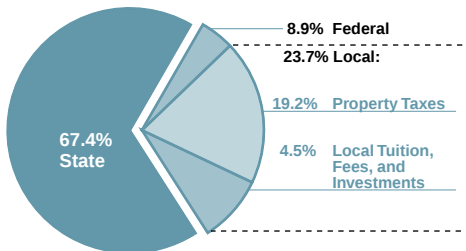

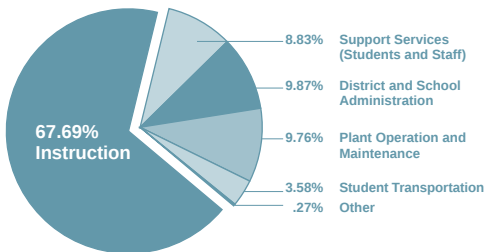
PUBLIC EDUCATION BUDGET
