ABSTRACT

This report presents summary statistics on application and registration patterns of applicants applying for fall entry into full-time study in their first year of university programs. Those few students who applied directly to the institutions may not be included in these statistics. In 2001, there were 325,139 applications by 92,863 applicants, of whom 51,555 actually registered at an Ontario university. Tables present data about application and registration ratios, applicants and registered applicants by institution and institutional category, and student preferences and geographic origin. Three appendixes describe program groupings and geographic groupings and explain one table's headings in more detail. (Contains 15 tables and 13 figures.) (SLD)

This report presents summary statistics on application and registration patterns of applicants (who were processed by the Application Centre), applying for fall entry into full-time study in their first year of post-OAC programs in Ontario Universities.

This series of annual reports commenced with admissions in Fall, 1973.

It is possible that some first-year students may apply directly to institutions and hence may not be included in these statistics. The Council of Ontario Universities has established a Committee comprised of representatives from universities, OUAC and the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities (MTCU), to establish a mechanism for the province-wide collection of registration data in a timely, complete and accurate fashion.

In the interim we urge users of this report to carefully review the "Definitions" (page 1) and "Limitations" (page 2) sections of this report.

Introduction

This report presents application and registration data for the Fall of 2001. The presentation of the data is identical to that used in last year's report. Users are cautioned to read the *Limitations* section of this report to be aware of any factors which might affect the comparability of data in this report to earlier reports in this series, and also to reports which present registration statistics.

Definitions

For the purpose of this report, the definitions used by the Ontario Universities' Application Centre have been employed.

Secondary school applicants refer to those applicants who were registered during the 2000-01 academic year as full-time day students in the OAC year at an Ontario secondary school. All other applicants were defined to be *Other applicants*.

Each applicant was allowed to indicate an unlimited number of choices of universities and programs. Each choice was considered to be a distinct *application*, even though the applicant submitted only one application form. Applicants also indicated their order of preference for their choices.

Throughout the admission cycle, applicants were permitted to amend their choices by dropping a choice and adding a different choice. Deleted choices are referred to as inactive choices or applications while current choices (up to the maximum of three) are called active choices. *All of the tables in this report exclude inactive choices.*

The Application Centre is responsible for processing all applications for first-year full-time applicants who were not previously registered at an Ontario university. When these applicants subsequently registered at a university, they were designated as *registered applicants*. If a student had been previously registered (i.e. repeater or internal transfer between programs) at that institution, his/her application was not processed by the Centre. Data on all students registered in first-year programs on a full-time basis were provided to the Centre by the universities via the Statistics Canada/MTCU USIS/UAR system. Included in these figures were those students who had applied for advanced standing above first year but had subsequently registered in first year. Where universities did not identify the classification of some of their registrants, these registrants were recorded as unidentified registrants.

Statistics presented in this report deal only with applicants processed by the Application Centre who are applying for fall entry into full-time study in their first year of post-OAC programs. In addition to the exclusions listed in the previous paragraph, applicants seeking admission to preliminary year programs or diploma programs which do not require OAC's for entry have been excluded. Table 15 presents a reconciliation of the various categories of registrants in first year.

General Limitations

As previously stated, the Application Centre received data on registrations indirectly from the universities as part of their annual submission of USIS/UAR enrolment data to Statistics Canada and MTCU. In its operations the Application Centre employs a unique set of program categories; there may not be a direct correspondence between these categories and the program categories used by MTCU and Statistics Canada. Furthermore, there may be instances where a student is reported in one program to the Application Centre and reported in a different program to either MTCU or Statistics Canada. In addition, statistics showing enrolment in *First Year* from MTCU and Statistics Canada may include programs (e.g., law, medicine, etc.) that are not included in first year as defined by the Application Centre.

Commencing with the 1993 report, Nipissing University is reported separately from Laurentian University.

Commencing with the 1995 report, Ontario College of Art & Design is reported. However, because OCAD only offers diploma programs, they are by definition excluded from tables 1 to 14 in this report. Table 15 (reconciliation table), however, shows figures for OCAD.

Commencing in 1998, students were no longer limited to 3 choices. Therefore, the number of applications is somewhat higher than in earlier years and therefore not strictly comparable. Between 1998 and 2001, the percentage of applications received where the applicant selected more than 3 choices increased from 8.6% to 22.4%.

Applicants and Registrants Summary

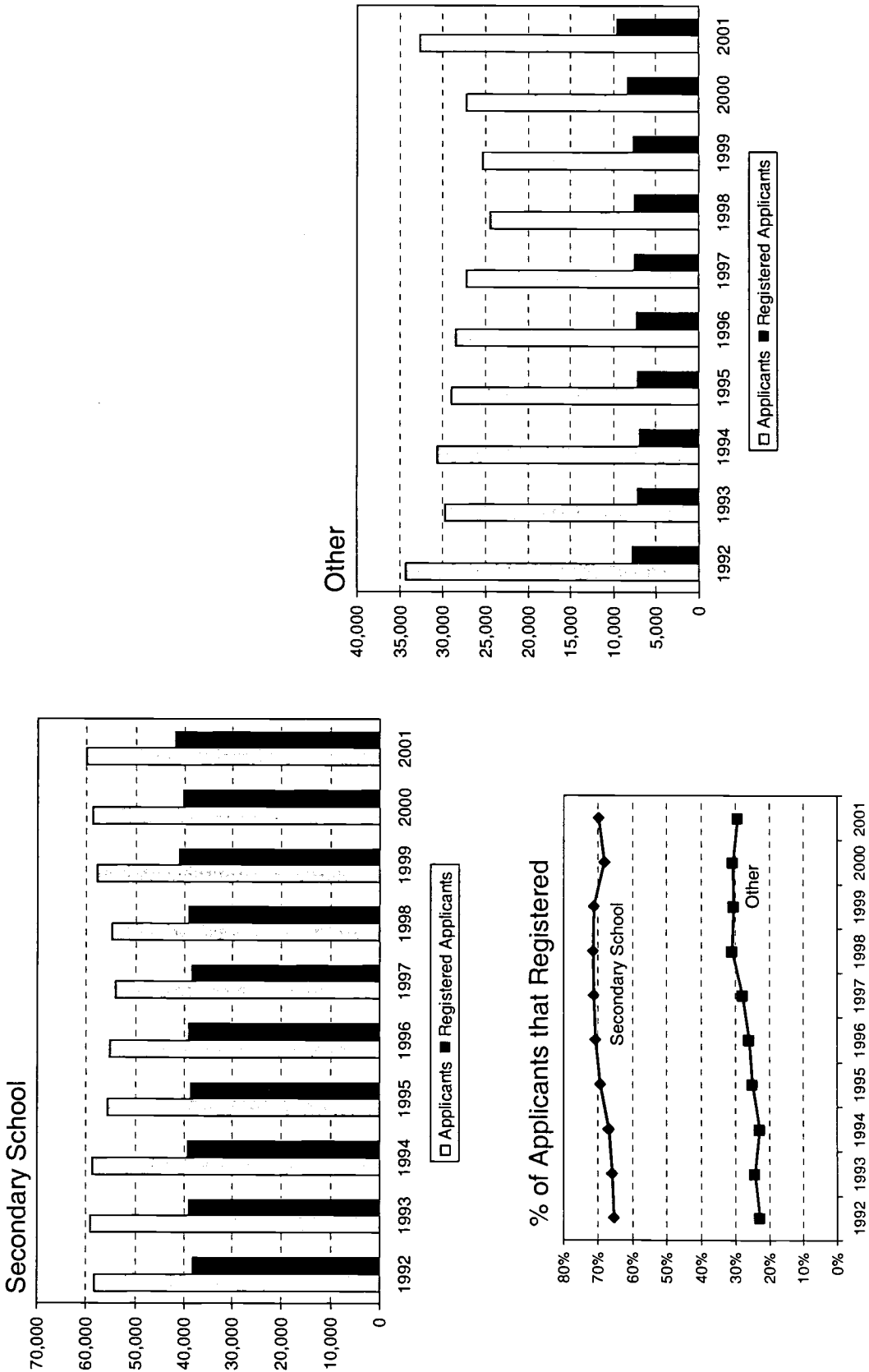

Registered Applicants by University and Category, 2001

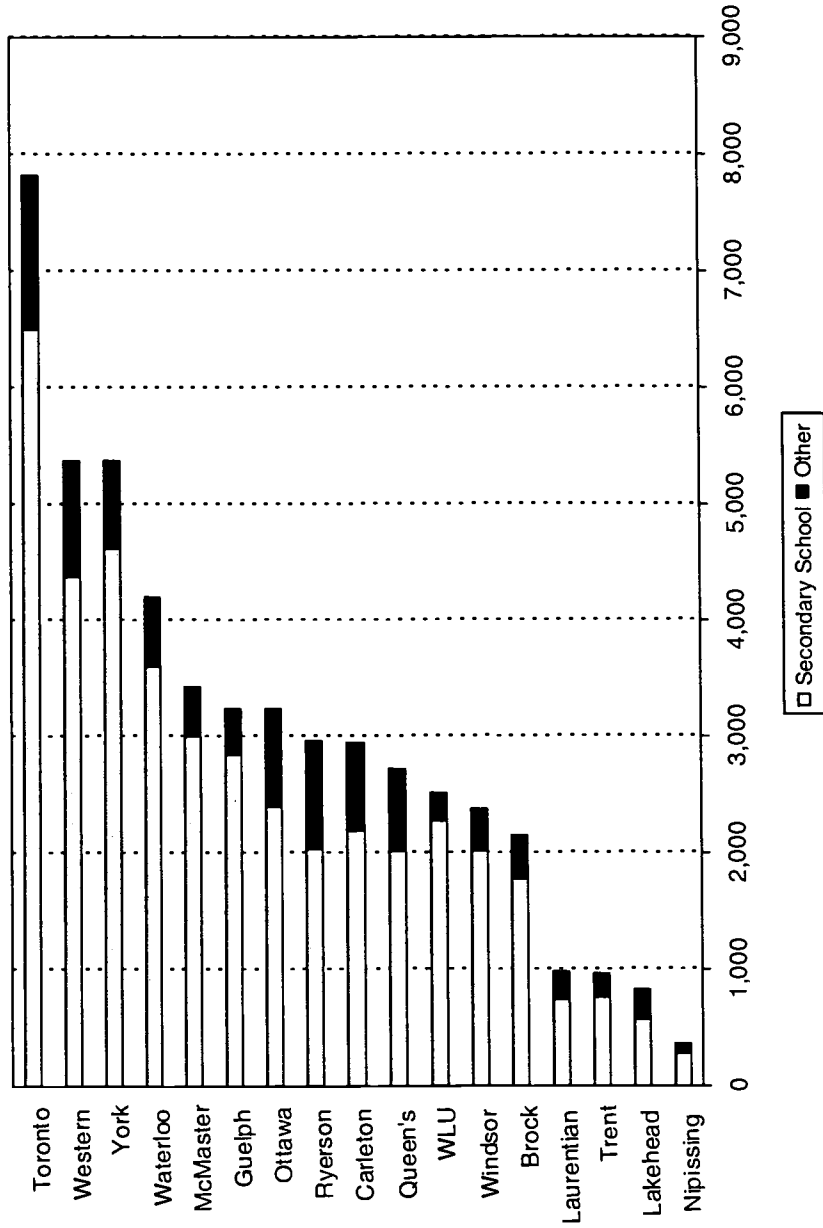

by University, 2001

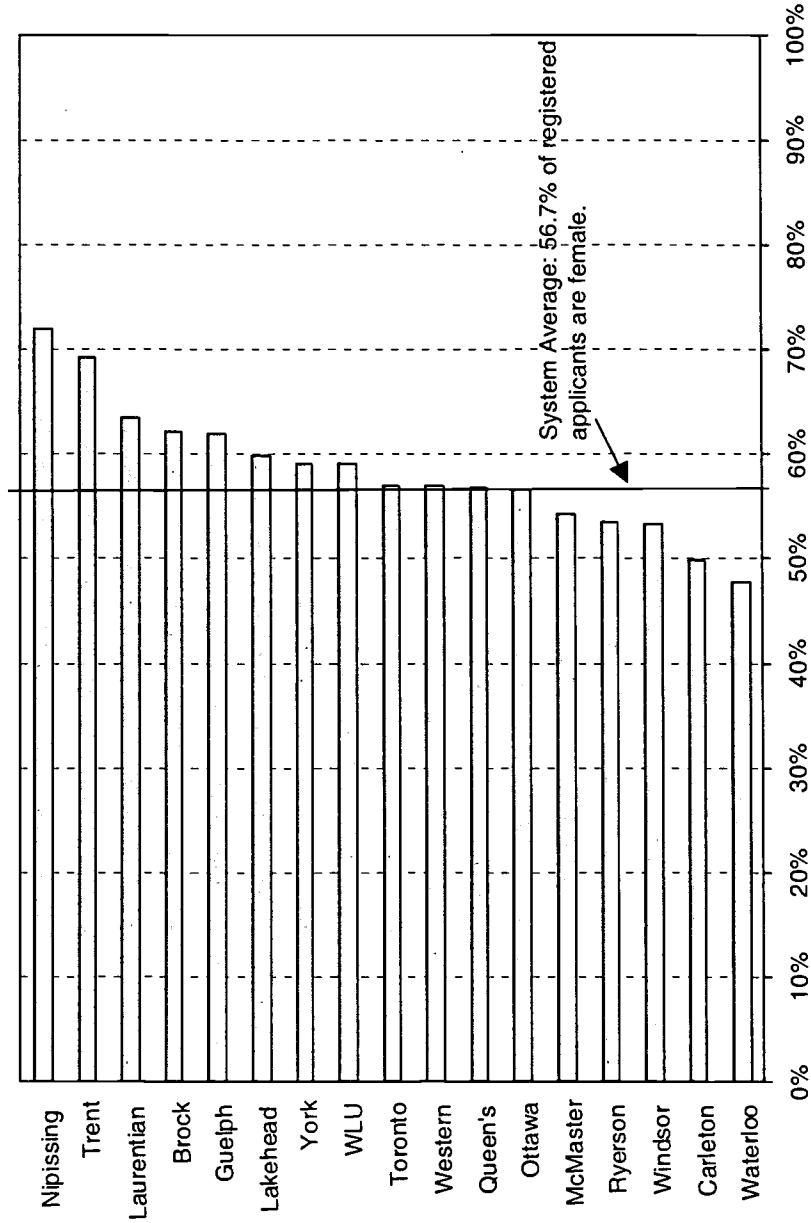

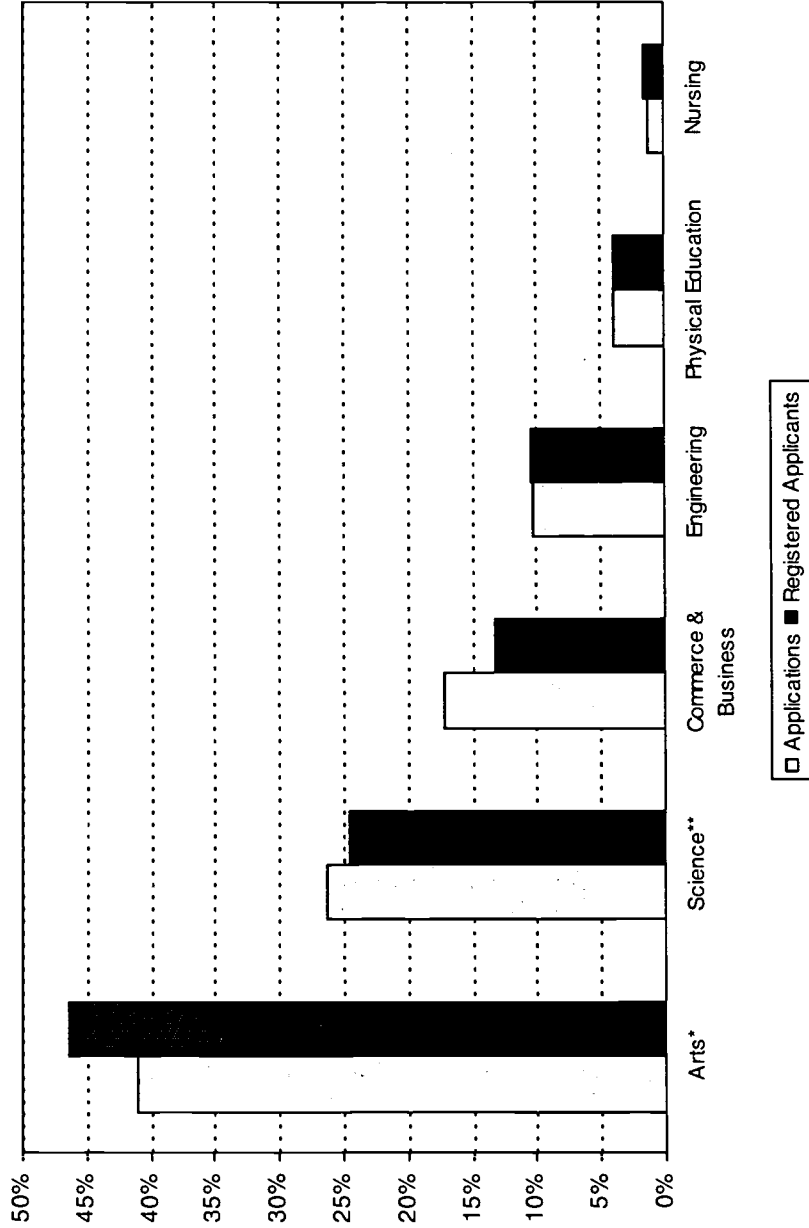

Major Educational Source, 2001

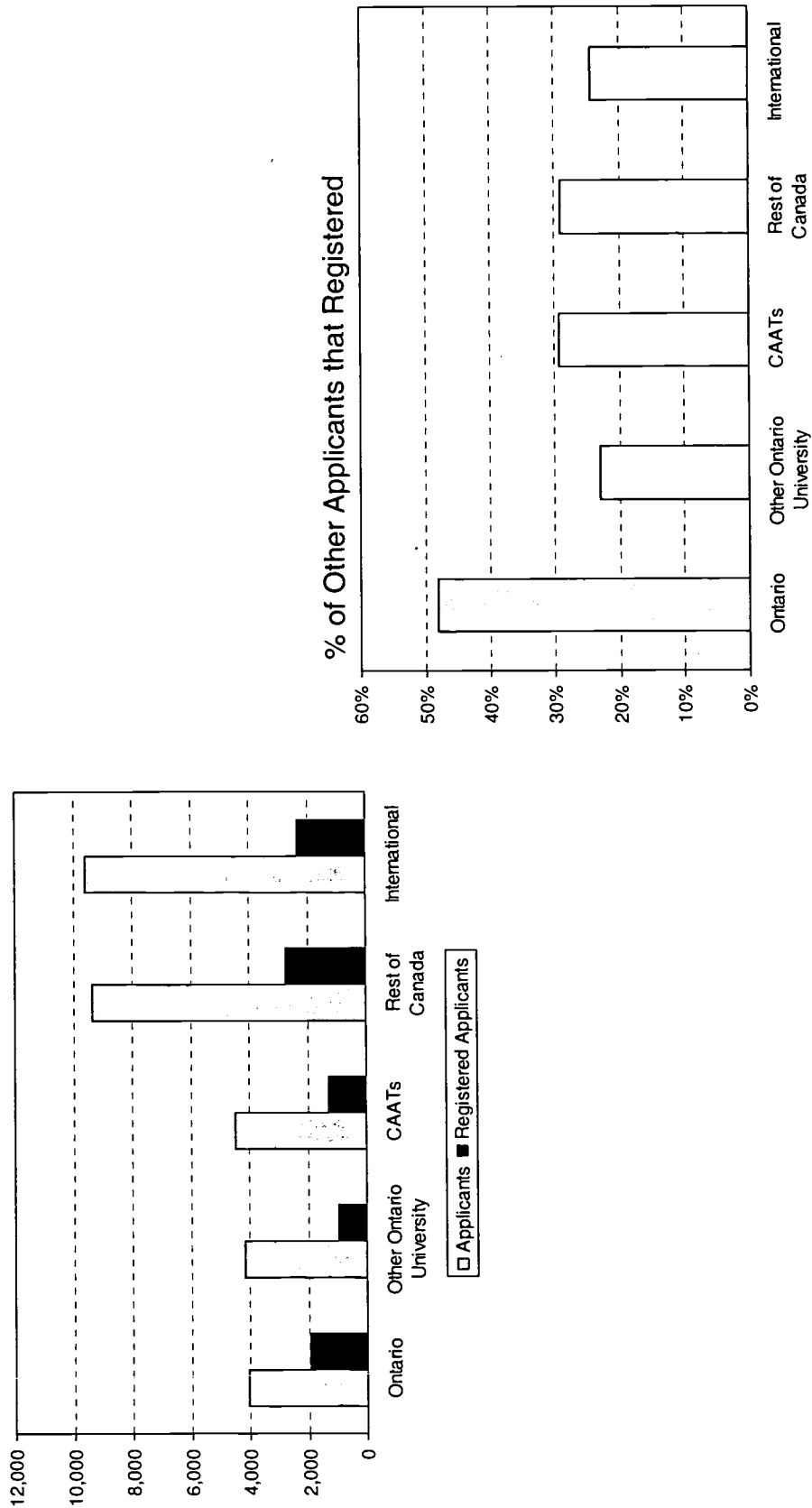

Distribution of SECONDARY SCHOOL Applications and Registered Applicants by Geographic Origin, 2001

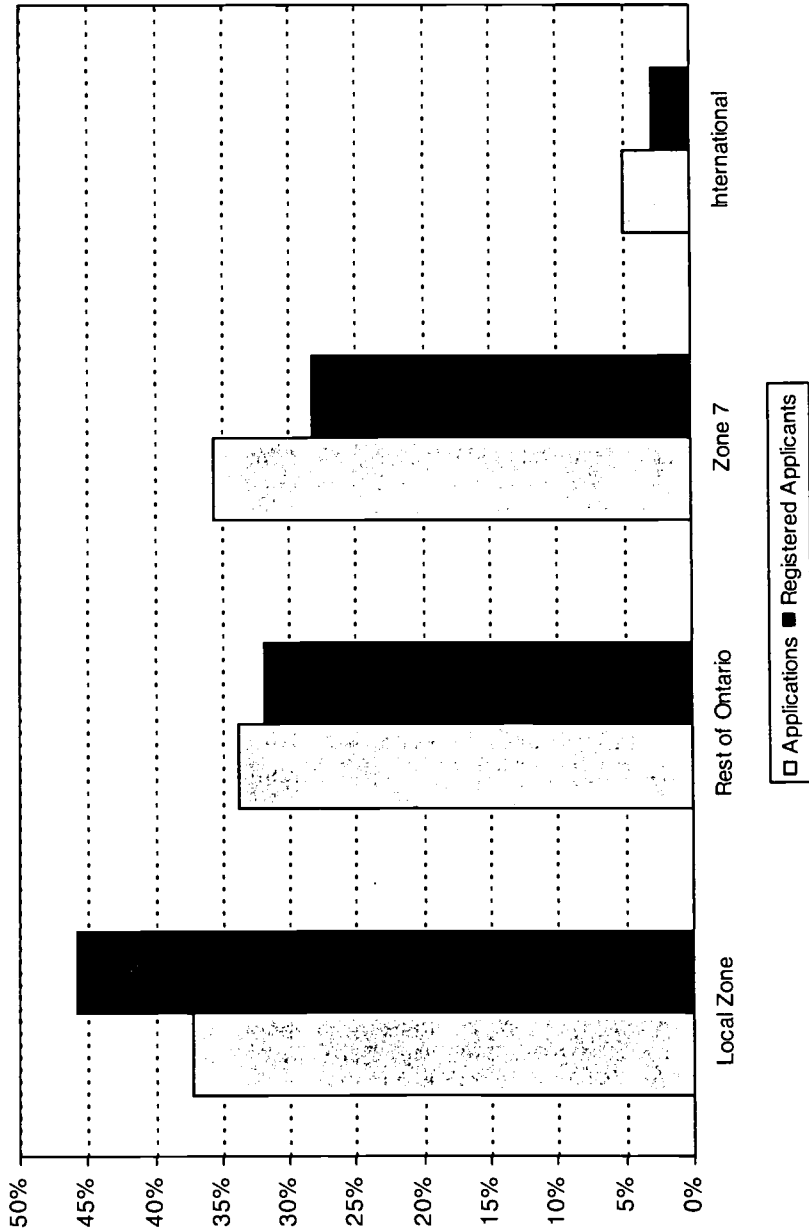

Distribution of OTHER Applications and Registered Applicants by Geographic Origin, 2001

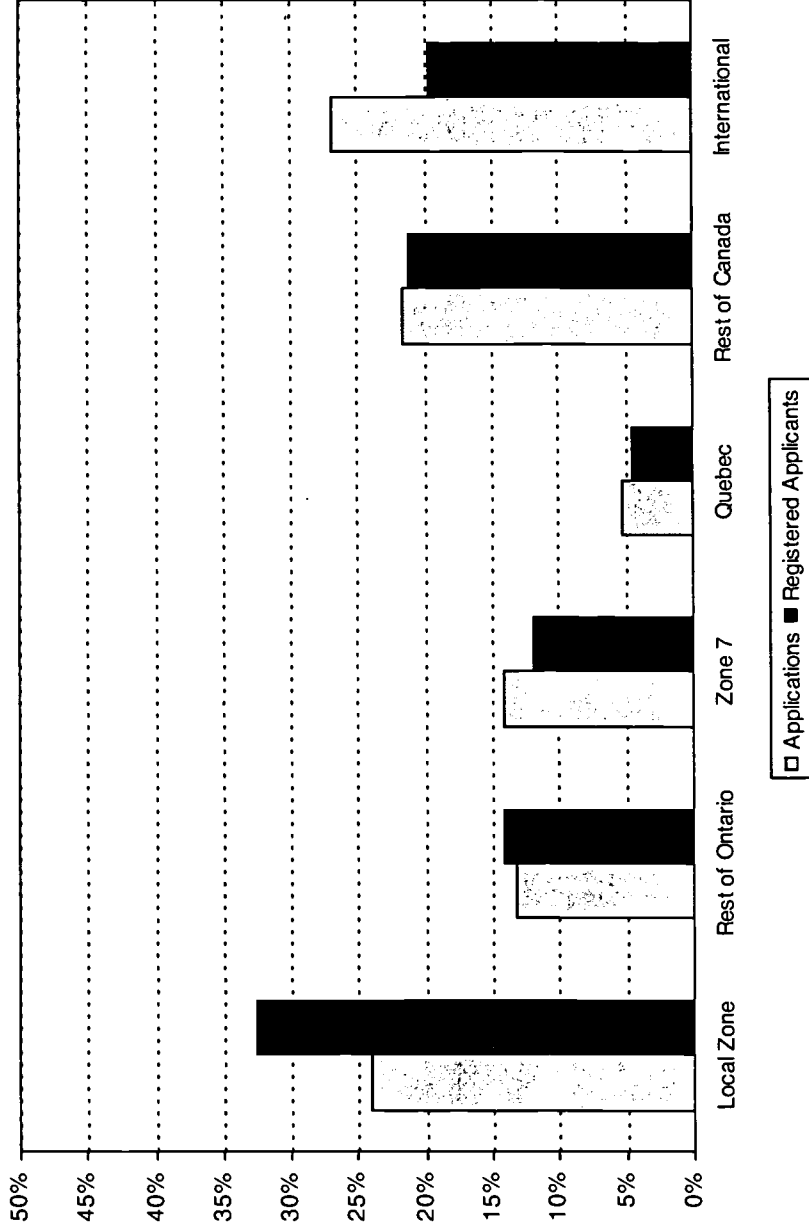

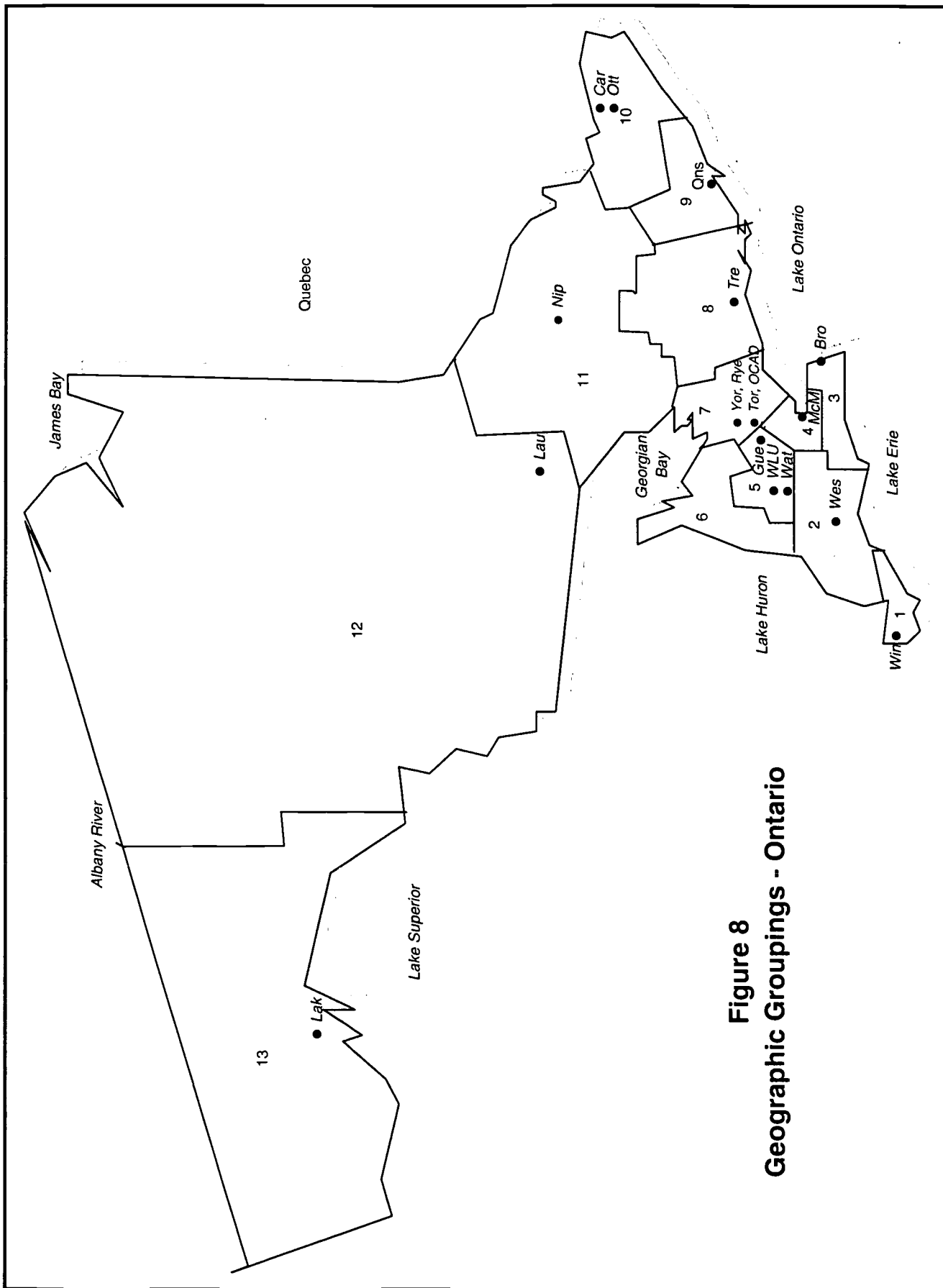

by Age and Gender, 2001

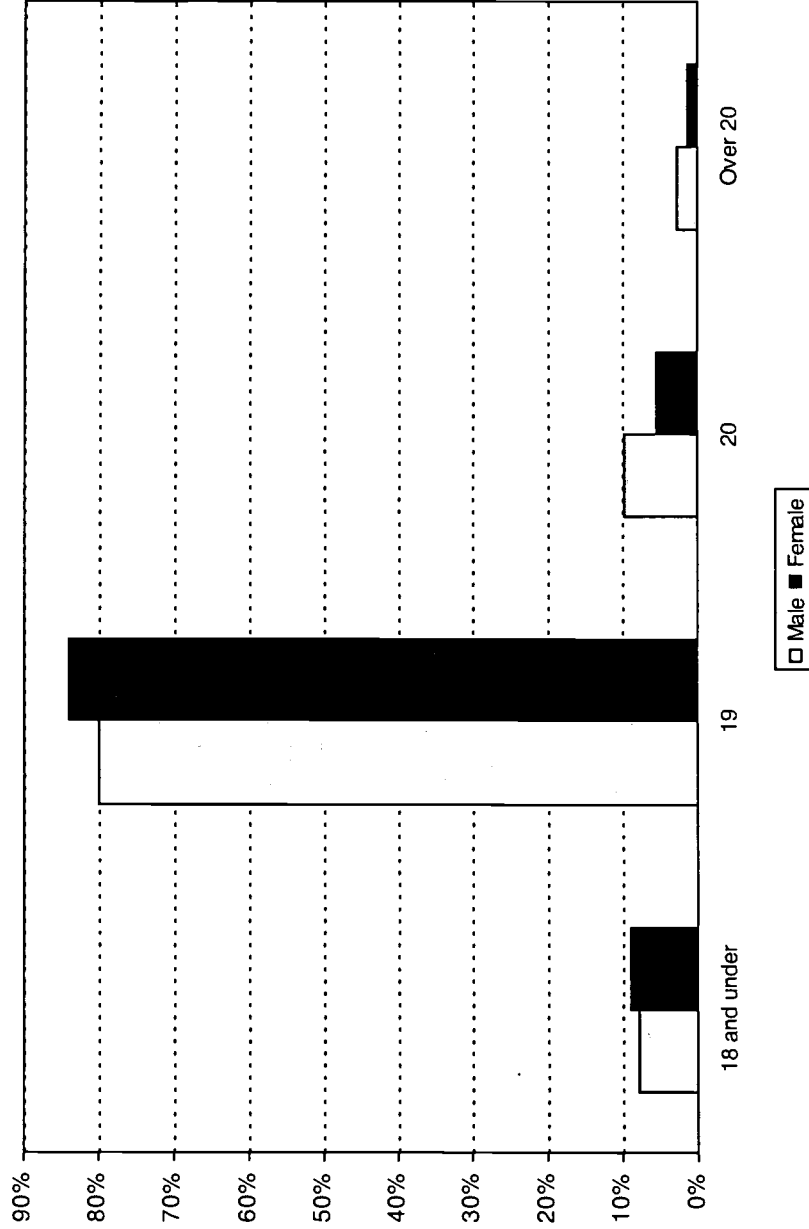

by Age and Gender, 2001

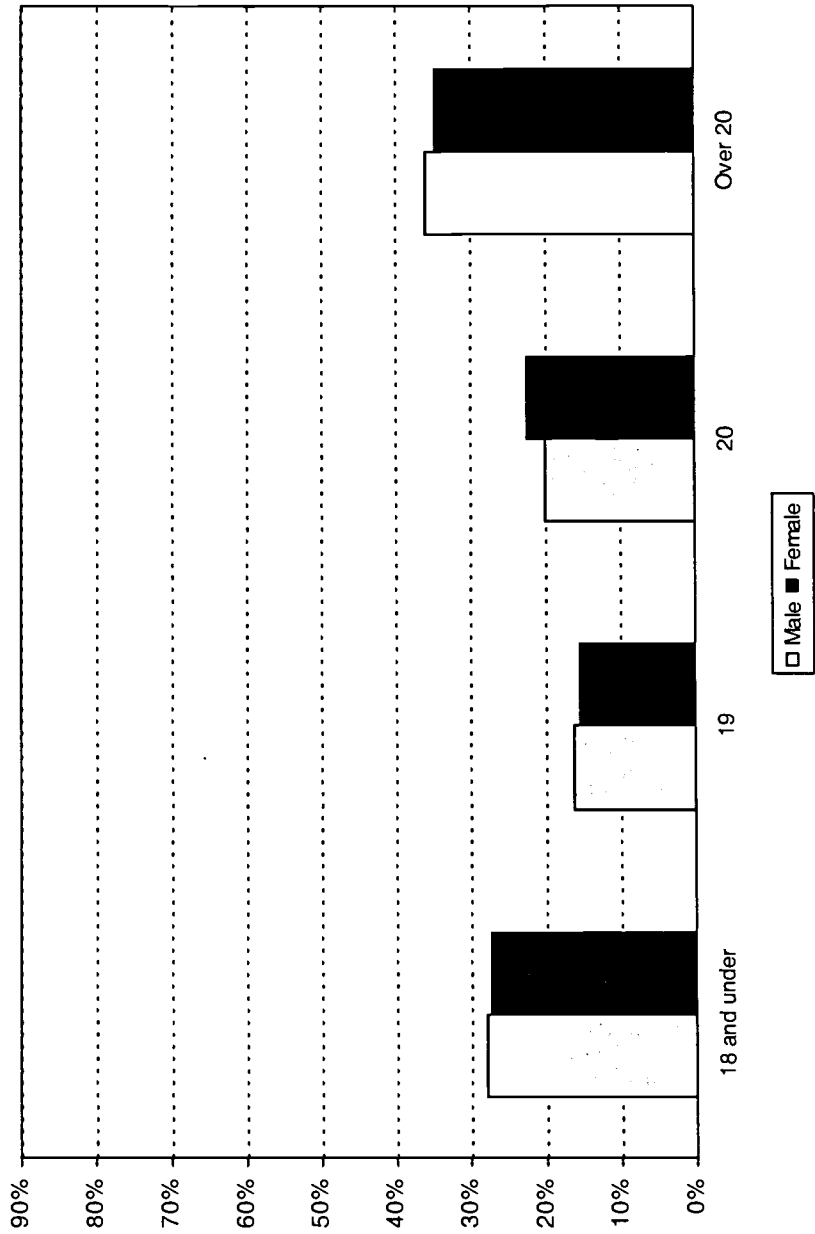

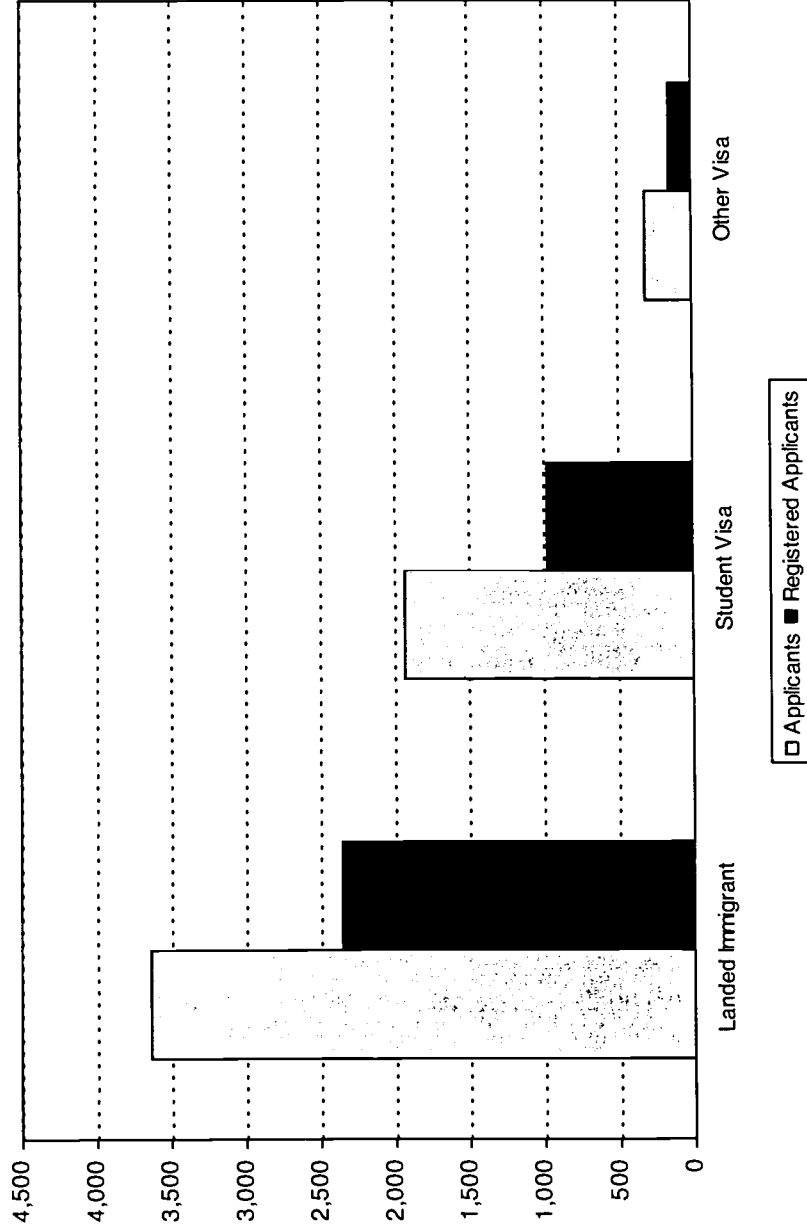

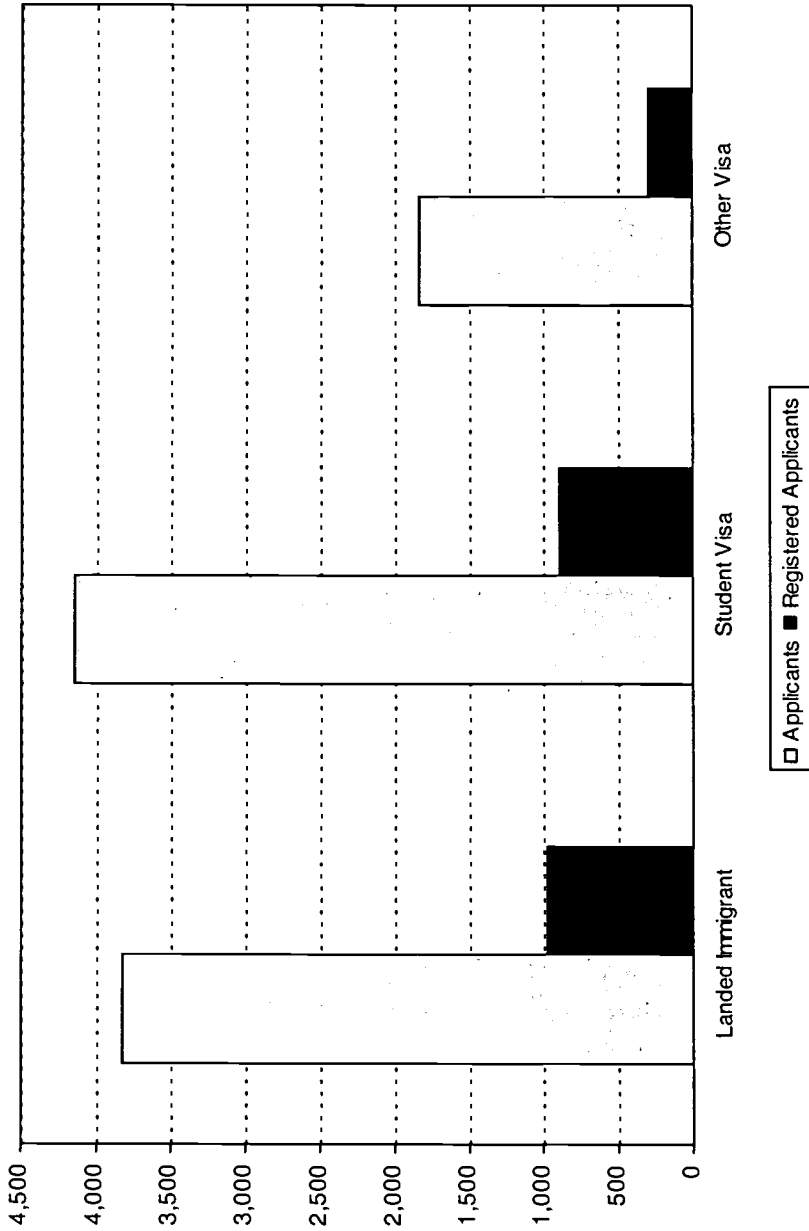

by Program, 2001

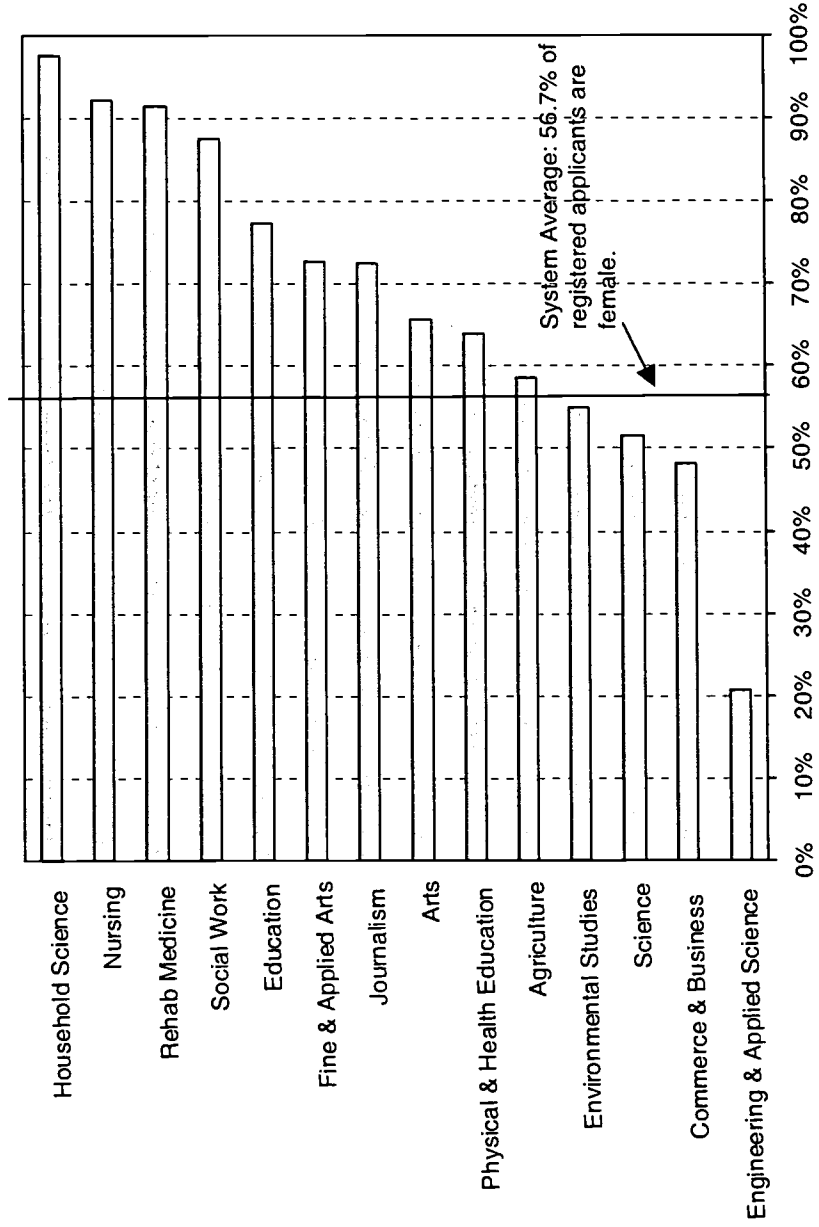

Explanation of Table 15 Column Headings

Table 15 reconciles the data in Application Statistics with the OUAC Admission Data System Report.

Registered Applicants in 1st Year

Registered applicants who applied for fall entry into full-time study in their first year of post-OAC programs. The figures exclude those seeking admission to preliminary year programs or diploma programs which do not require OAC's for entry.
