Wyoming Community College System 2008-2009

Annual Enrollment Report Introduction

This report provides an annual look at the summer 2008, fall 2008 and spring 2009 terms' enrollment in categories such as time, location and demographics of the community college student population. The content and format of this report has been developed through a collaborative effort between the Wyoming Community College Commission and the Institutional Research Committee members representing the seven community colleges. Most of the tables relay data that has been tracked by both of the aforementioned entities for over 10 years.

The enrollment reports continue to evolve as new data sets are needed to meet federal mandates, as well as to meet current requirements of the state and community colleges. Changes that have been made to the 2008-2009 Annual Enrollment Report include:

- Table 4: *Credit Headcount by County* now includes the most recent U.S. Bureau of Census population comparative from 2008 to the last census taken in 2006.
- Table 8: *Level of Instruction*, the *Full-Time Equivalency* portion has had the "Unspecified" category removed since it will no longer be used due to state funding of colleges being based on the identification of specific Levels of Instruction and enrollment effective with the 2009-2010 academic year.
- Table 9: *Ten Year History by Headcount* and Table 10, *Ten Year History of FTE Enrollment* have added a "2 Year Change" to show the percent of enrollment change during the last two years.

Pertinent information to keep in mind while reading this report includes the following:

- The annualized totals are calculated by the nationally recognized method of adding the summer, spring and fall semesters together and then dividing the total in half.
- Full-time designation is achieved by being enrolled in a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours in one semester.
- "Full-time equivalency means the number of approved academic or vocational-technical credit hours for each class for which students are enrolled divided by twelve (12)". W.S. 21-18-102 (a)(xii).
- Duplicated headcount means a student could be counted more than once if they are enrolled in numerous courses. These totals are not annualized; they relay a true participation total for each of the colleges.
- Unduplicated headcount means a student is counted only once regardless of how many courses they are taking in a semester. These totals reflect an annualized approach as defined above.

Other areas to note on a national level that could have affected enrollment during the 2008-2009 academic year include:

- The National Bureau of Economic Research, (NBER) reported in a December 2008 online article titled "*Determination of the December 2007 Peak in Economic Activity*" that the United States hit the end of an expansion period and the beginning of a recession in December 2007. As of August 2009, the NBER had not reported the nation as being in and/or moving toward a recovery period.

- The declaration of a national recession has historically shown increases in community college enrollments as discussed in the Community College Reviews' November 10, 2008 online article, "*Why Student Enrollment Rises as the Economy Falls.*"
- The National Center for Public Policy and Higher Education reported in an online paper titled, "*Unprecedented Enrollment Growth*" that the amount of public high school graduates for 2008 will be the largest in the nation's history, and thereby placing greater enrollment demands on this country's universities and colleges.
