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ABSTRACT

The tables in this report were prepared from data submitted by the 24 Maryland public school systems in the fall of 1998. Salaries include annual pay for 10-, 11-, and 12-month full-time and part-time employees in the positions listed. All data reported reflect the conversion of part-time employees to full-time equivalents. The average (mean) salaries are computed by dividing the sum of the individuals' salaries by the sum of the full-time equivalent positions. The position types used in this report are based on definitions included in the Instructions for the Annual Staff Reporting, Maryland Public Schools, April 1997. Directors, coordinators, and supervisors include people in charge of instructional and noninstructional salaries. Some of the results show that: the average Maryland principal salary increased approximately 3.5 percent, from \$72,057 in 1997-98 to \$74,605 in 1998-99; the average Maryland teacher salary increased approximately 2.7 percent, from \$41,404 in 1997-98 to \$42,545 in 1998-99; the average salary for teachers increased in all six geographical regions of the state; and the highest average salary increases occurred for superintendents; associate, area, and assistant superintendents; and pupil personnel/school social workers. 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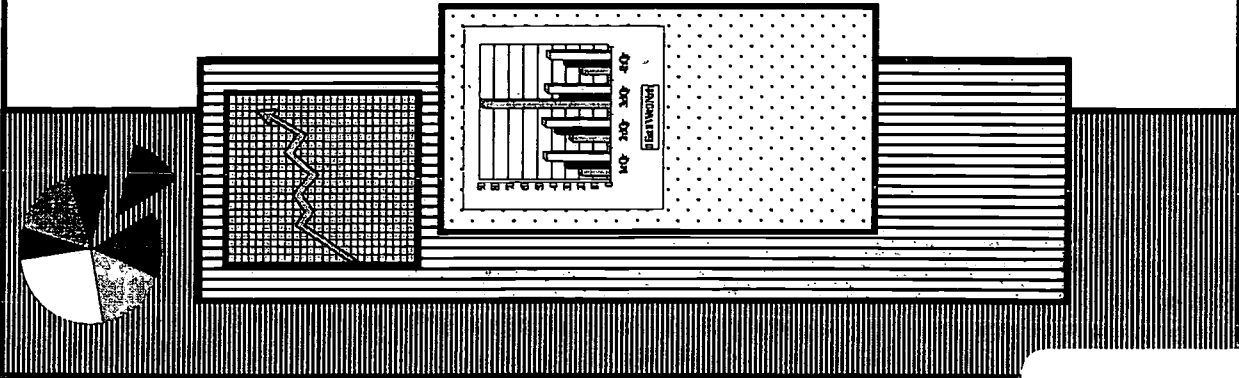

Introduction

The tables in this report were prepared from the data submitted by the 24 Maryland public school systems in the fall of 1998. Salaries include annual pay for 10, 11, and 12 month full-time and part-time employees in the positions shown. All data reported reflect the conversion of part-time employees to full-time equivalents.

Calculations

The average (mean) salaries are computed by dividing the sum of the individuals' salaries by the sum of the full-time-equivalent positions. The value of the means may be distorted by extremely high or low salaries in the distribution and so may not provide an accurate estimate of population averages. Therefore, medians (middle values) are also provided as estimates of typical salaries. The median represents the salary that divides the group in half. The first and third quartiles are provided as an estimation of the distribution of salaries across groups. Quartiles represent a division point similar to the median. The first quartile indicates the salary below which twenty-five percent of salaries fall while the third quartile represents the point above which twenty-five percent of salaries fall. Inspection of Table 1, page 8, reveals that twenty-five percent of teachers in Maryland are paid \$31,869 or less while twenty-five percent are paid \$50,866 or more.

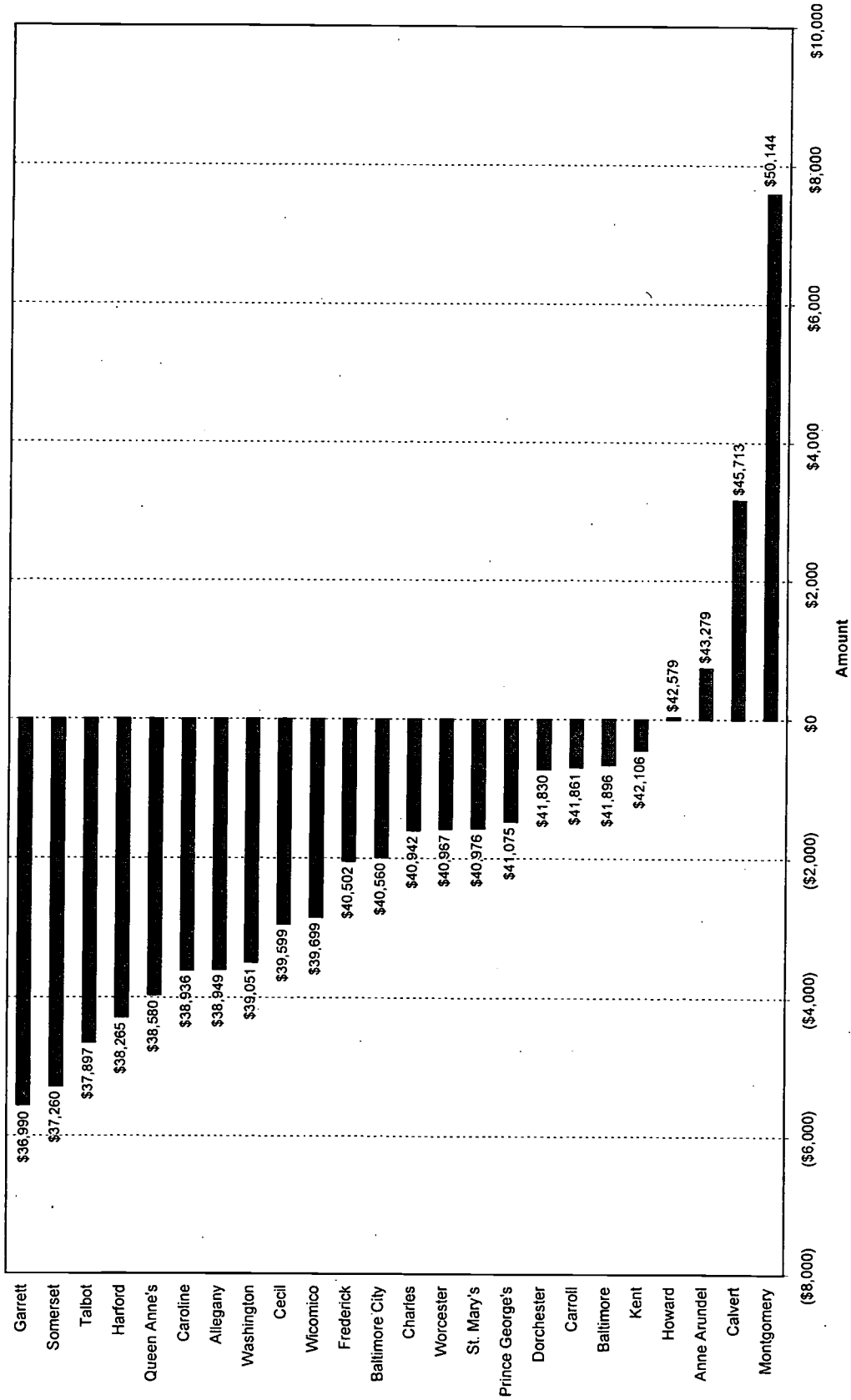
Position Classifications

The position types used in this report are based on definitions included in the *Instructions for the Annual Staff Reporting, Maryland Public Schools, April 1997*. Directors, coordinators, and supervisors include persons in charge of instructional and noninstructional services.

Prior Year Salary Comparisons

- ◆ The average salary for Maryland principals increased approximately 3.5% from \$72,057 in 1997-1998 to \$74,605 in 1998-1999.
- ◆ The average salary for Maryland teachers increased approximately 2.7% from \$41,404 in 1997-1998 to \$42,545 in 1998-1999.
- ◆ The average salary for teachers increased in all six geographical regions of the state: Baltimore Metropolitan, National Capital, Western Maryland, Southern Maryland, Lower Shore, and Upper Shore. The increase ranged from \$398 to \$2,663.
- ◆ The highest average salary increases occurred for superintendents (\$6,715), associate, area, and assistant superintendents (\$4,052), and pupil personnel/school social workers (\$3,993).
