ABSTRACT

This document includes tables and graphs illustrating the transfer rates of University of Hawaii Community College (UHCC) students into the University of Hawaii (UH) four-year campuses. The population of the study was restricted to those students enrolled at UHCCs in either the Fall 2000 or Spring 2001 semester with a declared educational objective of either Associate in Arts or Associate in Science, and further restricted to those students who had completed 24 or more credit hours of course work at UHCC campuses. The first table and graphic show numbers of students with transfer rates by campus. The second table and graphic shows transfer rates by ethnic background of students. The third table and graphic shows selected characteristics for the student enrolled at UH Manoa. Overall, 14.1% of the UHCC students transferred to the UH four-year campuses over the time period. Among ethnic groups, American Indian and Alaskan students had the highest transfer rate (27.3%), but the small number of students in the UHCC group (33) precludes definitive conclusions. Of the 1,067 UHCC students who transferred to UH Manoa, 24.8% had received a degree from a UH campus, 56% were female and the average number of credit hours earned at the UHCC campuses prior to transfer measured 64.2 hours. TRANSFER RATES: UH 2-YEAR TO UH 4-YEAR CAMPUSES

The graphics and tables that follow show the transfer rates of UH Community College students into the UH four-year campuses. For this study, the population was restricted to those students enrolled at the UH Community Colleges in either the Fall 2000 or Spring 2001 semester with a declared educational objective of either Associate in Arts or Associate in Science. The population was further restricted to those students who had completed 24 or more credit hours of coursework at the UHCC campuses.

Students were considered to have transferred if they were found to be enrolled in a UH four-year campus in either the Spring 2001 or Fall 2001 semester. The first table and graphic show numbers of students with transfer rates by campus. The second table and graphic show transfer rates by ethnic background of students. The third table shows selected characteristics for the students enrolled at UH Manoa.

Overall, 14.1% of the UHCC students transferred to the UH four-year campuses over the time period in question. Windward CC had the highest campus rate (16.0%), while Kaua'i CC had the lowest (11.7%). UH Manoa received the most transfers (10.2%), with UH-West O'ahu next (2.1%) and UH Hilo third (1.8%).

Among ethnic groups, American Indian / Alaskan students had the highest transfer rate (27.3%), but the small number of students in the UHCC group (33) precludes definitive conclusions. Students of Chinese extraction had a relatively high transfer rate (19.7%), as did Korean students (19.3%). Filipino students (9.4%) and African American students (6.4%) had the lowest transfer rates.

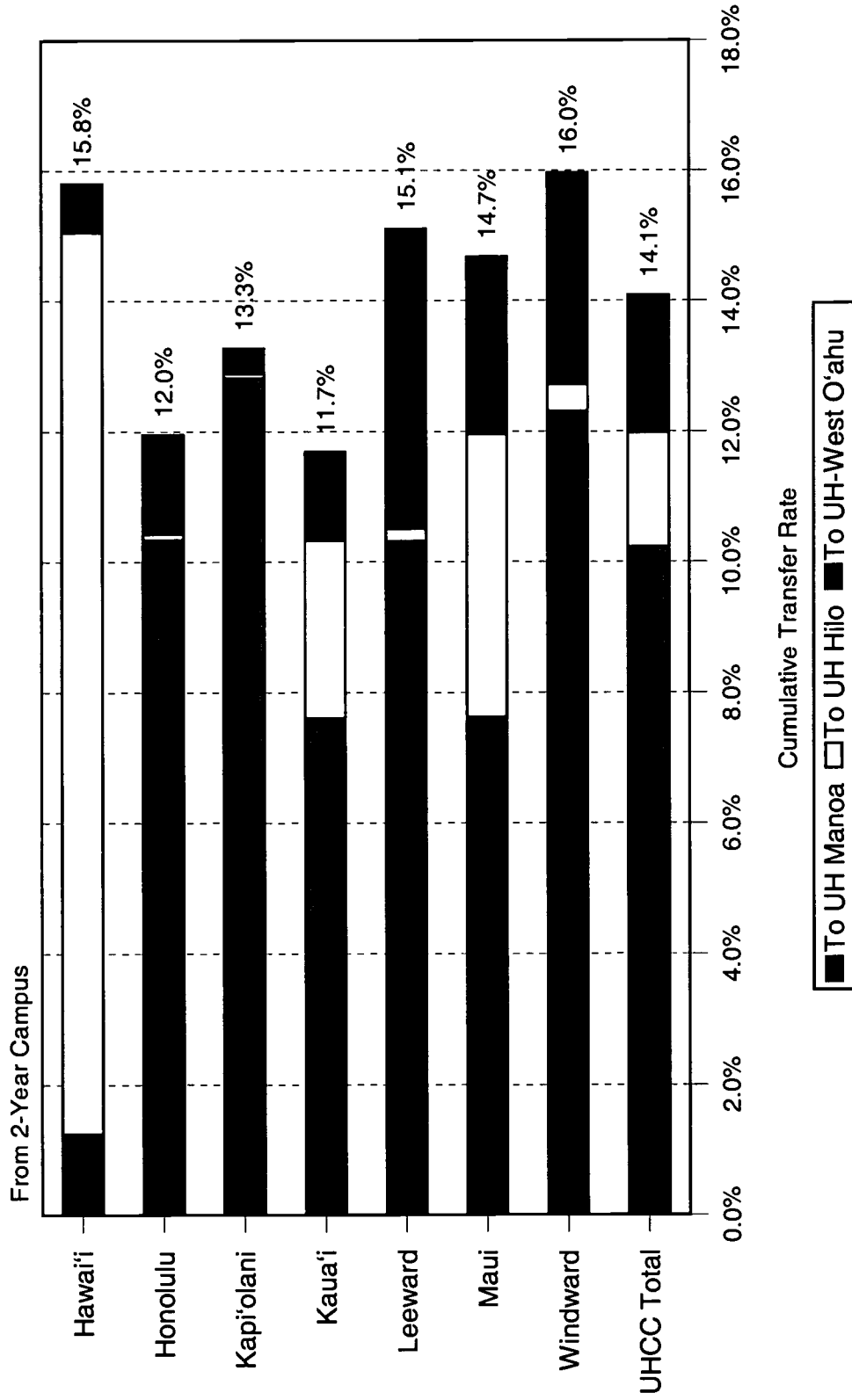
Of the 1,067 UHCC students who transferred to UH Manoa, 24.8% had received a degree from a UHCC campus, 56% were female and the average number of credit hours earned at the UHCC campuses prior to transfer measured 64.2 hours.

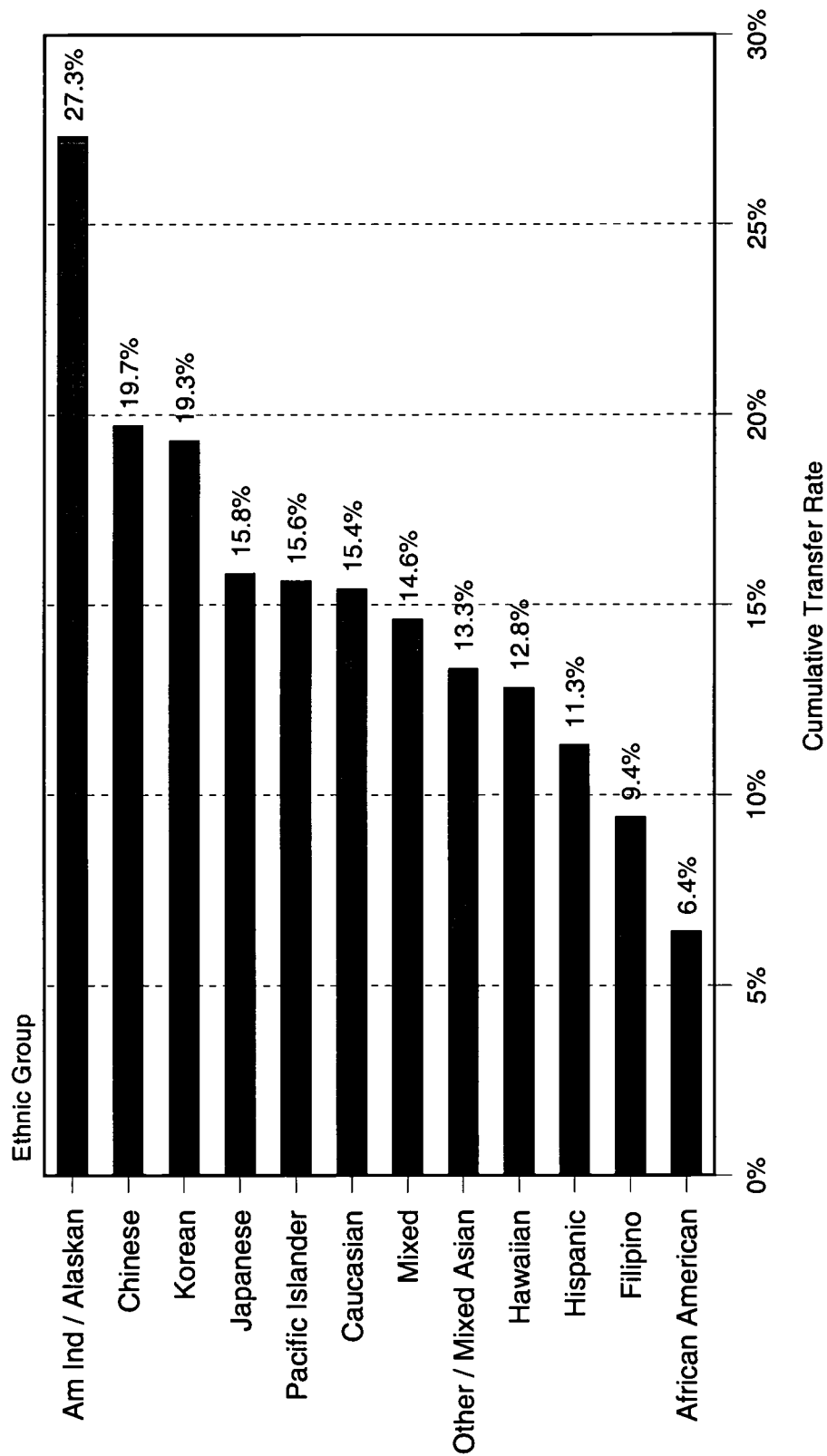
