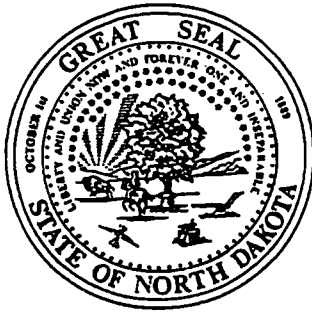

ABSTRACT

INTRODUCTION

DEFINITIONS

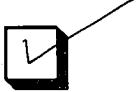
