


Average Daily Attendance

This chart shows the percent of students that attend school each day.




Free- or Reduced-Priced Meals













These charts show the percent of students meeting or exceeding the academic content standards in reading and mathematics (Levels III and IV).









Percent of Students Meeting or Exceeding Standards




Taxpayers' Report FISCAL YEAR 2003

Student Academic Performance
