



ABSTRACT

This document is a comprehensive, annotated series of resource lists designed to assist in selecting resources for the senior high English as a Second Language (ESL) program. This source book is divided into five levels. Level 1 is intended for students who are acquiring literacy for the first time or who have had significant gaps in previous schooling. Level 2 is intended for students who have little or no experience with English. Level 3 is intended for students who have some competency in English and need a program focused specifically on language development for academic learning. Level 4 is intended for students who are able to succeed in most high school courses with consistent support in English language development for academic learning. Level 5 students receive assistance with subject-specific language development in a variety of ways, such as in learning centers, from peer coaching, and with teacher assistance. A comprehensive listing of materials for each level is provided. Cited resources come in audiocassette, videocassette, and printed forms. 



AUTHORIZATION OF RESOURCES

Alberta Education selects, acquires, develops, produces, translates and authorizes the best possible instructional materials for the implementation of approved programs of study. Resources authorized by the Minister meet Alberta Education's criteria for acceptability, including:

- curriculum fit and instructional design
- tolerance and understanding
- developmental appropriateness
- physical properties
- cost
- Canadian content.

Resource Authorization Categories

Basic learning resources are those student learning resources authorized by Alberta Education as the most appropriate for addressing the majority of outcomes of the course(s) or substantial components of the course(s); or the most appropriate for meeting general outcomes across two or more grades, subject areas or programs as outlined in provincial programs of study. Basic learning resources may include any resource format, such as print, computer software, manipulatives or videocassette.

Authorized Teaching resources are those teaching resources produced externally to Alberta Education; e.g., by publishers, that have been reviewed by Alberta Education, found to meet the criteria of review, and identified as the best available resources to support the implementation of programs of study and courses and to support the attainment of the goals of education. Teaching resources produced as service documents by Alberta Education, such as diagnostic programs and monographs, are authorized by definition.

Support learning resources are those student learning resources authorized by Alberta Education to assist in addressing some of the outcomes of the course(s) or components of the course(s); or to assist in meeting the outcomes across two or more grade levels, subject areas or programs as outlined in the provincial programs of study.

Note:

Section 44(2)(a.1) of the School Act, Statutes of Alberta 1988, Chapter S-3.1, as amended, indicates that a school board may "...develop or acquire instructional materials for use in programs or in schools." Selection of instructional resources is not restricted to those authorized by Alberta Education.



SENIOR HIGH ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

Many students who come to Canada from other countries speak languages other than English and, upon entering Alberta schools, have varying levels of English language proficiency. These students are an important and integral part of our schools and communities. English as a Second Language (ESL) students are those students whose level of English language proficiency precludes them from full participation in the learning experiences provided in Alberta schools without additional support in English language development.

In order to benefit fully from schooling in Alberta, ESL students should have:

- enriched and supportive instructional programs that appropriately develop English language proficiency
- access to the full range of curriculum and services available to all students in Alberta schools.

The goal of the senior high English as a Second Language program is to provide ESL students with planned, systematic instruction and support that will enable them to speak the English language fluently, further their education, and become productive and contributing members of Albertan and Canadian society.

The senior high ESL program is organized into five levels. Level 1 is intended for students who are acquiring literacy for the first time or who have had significant gaps in previous schooling. Level 2 is intended for students who have little or no experience with English prior to entering Alberta schools. Level 3 is intended for students who have some competency in English and need a program focused specifically on language development for academic learning. Level 4 is intended for students who are able to succeed in most high school courses with consistent support in English language development for academic learning. Level 5 students receive assistance with subject-specific language development in a variety of ways, such as in learning centres, from peer coaching and with teacher assistance.

Throughout the five levels, students are expected to grow in their ability to demonstrate the following general outcomes.

Students will use spoken and written English to:

- gather, interpret and communicate information
- establish and maintain relationships
- · make decisions, solve problems, and plan and carry out projects
- explore, respond to and extend ideas and experiences.

The general outcomes represent different, but interrelated, dimensions for learning in the senior high ESL program. Although the general outcomes are stated separately, they are not mutually exclusive; but rather are meant to be developed in conjunction with one another. Specific outcomes state what students are expected to know and be able to do by the end of each level.
