Unless stated otherwise, all data are sourced from the national Apprentice and Trainee Collection. The Apprentice and Trainee Collection is an administrative collection governed by the *Australian Vocational Education and Training Management Information Statistical Standard: The Standard for New Apprenticeships* – *Release 6.0* (AVETMISS Release 6.0), which is available at NCVER's website: http://www.ncver.edu.au. References to the applicable field definitions within AVETMISS Release 6.0 which further define the data collected are provided in the 'Source' section.
