ABSTRACT

This data report includes trend tables from three sources of data regarding where Howard County (Maryland) citizens and recent high school graduates attend college. These trend tables are described and documented with minimal analysis and are intended to serve as a central data source for further development of charts, presentations, and analyses of particular situations. One statewide system, SOAR, tracks recent high school graduates to public and private campuses in Maryland. Trends indicate that HCC gets 30% of the recent high school graduates who go as full-time students to Maryland campuses. Four-year trends are provided for each public high school in Howard County. The Howard County Department of Education Post Graduation Survey indicates that eighty-five percent of the respondents reported they had attended college during the first year out of school. Another report, the MHEC's Enrollment by Residency Report, was developed from the annual Fall Enrollment reporting systems and include all Howard County residents attending public and private campuses in Maryland. Highlights from these 5-year trend tables are included and provide useful information regarding HCC's share of enrollment categories. (JJL)

HCC Market Share of Howard County Residents and High School Graduates

Trend Tables and Data Documentation

Howard Community College (HCC) has three sources of data regarding where Howard County citizens and recent high school graduates attend college. Trends in enrollment from these three sources provide valuable perspectives on important categories of our own enrollment as well as valuable information regarding the other campuses being chosen by different categories of students. This data report includes trend tables from these sources. These trend tables, clearly labeled and easy to interpret, are described and documented in this report with minimal analysis. The report provides a central data source for further development of charts, presentations and analyses of particular situations. These analyses might range from an examination of HCC enrollment compared with enrollment at another campus, or a closer look at where part-time students are attending college. Particular trend tables and charts will be prepared from these tables to share during the environmental scanning phase of the planning process and with various forums concerned with campus facilities planning, enrollment management and enrollment projections.

1. **SOAR: Market Share Within Maryland for Recent High School Graduates.**

This statewide system tracks recent high school graduates to public and private campuses in Maryland. Trends in the numbers of students reported in this data system indicates that HCC gets 30% of the recent high school graduates who go as full-time students to Maryland campuses. HCC has also been getting 70% of the students from this group who attend as part-time students. Four-year trends are provided for each public high school in Howard County.

2. **Howard County Department of Education Post Graduation Survey: Market Share of All High School Graduates.**

This Howard County Department of Education survey is conducted every two years and is sent to all graduates one year after graduation. The 1997 survey of 1996 graduates indicates that eighty-five percent of the respondents reported they had attended college during the first year out of school. Of the students reporting they had gone to college, 22% reported they had attended a community college and 31% reported they had attended an out of state college. This survey is our only source of information about how many of the high school senior class are going to out-of-state campuses. This information is provided for each public high school for the spring 1996 graduates.

**3. MHEC's Enrollment by Residency Report:
Market Share of All Howard County Residents Going to College in Maryland.**

These trend tables have been developed from the annual Fall Enrollment reporting systems and include all Howard County residents attending public and private campuses in Maryland. Each year data from the annual MHEC report are added to update these trend tables. The trend tables for students attending as full-time and part-time students are provided as well as trends in where new full time freshmen are attending college in Maryland. Highlights from these 5 year trend tables include:

- HCC gets 44% of all Howard County undergraduates attending in-state campuses as credit students. This "market share" has been stable over the last five years.
- HCC has gotten 33% of all new full-time freshmen during this 5-year period and 37% of this group in fall 1997. This group of students at HCC increased by 30% over the period 1993 to 1997. Towson's new full-time freshmen enrollment from Howard County increased by 90% during this period.
- HCC has been getting 25% of all the Howard County residents who attend Maryland campuses as full-time undergraduates. This group has increased by 13% at HCC and by 6% statewide.
- HCC has been getting 62% of all the Howard County residents who attend Maryland campuses as part-time students. The number of these students, however, has been decreasing at HCC and across the state. Almost every campus in Maryland that has had Howard County residents attending as part-timers has experienced a decline in this category during this period. Our own decline of 12% over this 5 year period has apparently not been because these students have been choosing another Maryland campus, but because there have been fewer part-time credit students at all of these campuses.

The tables in this report contain useful information regarding HCC's share of important enrollment categories. The trend tables allow HCC to monitor shifts in enrollment patterns and are designed to provoke a closer examination of why enrollment in particular categories may be changing. Your thoughts on how to integrate understanding of these trends into the planning process and into HCC's enrollment management process are welcomed. 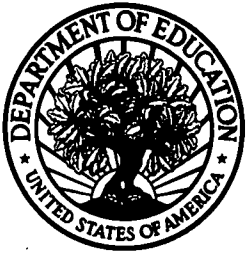
