

HIGH SCHOOL FEEDBACK

An Analysis of States' Current Efforts

Updated 12/12/11

There is increased demand from multiple stakeholders for information about the success of K–12 students after high school:

- The best indicator of whether students are graduating from high school ready for college and careers is actual information about their postsecondary experience, such as enrollment, remediation, and degree completion.
- When this information is provided to schools and districts, it is often referred to as **high school feedback**. This feedback is provided through a variety of mechanisms, including in web-based formats, comprehensive school profiles, or stand-alone high school feedback reports.
- As educators and systems leaders recalibrate the education system to prepare students for college and careers, they seek timely, specific feedback about student postsecondary outcomes to inform and improve their efforts.
- Local and state leaders and federal policymakers and systems leaders are increasingly interested in using high school feedback for measuring school progress, alignment, and accountability and for informing school improvement decisions.
- As a condition of receiving various federal funds, states have committed to produce high school feedback indicators, as in the following cases:
 - > As a condition of receiving State Fiscal Stabilization Funds (SFSF), every state must report the percent of high school graduates that enroll in college and earn one year's worth of credit by January 2012.
 - > As a condition of receiving ESEA waivers, states must annually report college enrollment and credit accumulation rates by high school. Eleven states (CO, FL, GA, IN, KY, MA, MN, NJ, NM, OK, and TN) made this commitment when they submitted requests through the first round of waivers in November 2011.

States, more than local entities, are best positioned to leverage their investments in statewide longitudinal data systems to secure this information, analyze it, and provide it to stakeholders in usable forms.
