

ABSTRACT

This report presents the findings of the 1999 survey of vocational graduates from Hawaii's Kapi'olani Community College (KCC). The purpose of this survey is to provide important information about our graduates, the type of employers hiring our graduates, and educational and transfer information useful for educational planning. A total of 140 vocational graduates were identified and contacted by telephone and completed the survey. The most important goals of the graduates were to obtain an Associates degree (46%) and to prepare for transfer (24%). Nineteen percent are working full-time while 34 percent are working part-time. The majority of respondents not employed were seeking work. Approximately 77 percent were working in jobs closely related to their major. About 20 percent of graduates have attended another university or college since graduation and 75 percent plan to continue their education. Contains 8 figures. The Office of Institutional Research and the Maida Kamber Center are pleased to present to the college community the sixth Annual Vocational Graduate Survey. The purpose of the survey is to provide important information about our graduates, the type of employers hiring our graduates and educational and transfer information useful for educational planning.

A total of 267 vocational education graduates were identified and 140 of them 52% completed the survey. The information was gathered over a two-month period in September and October 1999. The graduates were contacted by telephone. At least three attempts were made to contact each graduate. Data were analyzed for the entire college and for each program for which at least five responses were obtained. The major findings are summarized below.

The most important goals for the majority of the graduates have been to prepare for transfer 24% and to obtain AS degree 46%. KCC students continue to enjoy good employment status. Nineteen percent of those surveyed are working full-time while 34% are working part-time. The majority of those who are not working are seeking work. Approximately 77% of graduates are working in jobs closely related to their major. Of those who agreed to answer the question related to their approximate salary, 29% reported a salary between \$10,000 and \$20,000.

It is interesting to note that 60% of the students surveyed plan to complete a Bachelor's Degree while 10% of them plan to complete a Master's Degree. Twenty percent actually attended another college or university. The majority of those who transferred went to the University of Hawaii at Manoa.

We hope this survey is helpful in planning the educational goals of the college. Faculty and Counselors can communicate relevant career information to students. Suggestions and comments are welcome. The raw data are maintained in the Office of Institutional Research and are available for review.





Overall Satisfaction











Educational Satisfaction of Personal Interest






Employment Status






Job Relationship to Education






Educational Preparation for Current Job






