate/professional programs.
