
## **Overall Results**

- In 2011, the average score of fourth-grade students in Wyoming was 224. This was higher than the average score of 220 for public school students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Wyoming in 2011 (224) was not significantly different from their average score in 2009 (223) and was not significantly different from their average score in 1992 (223).
- In 2011, the score gap between students in Wyoming at the 75th percentile and students at the 25th percentile was 42 points. This performance gap was not significantly different from that of 1992 (40 points).
- The percentage of students in Wyoming who performed at or above the NAEP Proficient level was 34 percent in 2011. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (33 percent) and was not significantly different from that in 1992 (33 percent).
- The percentage of students in Wyoming who performed at or above the NAEP Basic level was 71 percent in 2011. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (72 percent) and was not significantly different from that in 1992 (71 percent).


## Compare the Average Score in 2011 to Other States/Jurisdictions

In 2011, the average score in Wyoming (224) was

- lower than those in 8 states/jurisdictions
- higher than those in 28 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 15 states/jurisdictions

## Score Gaps for Student Groups

- Data are not reported for Black students in 2011, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2011, Hispanic students had an average score that was 15 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1992 (19 points).
- In 2011, female students in Wyoming had an average score that was higher than male students by 7 points.
- In 2011, students who were eligible for free/reduced-price school lunch, an indicator of low family income, had an average score that was 16 points lower than students who were not eligible for free/reduced-price school lunch. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1998 (18 points).
