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ABSTRACT

This report presents tables of grades in selected first-year courses by entry-level placement test (ELT) status in Florida community colleges. The cohort used in this analysis consisted of the fall 1993 students with ELT scores as reported in the 1993-94 Student Data Base (SDB). Students who took an ELT were divided into those who passed and those who failed. The entire cohort was matched against the SDB course records for 1993-94 through 1995-96. The courses selected consisted of all courses that began with MAT1, MAC1, or ENC1. The study assumed that students enrolling in this level course had completed the highest level college preparatory course in the area. The fall 1993 cohort passed the mathematics portion of the ELT at a rate of 48%. By the end of the 1995-96 reporting year, 81% of those students who passed had enrolled in either a MAT1 or MAC1 course, while only 37% of those who failed had done so. The percent of students passing the writing segment of the ELT was 70%. After three years of follow-up, 85% of those initially passing had enrolled in ENC1 level courses, while only 53% of those initially failing had done so. The reading section of the ELT was passed at a rate of 73%. By the end of the 1995-96 reporting years, 82% of the Pass group had enrolled in ENC1 courses, while 59% of the Fail group had done so. 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GRADES IN SELECTED FIRST-YEAR COURSES BY ELT STATUS.

Introduction

Measure 4 Part 1 of the Accountability process looks at the number of degree seeking FTIC students who took an Entry Level Test (ELT), who enrolled in college preparatory courses in the various areas and who eventually passed the highest level preparatory course. Part 2 of this same Measure then tracks the student who were successful for an additional two years and reports on various outputs. While this provides an overview of what happens to students who fail one or more sections of the ELT, it does not provide any information at a course level.

The Office of Educational Effectiveness and Research was asked to investigate how well students who passed the highest level college preparatory course did in subsequent college level courses. This Data Trend is an attempt to answer that question.

Cohort Selection

The cohort used in this analysis consisted of the Fall 1993 FTIC students with ELT scores as reported in the 1993-94 Student Data Base. This cohort is very similar to the one used in Measure 4 Part 1 of the Accountability process, but is not limited to degree-seeking students. Nor was there any attempt to include only those students with all three ELT scores. Any FTIC student with an ELT score in a given area was included in that area. Thus, the overall N was slightly different for each area.

Data Analysis

Students who took an ELT were divided into those who

passed and those who failed. The entire cohort was matched against the SDB course records for 1993-94 through 1995-96. The courses selected consisted of all courses that began with MAT1, MAC1 or ENCI. It was felt that this would provide a simple way of incorporating the differences among colleges in the first-year mathematics and English courses. An underlying assumption of the study was that *students enrolling in this level course had completed the highest level college preparatory course in the area.*

The grades for both MAT1 and MAC1 were then grouped by pass/fail for the math portion of the ELT. ENCI was grouped in this fashion for both the reading and writing sections of the ELT. In addition to looking at the grade distributions and the number of enrollments, unduplicated headcounts were also considered.

Results

Mathematics

The Fall 1993 cohort passed the mathematics portion of the ELT at a rate of forty-eight (48) percent. By the end of the 1995-96 reporting year, eighty-one (81) percent of those students who passed had enrolled in either a MAT1 or MAC1 course, while only thirty-seven (37) percent of those who failed had done so. Measure 4 Part 1 indicates approximately forty-two (42) percent of those enrolling in college prep passed the highest level. If this percentage holds true for the cohort used in this study, then persons passing the highest level prep course took first-year courses at the same rate as those who passed the ELT originally.

For MAT1 courses, the number of enrollments among

students who failed almost equaled the number of enrollment generated by students who passed. Students who failed the ELT generated an average of 1.5 MAT1 enrollments each, while those who passed generated only 0.9. For the MAC1 courses, students failing the ELT generated an average of .76 enrollments while those passing generated 1.34. Thus while both groups of students are continuing, those initially failing the ELT appear to be taking MAT1 courses prior to reaching the MAC1 level.

One institution's reporting of a large number of P and X grades for MAT1 courses make it harder to compare the two groups for that segment of the analysis than it was for MAC1. In general, students passing the ELT made better grades in MAT1 course than those who initially failed the test. The success rate, i.e., percent earning an A, B or C, for the Fail group was slightly over thirty-eight (38) percent compared to slightly over forty-seven (47) percent for the Pass group.

For MAC1 courses, those failing tended to make lower grades. The Fail success rate was forty-five (45) percent with that of the Pass group fifty-two (52) percent. The Fail group also had fewer F's and more W's.

Writing

The percent of students passing the writing segment of the ELT was seventy (70). After three years of follow-up, eighty-five (85) percent of those initially passing had enrolled in ENCI level courses, while only fifty-three (53) of those initially failing had done so. Again, based upon the information contained in Measure 4 Part 1, both groups appear to be moving through their first-year English courses at the same rate.

The number of enrollments generated by students failing the ELT averaged 2.3. The average for those passing

the ELT was slightly less at 2.1. This may reflect the higher success rate in terms of grades earned by the Pass cohort. Almost sixty-four (64) percent of their enrollments were successful. The Fail group had a success rate of fifty-six (56) percent. Both groups had almost equal percentages of F's and W's.

Reading

The reading section of the ELT was passed at a rate of seventy-three (73) percent. This was the highest level of success among the three areas. By the end of the 1995-96 reporting years, eighty-two (82) percent of the Pass group had enrolled in ENCI courses, while fifty-nine (59) percent of the Fail group had done so. If the results of Measure 4 Part 1 apply to this entire cohort, the Fail group is moving forward in their collegiate career at a faster rate than the Pass group is.

The average number of enrollments for the Fail group was 2.3, while that of the Pass group was 2.1. That this is the same as for writing is not surprising since the courses are the same and there is a high correlation between reading and writing ELT outcomes.

The course grades success rates also mirror those of writing with the Pass group achieving a rate of slightly over sixty-three (63) percent compared to slightly over fifty-seven (57) for the Fail group. The Fail group earned less than half the A's and twice the D's of the other group. F's and W's were almost the same for the two groups.

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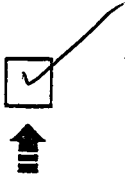
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
