FOREWORD

THE PRESENT PUBLICATION continues the series of annual land-grant college reports which had their beginning with the establishment of the Office of Education in 1867. In no other report of the Office and for no other group of higher educational institutions is the statistical information presented for individual colleges as complete as in the present publication.

In number, the land-grant institutions in the United States are small—only 69, out of a total of about 1,900 higher institutions. This small number of institutions, however, included in the 1951-52 school year 17.2 percent of the total college enrollment, and 34.9 percent of the total enrollment in publicly controlled institutions. The land-grant colleges conferred 21.4 percent of all earned degrees. Thus the land-grant institutions constitute a significant segment of all higher education in the Nation.

The friendly relations which have developed between the Federal Government and the land-grant colleges in the States have borne fruit in fields beyond "agriculture and the mechanic arts." From the start, the land-grant institutions have contributed to national defense through instruction in "military tactics" (now organized under the Reserve Officer Training Corps programs of the Army, the Navy, and the Air Force): In recent years, the land-grant institutions have also contributed generously through the services of their staffs in missions for "Point IV" and other governmental programs. An additional service has been rendered in connection with special governmental research, particularly in the fields of health and defense; in fact, the Federal funds for such research in the land-grant institutions (almost \$100,000,000 in 1951-52) are now more than double the amount currently granted under the various land-grant acts. It would appear that the Federal-State relationship established in the land-grant colleges has brought benefits to all the parties of interest: the colleges, the States, the Federal Government, and the Nation. This fact lends additional significance to the statistical tabulations of the present report.

STATISTICS OF LAND-GRANT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1952

THIS IS THE final annual report on the 69 land-grant institutions for the year ended June 30, 1952. A preliminary report giving selected data was prepared and distributed at the meeting of the Association of Land-Grant Colleges and Universities which met in Washington, D. C., November 11-15, 1952.

The questions are often asked, "What is a land-grant college? How many are there? Where are they located?"

In broad terms, the land-grant colleges and universities are so called because public lands were granted to the States for their establishment or support. Among their other functions, these institutions carry out the purposes of the First Morrill Act (1862) and participate in the Federal appropriations made in accordance with the Second Morrill Act and supplementary legislation. They are "a system of colleges and universities . . . conforming to certain broad policy stipulations of Federal law."¹

There are 69 land-grant institutions. In each of the 17 States maintaining separate school systems for white and Negro students there are 2 institutions, a total of 34. In Massachusetts both the University of Massachusetts and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology participate in the land-grant funds in accordance with a State law. In each of the remaining 30 States and three territorial divisions there is one institution.

Massachusetts Institute of Technology is wholly a privately controlled institution. Cornell University in New York, Rutgers University in New Jersey, the University of Delaware, Pennsylvania State College, and the University of Vermont are operated with varying degrees of private control.

THE QUESTIONNAIRES.—The questionnaires sent annually to each land-grant institution are in three parts. Part I is a report by the

institution on staff, students, and degrees; Part II is the report on the finances of the institution; Part III is a detailed statement of Federal endowment funds (held in trust by the States) and the interest received from these funds, and of Federal funds received through the Morrill and Bankhead-Jones Acts. Schedule G is a supplement to Part II and details Federal funds paid to the institutions.

The data on the number of students enrolled at the opening of the fall sessions were taken from the fall survey of enrollments in all institutions of higher education in 1952.¹

STAFF.—Among the "white"² institutions a fractional increase of 0.5 percent was observed in the total number of faculty members reported for 1951-52 as compared to the previous year. While the number of faculty members classified as "resident instructional staff" decreased slightly, the loss was offset by gains in the number engaged in "organized research" and in "administration." The number of students per resident instructional staff member was 10.6 in 1951-52.

In the 17 institutions for Negroes, the number of staff members reported in 1951-52 was 1.5 percent below the figure for the previous year. The decrease was confined completely to women staff members.

STUDENTS (undergraduate, graduate, and special).—In the 53 white institutions, the total enrollment in 1951-52 decreased 9.9 percent. The decrease was largely restricted to men students—12.9 percent below the previous year. The decrease in the number of women students was less than 1 percent.

In the three categories of students, the largest decrease was reported in the number of special students—18.6 percent below the previous year. The number of undergraduate students decreased 10.7 percent, while the number of graduate students decreased 3.9 percent.

Despite decreases in total enrollment, the number of students enrolled in college for the first time increased markedly over the previous year. About 12 percent more men enrolled for the first time, while the number of first-time women students increased 18.4 percent.

Among the institutions for Negroes, the decline in total enrollment was much smaller than that reported by the white institutions. The 17 colleges for Negroes enrolled 3.8 percent fewer students in 1951-52 than in the previous year. The number of men enrolled dropped 12.1 percent, while the number of women students increased 4.1 percent.

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS, BY FIELD.—In the white institutions, increased enrollment was reported in only three fields of study: nursing, medicine, and "other professional." The following percen-

tage decreases were reported in other fields: arts and sciences, 11.2; agriculture, 11.6; dentistry, 8.4; commerce, 13.7; home economics, 3.0; law, 17.4; and pharmacy, 10.3.

In the 17 institutions for Negroes the decrease in the total undergraduate enrollment was 3.8 percent. Decreases occurred in all fields except in education, nursing, and "other professional."

DEGREES.—Among the white institutions, a decrease occurred in the number of bachelor's and first professional degrees (men, 24.2 percent; women, 6.5 percent), and also in the number of master's and second professional degrees (5.3 percent). The number of doctor's degrees increased 4.1 percent.

In the 17 institutions for Negroes, the decrease in bachelor's and first professional degrees (both men and women) was 8.4 percent.

INCOME.—The total income for educational and general purposes increased 10.8 percent in the 52 white institutions. Increases were reported in all categories except in income from the Veterans Administration, where a decrease of 40.3 percent occurred. Most notable increases were 43.3 percent in contract research and 15.8 percent from State governments.

The total educational and general income of the 17 institutions for Negroes increased 11.1 percent. As was the case in the white institutions, the most notable decrease was in the amount received from the Veterans Administration for tuition and fees of veteran students enrolled under Public Laws 346 and 16. Small decreases were reported in income from tuition and fees of non-veteran students, in contract research, and in endowment earnings. Income from State Governments increased 16.7 percent, while lesser increases occurred in income from private benefactions, sales and services, and from miscellaneous sources.

EXPENDITURES.—Total expenditures for educational and general expenses in the white institutions in 1951-52 increased 10.3 percent. Increased expenditures were reported in all categories, the largest being in organized research.

In the 17 institutions for Negroes the total education and general expenditures increased 8.9 percent. Increases occurred in all categories except in organized research and extension.

FEDERAL FUNDS.—The total income from Federal funds in the 52 white institutions increased 4.1 percent. There were small increases and three small decreases in recurring appropriations, accounted for, probably, by the adjustment of unused balances at the end of each year. The receipts from the Veterans Administration for tuition and fees decreased 40.3 percent, while the increase for contract research was 30.7 percent.
